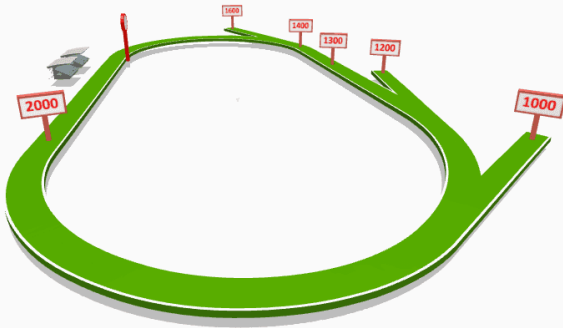

GALACTIC WARRIOR (3) wasn't beaten far here three weeks ago in a CL1 and had been off the scene for more than a year so comes here fitter. He's had interrupted preparations but the ability's there and he may go on with it now. DREAM INHERIT (2) comes back in trip off a freshen up. Has a hope.

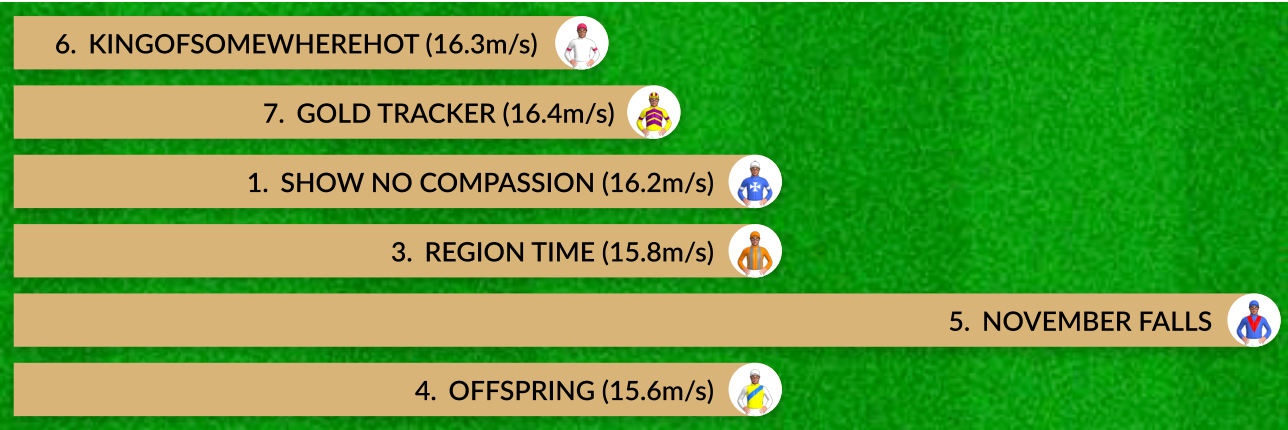

**ANALYSTS VIEW: WITNESS TO LOVE (8)** placed here second-up and then didn't get into the race last time on a slow surface after missing the start. Blinkers come off which can help at the start and Penza's booking is a lead. NORRIS (5) runs along and ran out of puff late at Wagga well supported. He will be fitter and draws to advantage. MISS GHENT (9) debuts for the canny Gardner stable and is likely better than the trial efforts suggest. AMBITIOUS FELLA (2) is on a 7-day turnaround and won't be far away if he jumps with them.



Race3 @ 14:45 Casino Canberra Canberra Guineas Preview

DISTANCE: 1400m



**ANALYSTS VIEW: OFFSPRING (4)** is a promising filly in the top local barn. Splits last time impressed and said she has plenty more to offer. Gets her chance to show that now and fancied to do so. **SHOW NO COMPASSION (1)** belted the Newcastle maidens first-up, stalking the lead as a 2-1 favourite. He'd been threatening to do that and will get every chance to take the next step. **NOVEMBER FALLS (5)** was a big maiden winner on debut and then sat on the speed first-up and ran out of steam late. Has the low barrier and fitter.

Race4 @ 15:25 Mane Lodge Plate

DISTANCE: 1600m



**ANALYSTS VIEW: FIERCE LEGEND (11)** is still a maiden but his ratings say he is right up to this and closing in on the win. He led and was only claimed late at Goulburn as an 11-10 favourite. That effort says he is good enough and he has been tried in Group company so the stable obviously have an opinion. **PURE HYDROGEN (5)** won when heavily bet two back then didn't have the best of it at Kembla Grange. Up to the mile looks ideal and he can prove a threat. **ARCH OF TITUS (4)** deserved the CL1 win this distance and will be on pace again from the low barrier.

DISTANCE: 1000m

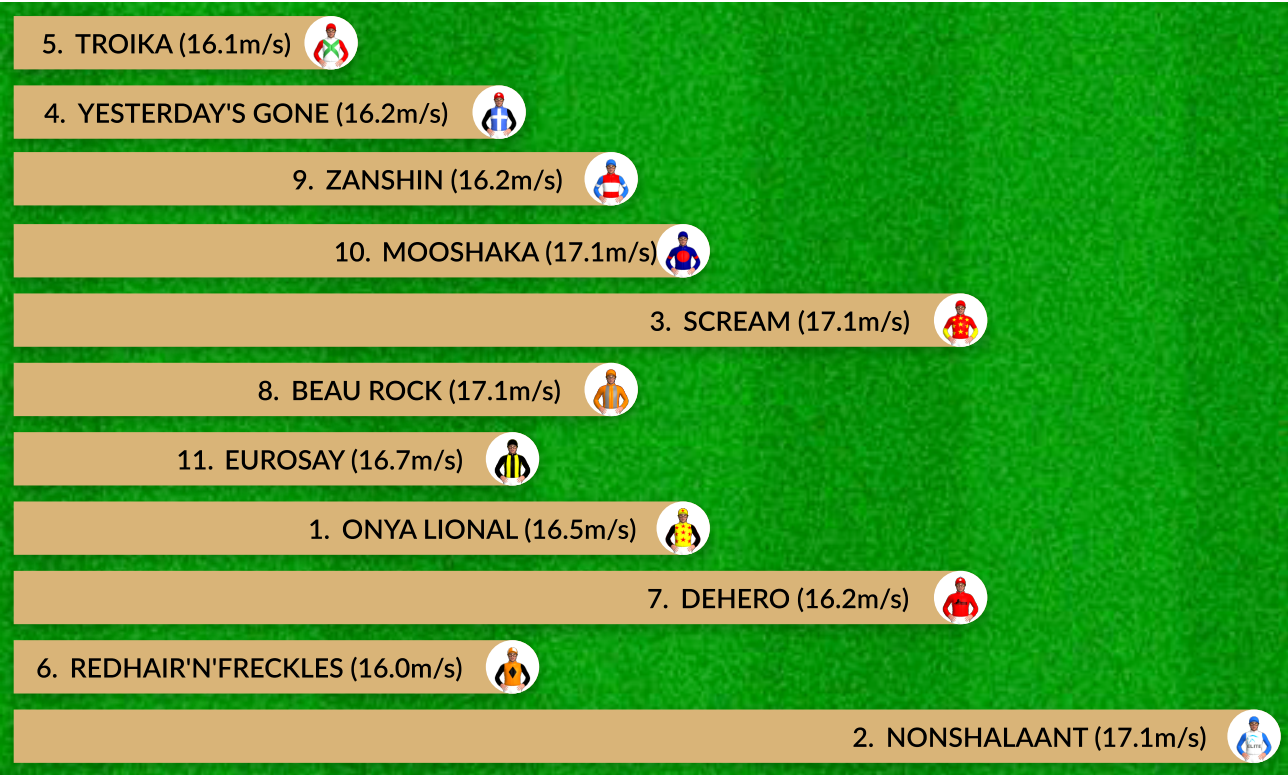


**ANALYSTS View: MISS BLACK DIAMOND (8)** comes south for a top Sydney yard. Resumed at Kembla Grange and faded late having shaped well for a long way. She had trialled well and was solid in town in her brief initial campaign. She's likely to control the race from the low barrier and won't have to be much improved to prevail. **DECIMUS (1)** resumes and is also Sydney-trained. Showed enough on debut to suggest he has a future and has warmed up with two city trials. **PRINCE PAPA (2)** debuted at Goulburn well supported. He's sure to have come on and will get every chance.



Race6 @ 16:40 Alan Rummery Bookmaker Shane Connolly Memorial Handicap

DISTANCE: 1000m



**ANALYSTS View:** SCREAM (3) is in good hands with the stable right among the winners of late. Won his maiden comfortably at Nowra and rated well. He races forward and will get every chance. DEHERO (7) resumes off a Rosehill trial placing. Won his maiden here two back and will appreciate a dryer surface. Can secure the run of the race and will be naturally improved.

Race7 @ 17:15 ETS Refrigeration & Airconditioning Black Opal Preview

DISTANCE: 1000m



**ANALYSTS View:** ALLABOUTELLA (7) won the Newcastle maiden on debut diving late after meeting early trouble. Splits were strong. Has the winkers on for the first time and the rails barrier can see her handy. Can prove a real Black Opal hopeful. LEGOLAS (3) was tried at Group level on debut. Spelled and resumed with a narrow defeat at Newcastle He led them up and can press forward again. SNIPPETY STAR (13) debuts off promising city trials.



Race8 @ 17:50 Affinity Electrical Technologies Canberra Mile

DISTANCE: 1600m



**ANALYSTS View: CAESARS PALACE (5)** resumed further improved narrowly beaten at Rosehill over 1500m and then topped that figure just beaten as favourite at Randwick-Kensington without a lot of luck at all. Another low draw but should push on this time and this is within range. LOVE TAP (2) wasn't far away in a rich Gold Coast feature before leading beaten less than a length at Randwick. Ratings have been consistent. FOR VALOUR (6) is a leader and posted a strong relative figure winning the 78 at Canterbury. Is on a 7-day turnaround and in top order. MISSION PHOENIX (3) has good ability. Drops back 800m but he does have handy form at the trip and ratings are strong if he can produce them over this journey. MANDERBOSS (7) flies the local flag and did a big job latest.

Race9 @ 18:20 TAB Federal National Sprint Preview

DISTANCE: 1200m



**ANALYSTS View: MORE THE MERRIER (9)** has switched to the sharp Matt Dale barn and brings three heavily-bet short course wins from northern Queensland. Has to run out the 1200m for the first time but no surprise if he's further improved in his new surrounds. KING GUTHO (10) got too far back in a rich Gold Coast feature 51-days ago. Freshened which suits and his best will have him in the finish. MAJOR TIME (3) draws for the run of the race and Penza is on for the apprentice.
