ANALYSTS VIEW: WOLVERINE (1) presents third-up off threatening efforts in Group company. There was only 1L in it the latest in the Surround Stakes and today she tumbles in class. Has the outside gate but should be finishing over the top of them. KIMBERLEY SECRETS (2) is a progressive filly who made it 3/4 this preparation winning the CL5 at Moruya. She will settle ahead of the above in the run and is sure to take pegging back. SMOOTH SAILING (8) has her third start seeking the hat-trick. She was heavily bet at Gosford in a CL2 last time and the low barrier and longer sprint advantage here. CAPITAL ASSET (3) improved again winning the 68 at Wyong. Clark will use the rail and note the Snowden yard strikes at a whopping 33% at this track and has enjoyed good success at this carnival.





ANALYSTS VIEW: ARAPAHO (1) has raced at Group level both starts this campaign and is ready for the step-up to the middle distance. He's well performed and King can secure a soft passage from the handy barrier. SACRAMENTO (3) has been close-up in Listed grade his last two and they stack up. Clark will push forward and the gelding hits this at peak fitness. ZEYREK (4) resumed with an easy win in a BM100 over 1400m. Is up sharply in trip but the stable has done that successfully previously. The outside barrier will require a clever ride. ATHABASCAN (6) finished just behind Sacramento in the Randwick City Stakes and has to be considered third-up. ALMANIA (9) peaks for Kris Lees and is also going well enough to consider.
