






ANALYSTS VIEW: DRESSED TO KILL (2) led here on Cup Day and was grabbed just short of the post on slow going. They may prefer to take a sit today but regardless she peaks and will be hard to beat. PROPHET TIME (9) placed first-up in the same contest and it was a big effort after missing the start. She's much improved and is likely to ride the speed. HELPISONITSWAY (10) debuts and is Dress To Kill's stablemate. Owns a Kembla Grange trial win and the blinkers go on. Has the rail and she looks all set to race well. TOKOYO (5) has had plenty of chances but is hard-fit and had good support at Goulburn last start. A value hope with Penza sticking in the saddle.






ANALYSTS VIEW: IMPENDING HARMONY (11) resumed on Black Opal Day well-supported and raced wide before pulling up with kickback material in an eye. Has an inside gate and can quickly improve for the top local barn. INVETERATE (2) resumes for the Olive yard off a heavy track placing at Wagga. He will be naturally improved and brings a Goulburn trial win. Draws out but that may be less of an issue here on a wet surface. CRINKLE CUTZ (4) resumes for the new stable and was placed here on a heavy track before the spell. He's trialled and rates a winning chance. OLD NEWMARKET (5) may need one but has wet track form and is likely to come back improved.




ANALYSTS VIEW: DECIMUS (3) wasn't beaten far on a slow surface on debut and followed the first-up placing here with a 1.2L defeat at Gosford in stronger. Has a low gate and the blinkers on first time and fitter is the one to beat. CHOOSE YOUR WORDS (1) is in a top Sydney stable and led and placed in the country second-up. She goes on wet tracks and will likely skip over and lead. STAR LEGACY (4) was plain in the same race but his two prior runs stack right up. Hasn't raced on wet tracks and will need a good ride from the awkward gate. ROMANTIC ROCK (12) has been mixing trips but is hard-fit and finds easier. Beasley is a positive jockey booking.






ANALYSTS VIEW: AUNT ROBERTA (7) is in a leading Sydney yard and needed the first-up run coming off a Group 3. Was narrowly beaten at the provincials after at 1800m on the slow. Has the blinkers on for the first time and can use the rails gate. The middle distance is ideal third-up and she's sure to take beating. ITSAGOODDEEL (11) peaks off a 1.5L defeat at Gosford over the mile. Goes in the wet and gives every indication the 2000m will suit. RAPID IMPACT (6) was narrowly defeated this distance range at Gosford on the same day. Keeps threatening and will run it right out. IBERIAN RULER (10) is Aunt Roberta's stablemate and has been solid both starts this preparation. The longer trip should suit and he needs to be kept safe.




ANALYSTS VIEW: MANZONI (5) switched from Godolphin and won a trial for the Jarvis yard before delivering the Maiden win at Moruya first-up. Has strong city and provincial form on slow and heavy tracks and has more to give. He can take the next step. LONDON (2) switched from the Waller barn and resumed in good order at Gosford beaten 2L in stronger grade. He has more up his sleeve and won his only second-up outing. Penza stays with him, and wet track conditions should be a bonus. FLASHING STEEL (1) resumes for a leading Sydney barn and has trialled well at Warwick Farm. Was last seen at 70 level in Melbourne and is likely to return further improved. More open the rest. ANCHORAGE (8) on resumption for Matt Dale may be the best of them.






ANALYSTS VIEW: OFFSPRING (5) is promising and missed a nose here first up before tacking the Listed Canberra Guineas beaten 3.5L. Out to the mile advantages and she has soft and heavy-track form. She can secure the run of the race the Dryden-trained filly appeals. PINKY (9) is in a leading Sydney barn and can prove a danger if she takes her place. The near-miss two-back at 66 level is the measure and the 1.5kg claim advantages. Managed a heavy track when close-up at Canterbury three-back. REGAL INHERITANCE (8) won the Maiden here on Black Opal Day as a 2-1 favourite. Lightly raced and can keep improving for the Sydney yard. REGION TIME (6) was out graded in the Canberra Guineas but missed a nose here prior in a 65 and a wet surface won't bother.



ANALYSTS VIEW: LIPSTICK SWING (2) led on resumption at Wagga and easily won the 58. Won her only second-up outing and Danny Beasley is a key jockey switch for the apprentice. Handles wet surfaces and fitter looks capable of going on with it. ZELAGO (3) peaks off the near miss here on Black Opal Day in stronger. Back to a shorter sprint should be an advantage given the expected wet conditions. I CALL JUNEE HOME (1) resumed for the new stable in a Quality sprint on the same program day and was swamped late. Has more to give and an inside gate and 3kg claim bring her into it. DEVINE MISS (8) is up to this at best and has been freshened. Needs a good ride from the rail but Penza is reunited, and the yard delivered three upsets over the Black Opal carnival.





ANALYSTS VIEW: UNIQUE PRINCE (8) was well supported here on Cup Day in better class but lacked finishing dash over the mile. Just missed this distance at Goulburn prior in a 66 and that reads well. He's in good hands and has the rail and Billy Owen is reunited. CABLE TIE (9) has been around the mark since the debut win at Hawkesbury and didn't finish it off here the latest as a 13-8 favourite. The Sydney-trained galloper has an awkward gate but the longer sprint suits and he's worth another. STRATUM PRIDE (7) placed in stronger on the same day and has more to give. She can secure a soft run and the Dryden yard is always a threat at home. WATCH ME RUMBLE (3) won the CL4 first-up and then was only beaten 2.7L as favourite in a rich Country Championships. Fitter again and the 2kg claim advantages. A player as well.
