




Race1 @ 12:10 John Mcgrath Auto Group Mg Phillip Plate


DISTANCE: 1600m



**ANALYSTS VIEW: CUT ON A DIME (2)** boasts the superior formlines coming through the G2 Phar Lap last start where he wasn't disgraced, backing up a strong effort in the G1 Randwick Guineas the start prior. Inside draw is a little niggle, but this is much easier. Just has to run up to recent form to be winning. OFFSPRING (6) was game when close to a hot speed in the Listed CBR Guineas and is better suited out to a mile. Can score without surprising. DADDY FRANK (8) wasn't far away on debut and will take plenty of benefit from that effort as he drops into Country level. UPTICK (10) was never likely fresh but can improve with the rise in trip.

Race2 @ 12:45 Thank You Tim Olive Handicap


DISTANCE: 1200m



**ANALYSTS VIEW: LOUD (5)** stuck on well fresh over 1010 at Orange and was a winner at Gosford over this trip in heavy going to end last campaign. 1200m suits the filly much better and she drops in weight for today's assignment. She looks the one to beat. **VANCOUVER QUEEN (3)** dominated on debut at Muswellbrook but was too bad to be true at Kembla last start. Back to country grade and a favourable draw can see her bounce back in strong fashion. **DIAMOND STAR (7)** has been off the scene for a year but was given a quiet trial coming into this. Good chance if she can handle the wet. **ZARINYA (2)** drops into country grade today and is not to be discounted.

Race3 @ 13:20 Seears Workwear Handicap


DISTANCE: 1000m



**ANALYSTS VIEW: TOKOYO (11)** was no match for a dominant winner last start at Goulburn, but stuck on well to finish runner-up. Her form has been good this campaign and she strikes a very suitable race this time around. Can finally bring up her maiden victory. **DEEP SHIMMER (8)** finished a length behind Tokoyo in that same race last time out but does meet that mare better at the weights. May need some luck from the draw but should handle the going and make her presence felt. **LA MIA VIA (2)** has placed 6/10 in her career and gets the winkers off again today. Drawn well and can salute. New stablemate **SUNCHYME (4)** creates interest and can score without surprising.

Race4 @ 15:55 Get Built Handicap



DISTANCE: 1400m



**ANALYSTS VIEW: WARBY (1)** ran over the top to score his maiden victory at Hawkesbury by 1.5L. Up in trip looks to suit and he has run well on rain-affected tracks previously. Can bring up back-to-back wins. EBERLEE (3) disappointed last start after a great effort in midweek company the star prior. This is much easier today and she only rises 0.5kg. Both wins have come in the wet and she's sure to make her presence felt. REGION TIME (6) was in great form prior to failing in the Listed CBR Guineas last start. Good win in the heavy over 1300m last prep. Big chance. THE MAXINATOR (2) is a stayer resuming but is 2/4 fresh and both wins have come in the wet. Keep safe.

Race5 @ 14:30 John Mcgrath Auto Group Kia Phillip Handicap


DISTANCE: 1200m



**ANALYSTS VIEW: MOTION LEGEND (5)** resumes with two solid trials under his belt, mixing it with quality horses in the process. He's built a good record thus far and he handles the wet going. Expect him to roll forward and make his own luck up front. He'll be mighty hard to beat. HELLO JACK (4) wasn't far off at Albury last time out when beaten by a progressive type. He's never missed the placings at this track and the drop back to 1200m shouldn't pose an issue. Genuine contender. PACKER (8) went under narrowly at Orange last time out and drops 3.5kg after the claim of the in-form Jett Stanley. Sure to be in the finish. LOCKUP THE KITTENS (9) showed enough fresh at Goulburn and can run a big race off the inside.

Race6 @ 15:05 Iron Jack Plate


DISTANCE: 1300m



**ANALYSTS VIEW:** This looks a race dominated by two stables. **MATRONYMIC (14)** went forward last start in a change of tactics and ran the best race of her career thus far. Drops back to country level today and suspect they'll adopt similar tactics from the draw. Will prove tough to beat. **CHOOSE YOUR WORDS (13)** has been fair without winning and shapes similarly to her last campaign when a big winner third-up in the wet over 1300m. Has to contend with a wide draw, but she's a huge chance with sharp improvement anticipated. **AUSSIE PHAROAH (4)** is on debut for the Maher & Eustace powerhouse. He's trialled well coming in and should be strong at the finish. **CYCLE PEAK (5)** went under as favourite on debut but showed enough. Not to be discounted.

Race7 @ 15:40 TAB Federal


DISTANCE: 1200m



**ANALYSTS VIEW:** A competitive Federal. **MERC (12)** was good at Moruya two back but may not have seen out the extra journey last start. He drops sharply in weight today with the claim of Bourke and back to 1200m is a big tick. Handles the wet and looks a genuine winning chance. **TRANSPLANT (1)** was swamped after leading at Hawkesbury last start, but was in great form prior. Draws ideally to find the front and will prove tough to run down. **CRUCIAL WITNESS (9)** is a bonny mare who went under narrowly in tougher company on Black Opal Day. She'll be in the finish. **WATCH ME RUMBLE (8)** wasn't far behind Country Champs winner Sizzle Minizzle last start. Merits plenty of respect.

Race8 @ 16:15 Canberra Southern Cross Club Tuggeranong Cup


DISTANCE: 1600m



**ANALYSTS VIEW:** The first edition of the Tuggeranong Cup sees **STRATUM PRIDE (6)** land on top. She' was a big winner last campaign over this trip in the wet and wasn't disgraced when held up and in the inferior going last start. Should get a lovely run from the draw and may prove too good for her rivals. TWIG (7) is 2/2 at the trip and steps out to the mile for the first time this campaign. Her form lines up alongside Stratum Pride from 2 starts back, but she meets that mare better at the weights today. Winning hope. SIZZLING CAT (3) scored a good win when rolling forward from the wide draw last start and gets the in-form apprentice on board. Loves the wet and can be in the finish. DIAMOND CLASS (15) was good at Goulburn and will appreciate a strong mile.

Race9 @ 16:50 Happy 40th Hutch Handicap

DISTANCE: 1000m



**ANALYSTS VIEW:** **CHIEF CONDUCTOR (1)** was only 1L off a smart horse who has since won impressively again. Has to carry a big weight but is far superior to his rivals today. Should be able to work across from the wide draw and put his opponents to the sword. BEAU ROCK (2) was a superb winner in tougher grade last time out, but does rise substantially in weight because of that. He is somewhat hampered by the wide draw, but would just have to repeat his last start figures to go mighty close. GIDDY UP GIDLEIGH (12) finally shed the maiden tag in good style at Wellington. Expect him to fire out and run along again from a favourable gate. Can land the knockout punch. SIFU (3) has placed 3/4 fresh and the wet track won't hurt. Keep safe.
