

ANALYSTS VIEW: PROPHET'S DAUGHTER (2) missed a lip twice at Wagga before improving again beaten 1.5L at Albury on a slow track. It was a tough effort and she's the one to beat. BURGUNDY GIRL (5) placed twice here and then left herself with too much to do at the Sapphire Coast. Presents at peak fitness and the Dryden yard is flying at home. VIENNOISERIE (3) switched barns and was beaten less than 1L here 7-days ago on heavy ground. Hasn't missed a beat and is obviously pleasing. MISS ADRENALIN (4) made good improvement winning her Maiden on a slow surface and can build on that for the in-form Ible yard.


ANALYSTS VIEW: FAIRNESS IS BEST (3) was beaten 1L here on debut and then came back and found the grade a bit rich on Black Opal Day. Followed with a narrow loss at the Sapphire Coast from an awkward gate and that reads well. He can sit handier today and fourth-up will go close. DREAMTIME LEGEND (5) drew even wider in the same contest and didn't have much luck. Improved at Goulburn prior and gets another chance. MISS STALWART (7) was better again placing at Nowra. She's in good hands and won't have to improve much to feature. RED REDEMPTION (4) races handy and will be suited dropping 208m in distance. Bensley sticks with Fairness Is Best, but Penza is a more than able replacement.



ANALYSTS VIEW: MATRONYMIC (7) is in a top Sydney barn and spiked her figures beaten 2L at Wyong riding the speed. She's been freshened and is suited back to country grade. Day sticks in the saddle and the filly will be hard to roll. Stablemate HEIRESS HERA (3) resumes and led beaten a whisker at Scone on debut when trained by Waterhouse-Bott. She's been away 390 days but has looked sharp in four spaced city trials and Penza rides from a low gate. The race day betting will tell the story with her. BOSTON OF TUFFY (2) resumes for Sydney's Joe Pride and has switched from the Robl yard. Hasn't raced shorter than 1500m but he's trialed and has shown enough to keep safe. PROPHET TIME (10) rates well and is on the improve. A live hope if she takes her place.



ANALYSTS VIEW: POKER DICE (8) has been knocking on the door and it was a stout effort here a month ago when beaten 2.3L from the back. Penza staying with him is a lead and the Dryden yard is flying at home. This is a winnable assignment. STYLEBENDER (4) peaks for the in-form Heys camp and will find this more suitable than Rosehill. He wasn't beaten far here first up and his best figures are at this trip. Peaks now and is ready to show more. AGGRANDIZE (5) races over a middle distance for the first time and was beaten a nose at the mile her latest. Made up a stack of ground and should see it right out. BANDOLERO (1) placed this trip at Mudgee and won't be far away holding that form.




ANALYSTS VIEW: JOHNNY DASH (6) is in a top Sydney barn and first-up did about what expected. He has plenty up the sleeve and is a second-up winner. Well-bred and handles slow surfaces. GALACTIC WARRIOR (8) peaks and is busting to win. Go on the nose defeat here two back and Penza is a positive jockey switch. RETIRO (2) peaks and raced favourite here a month ago in a 70 having switched barns. He's speed-bred and capable of using the rail. Has the ability and the 3kg claim brings him right into it. COOL LAD (1) resumes for a strong Sydney barn and would be a hope if presented forward. A betting watch.



ANALYSTS VIEW: LONDON GAL (7) had been threatening on good surfaces before delivering a 4.3L soft track win at Goulburn leading all the way. Tackles better grade today but carries 3kg less and the in-form Penza rides and he would have had choices. This looks winnable as well. BALEDON (1) is a handy galloper dropping back in grade. His Albury effort two-back reads particularly well, and he will present at peak fitness. UNIQUE PRINCE (8) was beaten 3L here this in this grade a month ago and didn't have the best of it. Missed 1L this trip prior and is also a hope. RYTHMBOAT (6) won the CL2 comfortably three-back and has been around the mark since. Draws a tricky barrier but has weight relief and can't be ruled out. CRUCIAL WITNESS (5) has been briefly freshened following her narrow defeat here at this level and is also in the mix.



ANALYSTS VIEW: Competitive. **TWIG (6)** missed a whisker here at 70 level and then came back and was beaten 2.5L as a 3-1 favourite. Peaks now and has won 2/2 over the mile. In good hands and is well-placed with the 3kg claim. Draws low and can secure the run of the race. The dangers all present off tricky barriers. PERSEVERE (4) is in a strong Sydney barn and is ready to win off two solid provincial efforts. Didn't have the best of it at Hawkesbury last time and is a threat. ZAMBRERO (7) is also Sydney trained and expect him to be much sharper dropping back to the mile. The big Newcastle win three-back reads well. STRATUM PRIDE (5) was narrowly beaten here a month ago in a 75 bet a 2-1 favourite. The Dryden yard is hard to risk at home. DIAMOND CLASS (14) may be best of the rest.

Has an inside gate and the Sydney-trained galloper can improve quickly. LIPSTICK SWING (1) led and won the 58 easily on resumption. The 2kg claim brings her into it and she can give a sight. ZELAGO (2) won well at this track last time out and drops back in trip off a freshen. Include.
