





ANALYSTS VIEW: GYPSY ROMANCE (5) may not have seen out the extra trip at Wellington and back to 1300m is a good sing. She should land in a handy position from the draw and if she can get back to her prior form, she'll prove hard to hold out. SUMMERSET GIRL (9) was solid without winning last campaign and has switched stables since those efforts. Her recent trial was good, and an improved effort is expected first-up. DANISH LANE (4) probably found the 1000m a bit sharp first-up and the extra journey is a big tick. Will be strong at the finish. IMPENDING HARMONY (6) hasn't been a 'punter's pal' but must be respected out of an in-form stable.









ANALYSTS VIEW: HARLEMITE (8) finished only 2L away on debut at Newcastle and tackles the older horses today. She'll benefit from the run under her belt and the booking of Penza is a good push for her chances. She looks the one to beat. O'SO DEMANDING (9) is on debut for the Baker stable and has looked good in both trials. Costin strikes at 18% when riding for Bjorn and she's sure to make her presence felt. FALREINE (3) disappointed last start at Wagga but had gone close in her 2 starts prior. Can bounce back. BEST INTENT (6) trialled well in readiness for her debut and must be included from the leading local stable.




ANALYSTS VIEW: SATIRICAL FAN (8) should be at peak fitness third-up. Was good without winning at Newcastle last start, beaten 3.1L and will find this easier back to Country level. Should find a lovely spot in running for the in-form Shaun Guymer and he appears the one to beat. BY NINE (1) was a touch disappointing at Wyong last time out after going down narrowly at Hawkesbury the start prior. Can bounce back. ZEDLY (4) can feature on the back of a good trial at Kembla Grange. ELLIE'S DREAM (5) stuck to the task well at this track and trip last start and should appreciate the better going.




ANALYSTS VIEW: HELLO JACK (2) has been in great form despite not winning, just going down 0.8L over this track and trip last time out. He should find the front from a handy barrier, and he goes well at this track. Expecting him to be very hard to run down. MIL CIENTO (3) resumed with just a fair effort at Goulburn over a short trip. He's trialled well since, with the rise in trip and drop in weight both helping his chances. He's sure to be in the finish. DEEP SHIMMER (5) relished the wet here last time out and 1200m shouldn't be an issue. Can go back-to-back without surprising. IN DE SUN IWILCOME (1) will be aided by an improving track and the run under her belt.




ANALYSTS VIEW: EASY ROSIE (2) has been contesting much stronger races this campaign and wasn't disgraced when beaten 3.1L at Newcastle last time out. Fit and firing, back to 1400m suits and she can get back into the winners' stall. UNIQUE PRINCE (3) is on the quick back up after winning last week's Federal. A repeat effort would see him go close once again. BLAAZAY (6) resumed from a long layoff 21 days ago and can improve today with the run under his belt and up in trip. CARNIVAL MISS (4) put in a good effort in tougher grade last time out and the 1.5kg claim comes in handy. Can feature again.




ANALYSTS VIEW: DEHERO (10) steps out to the 1200m for the first time but it does look to suit. She's better than she showed last start at Nowra and drops slightly in weight today. Penza does the steering and she looks mighty hard to beat. NOBLE BEAUTY (2) was a consistent performer in midweek company all through last campaign. She's run well fresh previously and can make her presence felt dropping back to this much easier grade. RED MICK (3) ran on well at Hawkesbury first-up and should be suited by the extra 100m today. Should be able to sit closer today and can give a big sight if she runs up to his latest effort. SUPERARGO (4) resumes on the back of a nice trial at Hawkesbury and has placed 2/3 fresh. Keep safe.



ANALYSTS VIEW: SISTER MOON (3) resumed with a good win at the Sapphire Coast and has been kept fresh since that effort. Barrier 9 won't hurt as she's likely to get back in the run. Expecting her to make a bold run in the straight and get over the top of her rivals to remain undefeated. RAISE HELL (2) is another progressive type who wasn't far away last start at Goulburn. He drops in weight from that effort and appears the main danger to the top pick. NONSHALAANT (1) is a consistent galloper who should find the front from an inside barrier. Can take plenty of catching from the front with Collett taking the ride. MOOSHAKA (6) can be in the mix if she's near her best.

ANALYSTS VIEW: LOUD (6) stuck on in the wet here 14 days ago before the meeting was abandoned. Back onto a firmer deck may suit as will the easier race she contests today. 1400m won't be an issue and she'll be mighty hard to beat. MY BLUE JEANS (7) can be an improver in this event. He'll get a long way back from the draw, but 1400m is right up his alley and suspect they'll be coming wide in the straight by this time of the day. Can give a big sight. Stablemate RIBEAUVILLE (1) drops back in grade steeply. He's at peak fitness now and Heywood has had success when riding previously. Key chance. WOULD BE KING (3) may have found his right race today and won't be far away.
