



ANALYSTS VIEW: HADOUKEN (1) is third-up and should be ready to fire. Three back he was only beaten 1L in an Eagle Farm 65 over this journey following a near miss in a Goulburn CL2. He draws to advantage and Day sticks in the saddle. Well placed. JAMROCK (8) is an improver and the sharp Neasham barn is building a tidy record in the capital. He has plenty up his sleeve and is suited out to the mile. FLIC EN FLAC (5) is in the all-conquering Maher-Eustace yard and won at Bathurst on debut. The longer trip shouldn't be a bother and no surprise if she took the next step. ELLIE'S DREAM (2) placed here and then came back and just missed in a blanket finish at this distance. He peaks now and is a chance if the outside barrier is managed.






ANALYSTS VIEW: THE PRODIGAL SON (3) resumes and was last seen beaten 1.9L in a 64 at Flemington. He delivered on debut prior and has warmed up for this with a Tatura trial win. He should be naturally improved and will take beating. SIR MING (1) has likely had issues but resumed in good order for the new barn. He won his only second-up outing and that stacks right up. Draws to advantage and no surprise to see him feature. POWER PUFF (6) is third-up and the Sydney-trained galloper has more to give. Penza is a positive jockey booking and can secure the run of the race. WAGUNDA (4) has been freshened and has up-side. In good hands and keep safe. DREAMING OF VEGAS (2) missed a lip on debut and then won a trial here before taking out his Maiden heavily-bet. Has the winkers applied the first time and fitter he can't be ruled out.




ANALYSTS VIEW: BEST INTENT (5) has her third start and is threatening a win for the top Canberra barn. Two weeks ago, she found one better as favourite at Wagga and didn't get it all her own way. Has an awkward barrier but can deliver with average luck. INVETERATE (3) comes out of the same race and despite being well-supported didn't do a lot. He's much better than that and Penza is a key jockey booking. Peaks now and can threaten. ALL SO EASY (7) resumed in good order and then worked into a placing at Wagga at long odds. Lightly raced and must be kept safe. RAIDER EIGHTYEIGHT (1) is in the mix.

ANALYSTS VIEW: GENTLY ROLLED (8) brings city form to resumption and was beaten a lip on the Randwick-Kensington her latest. She's had two trial warmers, and this is winnable if she's presented ready. NOVEMBER RHYTHM (4) is fast and has been freshened off four narrow defeats. He's been kept up to the mark with a Warwick Farm trial win. Was narrowly beaten here two-back but draws wide today and needs a good ride pushing forward. DORAMI (7) is a lightly raced improver who was just lipped out at Wagga heavily supported. The local won't have to improve much to feature. ZIPPY ZOO (12) has a similar profile and put in a big effort to place at Kembla Grange 13-days ago. PROPHET TIME (9) is also in the mix.



ANALYSTS VIEW: Plenty of chances. **DIAMOND CLASS (4)** placed here over the mile and then lifted to this distance and came from well-back to be beaten 2L. She drops back a level and draws well with a handy 2kg claim. Gets the nod. STYLEBENDER (7) was plain at Wagga and go on the placed run here prior when well-bet. He will push forward and is a chance in a moderate line-up. LOAFING (6) steps up in trip and was beaten 1.6L here in a 65 at his only try at 2000m. In the premier Canberra barn and Penza is a key jockey booking. PORT DOUGLAS (2) has been racing well and tackles the middle

distance for the first time. He will run along from the rail and give a sight.



ANALYSTS VIEW: A tricky benchmark 50. KINROSS (4) has got to within 3L or closer at the last three starts and all have been in stronger races. Gets more weight but a key jockey switch with Owen on for the apprentice. She can box-seat from the low barrier and looks suited. G'DAY POOPSIE (1) is down from Wyong and was beaten 1L at Taree on resumption in 58 grade. He's a second-up winner and the 2kg claimer will run him along. A winning chance. LAST WAR (3) resumes and has trialled well at Tatura. Finds the right level and is in the mix. KHALEEJ (8) resumed in a CL2 at Leeton and lost his rider. He hasn't won for a long while but three back was beaten 1L in a Goulburn CL1 and that would see him very competitive. Needs a good ride from the awkward barrier.



ANALYSTS VIEW: ALLGEMEINE (8) resumes for the sharp Matt Dale yard and is a lightly raced mare who goes on the fresh side. She was heavily backed all three runs last preparation and placed twice at this track. She draws well and is likely to be further improved. DEVINE MISS (6) is a local who is up to this at best and prepared to forgive the recent Wagga run when she got too far back. She just missed around here first-up and with the benefit of the 3kg claim can find her best. PUERTO RICO (7) was tracking well before a plainer effort at Albury when he led. He will use the low gate and is a chance on the 7day return. MOOSHAKA (10) deserved the big CL2 win here, which stacks up. Stays down in the weights and can't be ruled out. BEAU ROCK (4) continues to race well and deserves consideration.

ANALYSTS VIEW: On weights and measures, there's little between many of these. SEA TREASURES (1) resumed in a touch stronger at Bathurst and needed the outing. The longer sprint suits and he performs second-up and has plenty up the sleeve. He will ride the speed and gets in well with the 4kg claim. DIAMOND STAR (14) is one of several acceptors from the in-form Dryden barn and she didn't have much luck at Wagga, following the first-up win here. She's placed third-up and is good enough at best. BLAAZAY (3) only missed 1.3L here in a 70 and will be better for it. Draws low and Owen sticking in the saddle is a lead. I'M NOT LEAVING (8) ran a good figure beaten 1.4L at the Sapphire Coast and has upside. The outside gate will require a special from Collett. MY BLUE JEANS (17) and MANILA THRILLER (15) are others worth a look.
