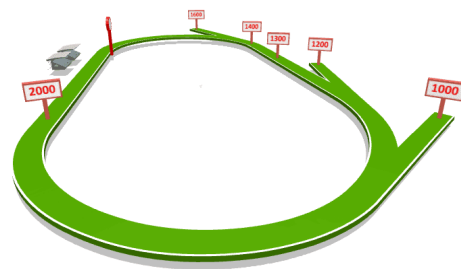

Race Analysis: Domain Gardens resumes with just the one trial under her belt. Showed good ability in her first prep and the booking of Guymer is a positive lead. Expecting her to have come on in the break and may just be too good for this field. Picasso's Dream couldn't get the job done at Queanbeyan last start but rates on top from that effort. Only the one winner from 10 subsequent starters is some concern but Nisbet rides at 30% when teaming up with the Baker yard. Media Frenzy ran well here two back, but was 9-1 on that occasion and it rated a below average Canberra Maiden. Now comes up early fave against a couple she rates equal to. Easy to oppose. Meghan stuck on well over the short course here last start and can improve out to 1200m.

Race Analysis: This looks the right race for Cheval Savant after being unable to sustain the run at Warwick Farm last time out in heavy going. Was running figures good enough to win this prior to that and now gets the blinkers on back to Country level. Can make his own luck up front and prove very hard to run down. The lightly raced Prefer The Wink caught the eye when out to 1800m to end last campaign. Gets his chance to show what he's capable now and appears the obvious danger with plenty of upside. La Sagrada made every post a winner last start and bolted in at Newcastle (Beaumont) over this trip. Mightn't find the front as easy this time but rates a leading chance on her latest effort. Burgundy Bubbles steps out in trip now after sticking on well over the mile here a fortnight ago. Gets his chance to show what he's capable of now.

Race Analysis: Looks a raffle to end the day. Zazel hit the line full of running to shed the maiden tag a fortnight ago and sectional analysis backs up the visual display. Looks one of the key formlines heading into this race and she's drawn to stalk the pace once more. May prove too strong at the finish once again. Spirits Burn Deep was 15/1 at Nowra but almost took the win after leading throughout. This looks to set up similarly and she'll stick her nose in the finish if she repeats her latest effort. Riva d' Amor is better than she showed last start and can run a much improved race coming back to country grade and form a nice draw. Timperley bolted in first-up last campaign over this track and trip in a similar event. Fitter for two trials coming in, just needs some luck from the inside draw.
