

Race Analysis: Willabelle pops up post-scratchings and it may be a good push from the barn as they've taken out the early favourite and left her in. She's a full sister to Group 3 winner Williamsburg and has shown promising signs at the trials. Not a whole lot of juice in the price but it's easy to see why she's come up top pick. Racing for the same connections is Stormy Revolution who was closing strongly over 900m on debut. Suspect the rise to 1200m is what she's looking for and the Collett/Neasham partnership are winning twice as much as the market expects at this track. Sharp improvement anticipated.

Race Analysis: Revelaide improved nicely when out to 1850m at Newcastle last start and stayed on strongly over the closing stages, with that form already being franked. Lightly raced and on the way up, she should relish the extra ground and if she can improve again, she'll be winning this. The key word there is 'improve', because her ratings at this stage only match what Tell The Future has done in his past couple. Really hit his straps since getting out to this trip and the gap between he and Revelaide in the market is too big. Domain Gardens has been good in her two runs back and appears to be working toward something. Not willing to risk her out to this trip for the first time.

Race Analysis: Great race to start the quaddie. Barely anything between this lot and going wide in the first leg seems the best play. Matlock should be fitter for the fresh run where he beat Merisi close to the line. Wouldn't surprise to see him go on with the job although Merisi does meet him better at the weights. Good Lieutenant won well here two back and that figure stacks up to what Matlock & Merisi did last time out. Lichester could be an improver. Her two efforts at the mile have been inconclusive and now looks to get plenty in her favour while Donegal Lights just keeps winning.

Race Analysis: Interesting race at the top of betting. Bon Frankie won his Highway rather comfortably last start and the time there stacks up strongly against the rest of the card. The niggle is that he found himself in the right spot on that strong tempo and this may set up differently in the run. Another branch to the tree is the fact Rouge Lune beat him first-up before a somewhat plain effort at Goulburn last start. They meet at level weights now, but was Frankie's win a perfect storm or can he go on with it? Dorami has been a consistent galloper, though that may be her downfall here with Frankie and Rouge Lune's peak figures higher. Champions League isn't out of this if he's at his best.

Race Analysis: Surprised Decimus isn't favourite in this. Two bad runs to end last prep over the longer trips but really hit top form around a mile last campaign. This looks like a perfect starting point for him having found the shorter trips too sharp early in last campaign. Ticks plenty of boxes with Collett booked and he can return on a winning note with a few niggles against his rivals. Shadow Dane resumed for the new barn with a win at Wagga and ratings suggest their is more to come. Time at Wagga was very slow, but he has the platform to build on. Form behind Hurricane Ablowing and Chasing A Quid is very noisy, with only 2 lengths spreading the field at Moruya. Although they appear suited by the rise in trip, they would both have to improve to get close to Decimus.

Race Analysis: No real desire to bet in the last with plenty of scratchings and going wide in the Quaddie looks the play. My Girona looks the one off the last start effort at Parkes when only narrowly defeated. A few of these rate similarly, but hers is the most recent and she looks the most likely to repeat it. Astunner has figures to match though they have come over further and in different scenarios. She is a first-up winner previously though and appears the main danger.
