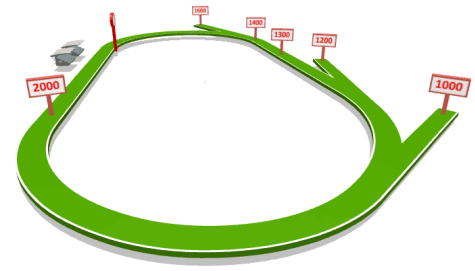

Cyborg wound back the clock to show he's still got some zest left in him. He dipped off a similar run earlier this campaign which is a little niggle and he was 20-1 when winning just 9 days ago.

The draw is a little niggle, but she did jump favourite in a similar event at Narrandera two starts ago. Now with a new stable and the gear changes suggest she may be an improved commodity. Forbidden Gemstone stuck on well in this grade last start and steps out to this trip second-up. Remains at the same weight from a nice draw and can play a major role again. Super Riff can improve getting out in trip third-up into the campaign and Factoring Profit strips fitter today dropping back in grade.

Race Analysis: Trooper Knuckle was right up to his best when first-up last campaign off a similar break and will be fitter for a recent trial. Looks to map beautifully from the draw and his ratings are right up to what Napoleon Solo has produced, but he's getting 1.5kg off that rival. This looks a nice kick off point for his campaign. Light Press creates plenty of interest as she steps out to this trip for just the second time. She's been good from 1000m to 1200m since arriving in the Kirkup stable and now that she's a more mature horse, this trip isn't outside of her wheelhouse. Loose Love and Trooper Knuckle have met three times where the Knuckle has defeated him by a combined 25.7L. Loose love did beat Trooper Knuckle in a recent trial, but Dryden's gelding holds the aces on raceday.

Race Analysis: No desire to get involved in this. Texas Open brings the best figures into the race but he has had plenty of chances to shed the maiden tag. Hard to knock his form this time in though and he may have found his right race today. Downtown's Abbey stuck on well at Wagga when a \$15 chance, running into the placings. Wide draw makes things sticky but the fact Beasley sticks creates plenty of interest. Will need to improve on the debut run, but unlike her rivals she has the upside to do so. Clendenning has claims after being around the mark for much of last campaign and while No Escaping This was big odds at Wagga, a repeat of that performance would see him in the finish again today.

Race Analysis: Adagio was a strong maiden winner at Muswellbrook before bumping into a rocket here on Black Opal Day. He then held his own in a good race at Hawkesbury and will find this a much easier assignment than what he faces there. Should find the front with ease off the inside alley and McLucas strikes at 21% when riding for the Waterhouse/Bott Stable. Looks a horse on the way up and he can get the job done. Twin Turbo put in some big ratings last campaign and has a sense of timing about him third-up and out to this trip. He jumped a heavy favourite in a similar race at Tuncurry at the end of last campaign. Trending the right way and can play a major role. Henley Extreme had improved with every run this campaign before dipping last start at Hawkesbury. Happy to overlook one bad effort and she's right in the mix on her prior form.

He will have to carry the 60.5kg, but he's been thrown in the deep end right from the start and hasn't looked out of place. Looks set to make a winning return. Cable Express got the job done on debut, beating a horse who went on two win two races, including one at Hawkesbury. Trialled recently with Beasley in the saddle and he rides again today. Expecting him to have come on since his debut effort. Opal Fields has been running on well from the back and may be looking for this trip now. Good at Wyong last start and is worth including in Quaddie numbers.

Back to country grade and a smaller field are both ticks.

Race Analysis: Happy to back in Vaderzan in the closer. His rating continued to improve with every run since joining the Dryden camp last campaign before nothing went right at Gundagai prior to the spell. The stable has had a full campaign to work with him now and his maiden win hinted that there was more to come. Can build on his efforts last campaign. Bentley Brook was a dominant winner at Goulburn last start. Nothing prior had hinted at that performance coming (jumped \$11) but the figures are too hard to ignore. Has to repeat that now which may be the niggles.
