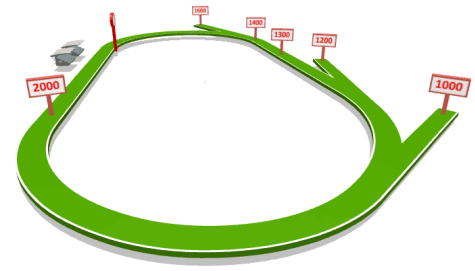

Race Analysis: Getty has been switched to the Kelley barn after a narrow defeat over this course and distance on December 29th. He looks to get the run of the race along from barrier one and his peaks are much higher than what his rivals have produced in their career thus far. The market didn't want Miss Bayles first-up at Hawkesbury, going \$3.90-\$4.60. She doesn't have the peak ratings of Getty, but her consistency is what holds her in good stead. Fitter and firmer are both ticks. Slinky and Super Zippi both had excuses in their debut runs, and both have trialed well coming into this. With plenty of upside, they may be the ones who have value in their price.

Own Them was a Sectional Star at Goulburn in his first AUS run. He was 40-1 there and while the rating holds up, he's hard to have at his current price.

Race Analysis: The first of the feature races and there's plenty of form lines to assess. Kinloch dipped third-up at Randwick but he is known to do that. Ratings from his first two runs this campaign suggests he's right on song for a race like this. Where he lands in running is the big nigger, but his ratings suggest he'd be an above average winner if he returned to form. Vreneli jumped favourite in this event last year, but comes into this edition off a very different setup. Known to spike in his ratings second-up and although the fresh effort was just plain behind Kinloch, we've seen him improve sharply in the past. Coin Toss finds the easiest race he's been in since coming to Australia but there are some queries after trialling just fairly coming in.

Race Analysis: Thunderlips brings the best form into the race, winning his past couple in town. He looks to be hitting his straps now and he's already rated as good as the average Guineas winner and looks to have more to come. Will make his own luck on the speed and take plenty of catching. Port Lockroy didn't get going until he got to a mile last campaign but contested some strong races at the end of his campaign. Where he gets to in the run is a slight niggler, but he's a colt with high expectations. Miss Amore brings the X-factor. Brilliant debut win and now thrown in the deep end, though her debut figures suggest she might float. Tumbling was just too far back on the Kensington last start but looks likely to feature here.

Redstone Well didn't finish off as anticipated last time out after a good win two back. The 8 day backup could see him travel a little better in the run and should be coming at them hard late in the race.

Race Analysis: Adagio looks the horse on the rise after a determined victory at Muswellbrook. Showed plenty of strength to get through the heavy track and pull away from his rivals late. Looks a staying type on the rise and can dictate proceedings from the front. Easy to mark him inside Vaguer who stuck on well first-up over the mile here. He did indicate 2000m would be his go there and he gets a big jockey upgrade with Marquand on board. Looks a race between those two.
