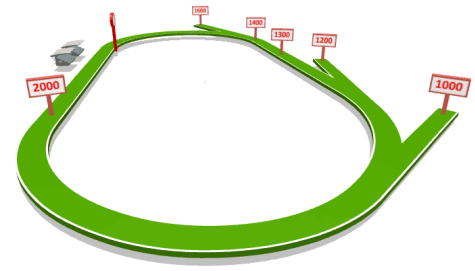

**Race Analysis:** No real desire to get involved in the opener. Jouno was galloped on in the straight last start at Kembla just as he ran to the lead. Should appreciate the drop back to country level and maps to find the front for Beasley. Debut figures have him as the one to beat. Tango Queen creates plenty of interest on debut. Given a solid hit-out in her most recent trial which was the second fastest 801m heat of the morning. She's bred more for strength than speed being by Tivaci, but she looks to have good speed and will use that strength to the line. Lady De Guise was beaten as favourite at Queanbeyan and comes into this with 57 days between runs. Has posted better figures than she did that day and her starting price expected her to be better than she performed. Worth keeping safe.

**Race Analysis:** Difficult to get a handle on this event, but races like these are usually won at the top of the handicap. Prophet Time should be hitting peak fitness now and was very good at Wagga in a tougher race when in the market. Keatings is striking at 14% of late and still claims 2kg. Should be positive from the alley and may prove too tough to run down. Heavenly Prophet went close in a similar race to this in December and comes into this on the fresh side. Over 700 days between wins but the form is there to suggest she's good enough and it's from only two starts ago. Bella Ace held her own in a tougher race at Cowra recently and the figures from last campaign would have her right in the finish in this. Trending the right way and now lands in a suitable assignment. Super Riff may be looking for further but went down in a photo finish in a similar race on the Acton here in July. Has run well second-up previously and has claims from an inside alley. Plenty of chances.

**Race Analysis:** Hasime was a Sectional Star at Goulburn on debut and then ended up in another slow sit-and-sprint last start at Newcastle. Stays at the mile now third-up and although she's drawn a touch awkwardly, she did end up sitting close to the speed at her last start. Has outperformed her market expectation in both runs thus far and now finds her race to shed the maiden tag. Expecting a better effort this time. Taytay Bay is interesting as he rises to the mile now at his fifth start. Form out of his maiden win leaves a lot to be desired, but his racing pattern suggests the mile won't be an issue. Can be an improver. Have to respect Final Reset too. Nice win prior to the break and resumes at the mile fitter for two trials. Can play a role along with Ferghana, who may need some luck but rates amongst them on his last start second.

**Race Analysis:** Phoroneus was huge in the Black Opal here 10 days ago and this is obviously a much easier race. Ignore the first-up run in the Opal Preview as he almost fell shortly after the start. While he does take on the older horses today, the figure he produced in the Opal is much better than what his rivals have put up to date. Was strong through the line in the Opal and if he runs anywhere near that rating, he should be winning this. Major Desire looked to peak on the run late at Goulburn first-up on a day where the track played very poorly. Fitter for that run and sticking at 1300m is a positive sign. Not a whole lot between a few of these but she showed glimpses that there's more to come last start. She gets her chance now. There are some queries around Clever Cookie who is now 40 days between runs after being scratched on veterinary advice on March 5th. Tongue tie and winkers are welcome additions, but the draw makes things tricky.

**Race Analysis:** Keen to back Caring Lass. Backed off the map to win at this track and trip second-up and bolted in by 4.3 lengths. Has held her form since then with her only notable dip being in Midway company at Randwick. Back to a mile off 41 days is an iffy setup, but her recent Warwick Farm trial was superb and the booking of Beasley is worth noting. Clear top pick on her figures. Packer should appreciate the rise in distance after going under as favourite at Bathurst most recently. Penza replacing the apprentice hoop is a big tick. Flying Flossy was a good winner at Nowra last start and peaked when getting to the mile last prep. Nice horse but would have to raise the bar.

**Race Analysis:** This looks to set up nicely for up-and-comer Blue Grotto. Only beaten by a smart one with a big weight first-up and strips fitter for today's assignment. Beautifully placed to find the front and the Stewart stable are in form of late. Returned with a new peak rating and can build on that today. Kattegat is the best horse in the race on exposed form and isn't treated too poorly considering. He's run well over the short course before and if the track ends up on the soft side, then it won't hurt him. Early price looks a little too big. Extravagant Lad continues to build after a long layoff and has bumped into a couple smart ones when at the pointy end of the market his past couple. Has good early speed and can be in this for a very long way.

**Race Analysis:** Keen to play in the last. Scalextrics dipped second-up when on the quick turnaround, but he had been known to do that in his previous campaigns. First-up run suggested he was back on song and now gets back to Country level with Beasley in the saddle. He'll love any sting out of the ground, and he looks the one to beat. Major Ore follows quickened well to shed the maiden tag at Newcastle and he should enjoy the step up in trip. Follows a similar profile to other 3YO winners we've seen here, and the debut win suggested there is more to come. Nettles held on to win as favourite at Scone but didn't do anything out of the ordinary there. Maps for a nice run once more but needs to raise the bar to catch Scalextrics and Major Ore.
