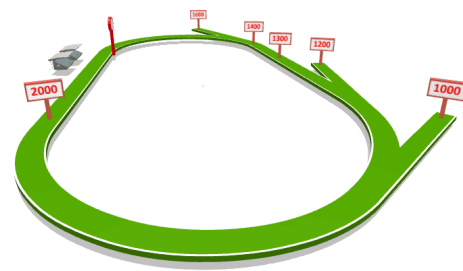

Now joins the Pat Murphy barn after a sound effort at Colac and that figure looks good enough to be winning a maiden at some stage. It's the unknowns that create interest though and Grins is the one I'm most keen to be with of the unraced brigade. Her trial was good back in November last year and there have been a couple of winners come out of it. Looks to have nice ability and can give this a shake on debut. Good Prize looked as though he needed plenty of education in his only public trial but suspect he's come on since then. Wouldn't surprise to see him run a race. Although Mountain Chatter was well beaten in his only trial, there has been plenty of market support both times he's accepted for his debut. That holds plenty of weight.

Race Analysis: Not a race I'm keen to dive into. Rosy Sue had missed a few times recently after beginning her career on the right note. Her last start win suggests she may be getting back to something like her old form and she's still new enough to think there's some more to come. Budler is also going at 18% from his last 50 rides. Geminids has placed 4/5 first-up and those have been in tougher company than this. The trip may bring her undone but she's right in the mix in what looks a suitable assignment. The rest behind them are relatively even.

Race Analysis: Time to open the shoulders. Getty was superb winning here on Black Opal Day before bumping into a very smart one at Goulburn most recently. He led them up there and stuck on well to beat the rest of the field, relatively comfortably. His Opal Day effort here rates highly and he'll run straight to the front for Owen and he's sure to take plenty of catching. Love The Cube won a good maiden at Hawkesbury 34 days ago but the time was by far the slowest on the day by Racing and Sports measure. He was the beneficiary of sitting on that slow speed and while the form has been franked, it's mainly from runners who had no chance off the slow tempo. This looks a different set up. Hold is her own worst enemy, getting herself into bad spots by being slow out of the barriers. A more experienced filly now, the gear changes can help her sit closer and her best form puts her right in the mix.

Capitol Queen and Candlelit rate similarly to each other, but I have a query on just how well both are going at this stage. Happy to let them through to the keeper. Factoring Profit rises in grade but he rattled home here a fortnight ago and the booking of Collett hints at the stable's intent.

Race Analysis: Scratchings make this a hard race to get a handle on. Fascination Alley hits this fourth-up and at her peak. She hit the line strongly at Taree last start after a good maiden victory at Hawkesbury two back. May need some things to go her way but the figures out of her maiden win are up to winning this. Halkis was 80-1 last start but made her presence felt at Kembla Grange on the back of a strong effort here on Opal Day. Has the tactical speed to put herself in the race, it's just her starting prices in recent races that are the niggler. Atomic Forty Seven wasn't far away here in a tougher race a fortnight ago and steps back out to the mile. He's not 0/2 at this trip but does appear to have some class.

Race Analysis: Steely Girl was good behind Code In Time first-up and we'll get a guide on that form earlier in the card. Beaten 3.3L there, but she did spike second-up last campaign and this looks a nice set up for her off the inside. Happy to mark her favourite on ratings. She'll have the sit on Eltoroson who can find the front from barrier two. Just missed at Moruya last start and he has two ratings from the beginning of the campaign that stand right out in this field. He ticks plenty of boxes. Rainagain was beaten 5L over 920m on debut and steps right out to this trip straight away, with the sectionals from his debut suggesting he was finishing off strongly. Wouldn't surprise to see him feature.

He's not only the best horse in the race, but the fastest and he can shoot across from the deep with plenty of time to spare from the 1200m shoot. He'll be forward enough to carry the weight and if he returns in similar form to how he ended last campaign, he'll take plenty of catching. Eastern Glow is the obvious second pick after contesting some strong races last campaign. Nice trial coming in and he'll be right there to pounce.

Race Analysis: Dead Of Night looks a nice horse on the way through. He peaked off a similar setup in his debut campaign and this looks and if he repeats a similar spike in his ratings he'll take plenty of beating. Worth noting that Neasham and Collett strike at 22% when teaming up and he's likely to be forward in running in a race that lacks obvious speed. Jessandi dipped off her solid Opal Day run, with a repeat of that effort putting her right into the frame. She performs best when the pace is right on though and if she gets that today is the query. Bringbackthebears is in the same boat. Region Time flashed home in the Tuggeranong Cup and she can play a major role now up in trip.
