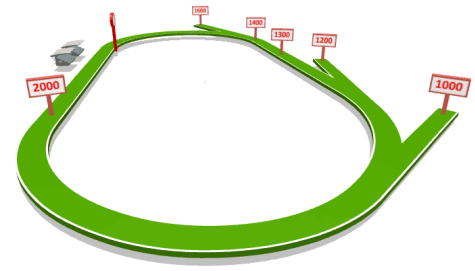

Race Analysis: Thought there was plenty of value around Imasuperstar first-up for the Potter barn. while not winning last campaign in Victoria, he produced ratings good enough to win this race on a number of occasions. While he hasn't trialled publicly, he would've had a couple of private jump outs in readiness. He's the one that appeals most at the early price. Worx was a big drifter when first-up after 434 days, but ran on well to finish in second. The rating there was just fair, but he's expected to have come on from that effort. The rating he produced there isn't far off what Imasuperstar was doing last prep. Now with a run under his belt, he can begin to work back to his best. Siovy Dane has been super this preparation, but all of her form is on rain affected going. Big tick with Penza sticking but it's hard to see any juice in the early price.

Race Analysis: Keen to back Chasing A Quid in the last. Love the fact he's been kept to sprint trips now and it's paid dividends already with back-to-back wins. Chasing the hat-trick now and maps for a similar run to what he had last start when putting his rivals to the sword. The rating he produced there suggests he wouldn't be out of place in Highway company and he's priced up outside Lyrical Beauty who he beat fair and square last time out. She does meet him better at the weights, but Chasing A Quid spotted her a start and gunned her down with ease. Not That Easy won well here 21 days ago but didn't do anything we hadn't seen from her before. She's an exposed mare now and there's nothing to say she's better than what she did when winning last start, while Chasing A Quid might still be on an upward trajectory.
