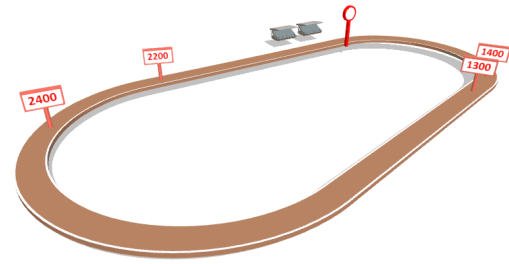

Race Analysis: A competitive card of racing gets underway with some value around Champagne In Lace. Won well first-up before bumping into a good race in tough going at Goulburn most recently. The first-up win was in the same grade as today's event, and she'll carry less weight after the claim of in-form apprentice Coriah Keatings. Worth noting she bolted in by 3L to break her maiden at this track and trip in September. Can find the front and lead the whole way, especially with her closest danger being scratched. White Liar has just been fair in tougher company her past couple, though her form earlier this preparation would see her take it right up to Champagne In Lace. Ratings have White Liar ahead of Love Of Air who was relatively plain on Monday at Queanbeyan, but this looks a suitable race.

Race Analysis: Keen to crack in here with the Vella-trained Chasing A Quid. Was trending the right way and rated a Highway calibre horse with R&S prior to his loss at Wagga most recently. That race was of much higher quality than what he faces today and while he's forced to carry the topweight as a 3YO, I think he's still got a class edge on his rivals. Craving Magic found form at the end of last campaign with good wins at the Sapphire Coast and Orange prior to a spell. While he is looking for the hat-trick, he'll have to make a jump in his ratings first-up which seems unlikely based on what we've seen so far.

Race Analysis: Happy to dodge this tricky maiden where a few of these look evenly matched. Good Prize just missed at Queanbeyan on Monday and a repeat of that effort can see him getting the job done, but the quick turnaround is the query. Grins showed enough on debut and that effort matches what Good Prize produced last start, but she was very plain at Moruya most recently. Now 21 days between runs and back onto her home deck, she can track Good Prize across and make a race of it. Abitsuss was very green in both his trial and debut effort in the Clan O'Sullivan. Will benefit from those outings and the booking of Penza is a nice push for his chances. Hard to line him up though as we're only assuming how much better she could be. Sakimarjuel has had a few goes now and those ratings stack up to what Good Prize and Grins have produced.

Race Analysis: Chop The Ice should be fitter for the first-up effort where he was narrowly edged out at Albury 32 days ago, and he bolted in second-up on the Turf here last campaign. Worth mentioning he broke his maiden when defeating Gundy Guy by 1.3L at this track and trip last preparation. He maps for a lovely run with the speed drawn wide. Was close to his best first-up and with improvement likely, he can knock this off down the bottom of the weights. Incentive and I Am Mamwaazel both have speed and can take catching over this trip, though both have plenty of niggles as well.

Race Analysis: Not interested to get involved in this event with plenty of unknowns. Sir Maurice was competitive in much tougher company last campaign and has trialled well coming into today's assignment. He has a number of ratings last campaign that are right up to winning this event, though first up and what may be a sticky alley are enough doubts to make me look elsewhere. My eyes then turn straight to Allegro Miss who rattled home from the back of the pack in fast time at Goulburn first-up. She was 25-1 there and while she as well beaten off a similar set-up last campaign, this looks a suitable event for her. If she can produce what she hinted at Goulburn, she should be right in the finish. Bounty By Knight stuck on well first-up in Soft going here 28 days ago. Should be close to the speed again and is expected to have come on. Not out of this. Enament's best is good enough to be in the finish of a race like this, though she is first-up off a long break.

Race Analysis: All the main dangers have come out, leaving Siovy Dane as the short favourite and deservedly so. Should roll to the front and make every post a winner with Olivia Chambers' claim coming in handy. Just has to run up to her recent form to be winning. Encantado could be the one to spoil the party if Siovy Dane doesn't show up. He's been a work in progress for the Potter stable, but he has shown glimpses of ability.
