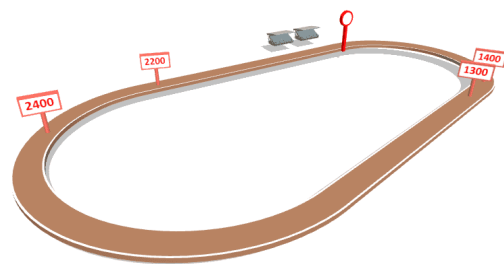

Race Analysis: Leaving Southern Deel out of the market at this stage as she's engaged in Race 5 with a jockey booked. That leaves Bronco Revolution well fancied in the opener following a defeat first-up at Canterbury on May 1. The rating she produced there is good enough to be winning a race like this and the form out of that race has stood up nicely since (1 win, 3 placings from five starters). Her trial since that effort was solid and she appears the one to beat with an inside draw and improvement expected. Fellow Sydneysider Cashaway Gold is better than what she showed at Canterbury 16 days ago and can bounce back third-up into the campaign. She is engaged at Nowra on Thursday, though she's a clear second pick if the stable elects to run here. Pushalot showed good improvement last start when beaten narrowly over this course and distance. Can find the front again and take plenty of catching, but she's still behind what Bronco Revolution produced first-up. Open to further improvement, but she'll need to.

Race Analysis: A lot of the horses in this event are rated similarly, so I'm taking a pace angle in this event and has me leaning the way of Bringbackthebears. Lugged a big weight last start and was run off his feet over the mile last time out at Goulburn and is suited much better to this event as he boasts a good record over this course and distance. May be back in the run, but if he gets the splits turning for home he'll be coming with a head full of steam late in the race. Fil posted a good time and a good rating when taking up the running and winning comfortably at Wangaratta 12 days ago. Suspect the stable will adopt similar tactics today from an outside alley and the Victorian form holds up well in the South/South Eastern racing circuits. He's likely to join Exceedingly Hot out in front who is on the 7-day backup from a good win last time out. Sectional analysis says he didn't get a picnic in front at Albury and he was there to be beaten if they were good enough. His rival's weren't and he can continue his upward trajectory. Dubai Showgirl will appreciate this being both further and easier than her recent outings.

Race Analysis: Not a race I'm overly keen to get involved in early doors, though Forbidden Gemstone should be marked a clear favourite. Bumped into one who jumped second favourite in a Highway last Saturday two starts ago and kept up well when back in trip at Wagga on May 25. Back out to this trip should suit and Martin will play 'catch me if you can' with the 2kg claim. Hard to knock her recent form and appears the one to beat. White Liar has ratings to match, they can just be few and far between. Good over the short course here last start, but got too far back and never looked likely two starts ago. Needs some luck from the barriers, but the ratings are there if she gets the breaks. Papaver Miner is good in this grade and he maps for a similar run to what he had last time out. Won't rise in weight after Bronett Prag's claim and is worth including.

Race Analysis: Another race I'm happy to let through to the keeper. The key chances appear at the top of the weights and on recent performances, Ever Was is easy to mark favourite. While beaten 5.2 and 3.9 lengths in his past couple, the ratings he's produced in those outings are ahead of what his rivals have done recently. He may need some luck from the alley, but Dalton's 3kg claim comes in handy and if he can hold his form, he should be getting the job done. Rapid Impact will put up a good fight though as he drops back into Country grade. Nothing really went right for him at Canterbury last start and getting back to a bigger track and onto a firmer surface are both big ticks. Kanoozi was finishing off well over 1750m last start and is another who should appreciate the extra distance.

She trialed well on this course back on May 17th and the form out of her trial has stacked up nicely with the horses running second and third in that trial both winning. There's no superstars amongst this field and she'd only have to produce an average winning rating for a maiden to be too good for this lot, and she looks to have more talent than that. It shows in the SP's of Oh What A Knight that he was in a soft race last start when nosed out by his stablemate on the line. He didn't do anything different there and the feeling is he would have to be better again now. Vella Icon steps out in trip now which seems the right move.

Race Analysis: Siding with the progressive Zazel in the penultimate event. She disappointed at the end of last campaign as favourite, but her form prior to that was superb when shedding the maiden tag. She maps for a nice run in transit and she still has plenty of upside being early in her career. Expecting her to have come on in the break and if she can run a figure close to what she did at the end of last campaign, she'll take beating. Heart Of Vancouver was only fair first-up at Goulburn, but the winner of that race has since performed well at Randwick (Kensington) on Wednesday. The gear changes is what creates interest, with the blinkers and tongue tie going back on the gelding. Both the stable and jockey are in form at the moment and an improved run is anticipated. Shrimp took a while to win her maiden but did so in impressive style. Expecting her to be prominent in the run and prove hard to catch.

Race Analysis: Cracking federal to finish the day. Craving Magic was a dominant winner first-up over this track and trip and wasn't disgraced in much tougher company down at Sandown last week. Drops in weight today and suspect he can improve again third-up and back to this trip. Looks to get a beautiful run and can bounce back to winning ways. Love Shuck turned down a Federal here a fortnight ago and landed on a bog track at Rosehill with the races called off shortly after his run. Put a line through that and assess him on his prior form which suggests he's a progressive type on the way up. Heywood getting down to 56.5kgs is a big indicator on how well Love Shuck is travelling. Giving Merc a good chance here. His best form of recent times has been when fresh and that's what he is today. Never a chance in the Wagga Town Plate, but he sat up on the speed and couldn't be caught on the Turf here two back. Should land in a prominent position and be presented at the right time to strike. While drawn wide, Ferrari Girl possesses plenty of speed and appears the only leader of the race. She may be able to run them off their feet as she did last time out.
