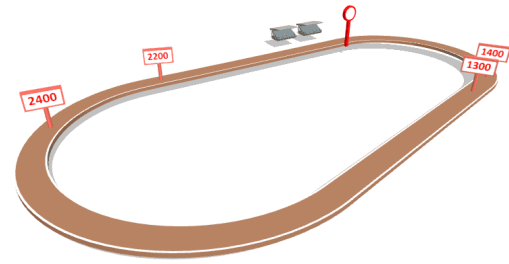

**Race Analysis:** Siovy Dane was a savage drifter last start, being \$1.70 race morning before drifting to jump a \$3 chance and bolting in by 8.2 lengths over this course and distance. That run is clearly the best of this group and she'd just have to run close to what she did there to be winning again. She has plenty of early speed and should be making every post a winner again... we just need the drift again! Ferrari Man has been in good races since finishing 0.9L away in this grade at Queanbeyan first-up. Back to this level looks ideal and there appears to be some value around him at a longer price.

**Race Analysis:** The scratching of the top weight leaves this open for up-and-comer Dreaming Of Vegas. He's posted good ratings without winning this time in work, and rates a Highway calibre horse with Racing and Sports. The only time he's been to 1200m was on the Turf course here in May 2023, where he bumped into last month's Wagga Town Plate winner. He looks ready for the rise in trip now and he wouldn't have to improve his ratings all that much to be getting the job done. Chasing A Quid gave them too much of a head start last time out and paid the price at the finish. He is better than what he showed there and sitting closer in the run will help his chances, though his peak ratings don't match up to those of Dreaming In Vegas. Get Shafted wasn't far behind Chasing A Quid last start and has claims, but he usually needs a few things to go his way.

**Race Analysis:** Pick of the form on Racing and Sports numbers is the maiden over this course and distance on May 17 where Oh What A Knight ran into second, beaten a length. The pace was good on that occasion and while there doesn't appear to be too many pace influences in the race, Barrett may be able to take a chance and hunt forward from the draw. His form around this trip is handy and if he can run up to what he did here last start, he should be going one better. Villach is an interesting horse joining the John Rolfe barn. He ran superb splits over 1856m last time out, but his best form has been around 1200-1300m in his earlier runs. The form out of his past couple of races has been handy and if he can bring those figures to the Acton track, he's in this race up to his ears. Enament had good support first-up off a long break. May have needed the hit out on that occasion and an improved run is expected.
