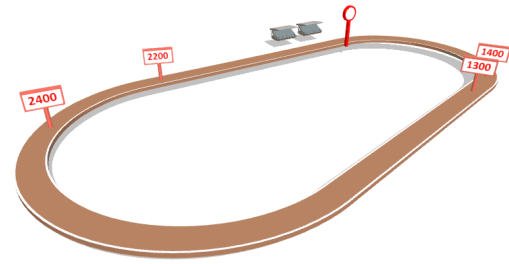

Race Analysis: No real interest early in the day. Papaver Miner is looking for the hat-trick after a good win over 1206m last time out. The figures there are solid in the context of the race, but don't stand out by any means. Redneck Princess bring some 'fresh blood' into the race having raced around in Victoria her past three. There's a few figures in there that say she's up to winning a race like this and there's already been a winner come out of her last start, though she can be hard to trust at times. Don't Thinkaboutit and Inveterate both come through the same race were the former had Inveterate's measure, with those figures standing up alongside the other chances in the race.

Race Analysis: Some good quality in this Class 1 and Joe Pride brings Star Diesel down to the Acton with plenty of upside. The gelding was caught in the worst part of the track first-up at Goulburn in an effort that's not really worth assessing. His form from last campaign stacks up well, producing ratings clear of what his rivals have done. Nick Heywood can have the gelding handy from the barrier and if he can run up to the figures he produced last campaign, he can get back to winning ways. Kenyan Charm looks an improver and the ratings from her debut preparation on good surfaces suggest she's better than what we've seen this far. Both the firmer Acton surface and the drop back to Country level look key pillars in her recapturing her form from last campaign. You Wish has been good her past couple, though she was an \$11 at Wagga last time and a \$10 chance at Goulburn prior. She's now single figures in a race where you can make strong points for a couple of gallopers who have better ratings to their name.

Race Analysis: Keen to continue on the 'Pride Procession' with Rickythesteamboat coming down. He loomed up as a big chance at Hawkesbury first-up before peaking on the run late and finishing 2.3L off the winner. He does appear to lack gate speed, though a genuine tempo is expected and he'll strip fitter for the first-up effort. He'll appreciate the easier grade and with improvement expected, he can get the job done. Madame Society was well beaten on debut in April, though the form out of that race was solid. She's been given a sneaky trial in readiness for today and it wouldn't surprise to see her right in the finish. Champ De Mars wasn't disgraced when 20-1 at Wyong first-up and is expected to sit much closer from an inside alley today. That's how she usually produces her best figures, and a return to that level will see her right in the finish. Surprised to see Daicos at the top of betting. He's had plenty of tries now and while the Kelley stable and Jack Martin are in form, his prior efforts are easy to poke holes in.

Race Analysis: Just Easy brings the best exposed form into the race and while she hasn't set the world alight at the trials, the addition of Blinkers today is of note. Every rating she has run to in her five outings is better than what her rivals has produced, she'll just need to be at that level fresh and onto the Acton surface. Pushalot will put up a good fight through on the 9-day turnaround and up in trip for the first time. She's been knocking on the door for a little while now and she's expected to put herself right up on the speed. She'll give them something to chase. Otono creates some interest, debuting over the 1280m today. She's by The Autumn Sun and both trials have been over sprint trips, so getting out to this distance first-up could see her out-perform what she's shown at the trials. Vella Icon was game when posted wide last time out and should get an easier time of it again today, though she'd have to raise the bar to get to what Just Easy has produced.

Race Analysis: All Astern was well beaten as favourite at Albury, but the winner was placed at Corowa on Monday and the third horse won at Albury on Tuesday. The first-up effort rates well and she's expected to be close to the speed under Keatings. She's easy to mark favourite, though her and Chief Witness should be closer together in the market. The wide draw stings, but he turned in a bold effort when not in the best going at Kembla Grange last start and this is an easier event. While he is drawn wide, he possesses good early speed and if he's within striking distance at the turn, he can land the knockout blow. Much like Chief Witness, Ferrari Girl ended up in the worst going at Moruya when tiring badly. Her two efforts here prior were great and she's expected to take up the running from a good draw. Won well in similar grade here on June 1 and has claims. Endorsement ran well on the same day, but that was a much easier event. He was also 25-1 and given a great ride by Dalton, so there's a few niggles to him holding his spot in the early market.

Race Analysis: Tricky Federal with a number of these more than capable on any given day. Love Shuck deserves to be favourite after sticking on gamely here on June 14th. He faced the breeze off a strong tempo that day and was feeling the pinch late in proceedings. Back to 1000m may see him able to take a sit from gate three and with a softer run in transit, it wouldn't surprise to see him return to winning ways. Light Press was great last campaign if you take away her two runs in town. She's 2/2 on the Acton and has won 2/5 fresh. Martin's claim comes in handy and if she's up to the mark, she'll take plenty of catching. Devine Miss might be the one to land the knockout blow if they overdo it up front. She's been off the scene since September last year, but she trialed sweetly on June 22 and that trial form has been solid. The booking of Taylor suggests she's ready to go first-up and she'll be flying down the outside over the closing stages. The locally-trained Fangela is a rocket first-up and while he has to carry the big weight, he has earned that. He'll need some luck from the alley though but there's no denying he's good enough. Happy to push the early price of Spinosaurus despite looking for the hat-trick. He ran the slowest time of the day at Goulburn last start, much slower than the Fillies & Mares race prior and 2YO winner in the race after, both over the same course and distance.

Race Analysis: Quadratic essentially blew herself up in the SA Fillies Classic 60 days ago, setting up a quick time from the front. She was tough on that occasion, following up from her maiden victory at Bendigo the start prior. She has moved into the Matt Kelley barn since her run in South Australia and although drawn wide, she should have the speed to get across from out wide. She'll appreciate a solid tempo and if she can be prominent in the run, she'll be asking a lot of her rivals to try and reel her in. Margaret's Missile looks an improver second-up and out to this distance. She's likely to be back in the run, but with a genuine tempo anticipated, it'll bring her right into play. Slipstreaming has been disappointing so far this campaign but this is a completely different scenario. Back onto a good deck and out in trip can see him improve and he'll need to if he is to challenge for the win.
