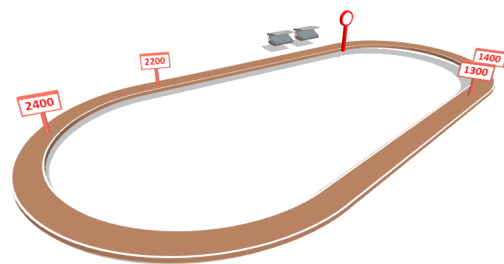

Race Analysis: Good race to kick things off with differing formlines. United Front has returned to his QLD figures since stepping out to 2000m, leading all the way to win well at Wodonga last time out. Suspect the stable have figured him out now and his on-pace racing pattern suits the Acton surface. While he has never won on a Good rated track, he has run similar numbers to the figure that saw him win last time out. Blind Date was good once he got into the clear at this track and trip last start, running a good time in the process. She's had a few goes now, but there are a few ratings from last campaign that are well above what the rest of the field have been doing of late. It's just a question of whether she's at that level now or not. Firealarm beat home Blind Date here last time out and gets the blinkers off this time. Ticking along well and getting out further may help his chances. Highness was a bit of a 'nothing' run first-up at Moruya, losing his spot turning for home and ending up in the bad part of the track. Straight out to this trip suits and a sharp turnaround in form wouldn't surprise.

Race Analysis: Happy to let this race go through to the keeper. Penciled is now onto his third trainer after a brief stint in Victoria and hasn't been missed by the handicapper in this event. Martin's 2kg claim is welcomed and he should put himself close to the speed, both big ticks in these sorts of races. Hard to nail him down though with Don't Thinkaboutit, Papaver Miner and Skepticism all coming out of the same race. Don't Thinkaboutit got the win there but will meet his rivals worse at the weights this time, as well as drawing a wider barrier. Papaver Miner may appreciate the extra trip but will need to improve on recent efforts to turn the tables on Don't Thinkaboutit. Skepticism was first-up there and she is a second-up winner in the past. With improvement likely, she can be in the finish again, though all those horses just mentioned are hard to trust. Russian Rose is a maiden still looking for her breakthrough and hasn't been beaten far in maiden's at this course. Wouldn't be surprised if she's the one punters back, but like many of them, she's had plenty of chances.

Race Analysis: Call me former Australian Test Cricket opener Chris Rogers because I'm shouldering arms once more in this. O'Hellyeah was fancied at Albury but bumped into what looks a smart one there with good margins put through the rest of the field. That rated on the lower side of average for Maiden's at Albury and while improvement is expected, there are a number with ratings to match. Comb Over Con can be a bit hit-or-miss, though when he hits, they are solid ratings that stack up in a field like this. He's placed 4/5 on the synthetic surface and is expected to be right there in the finish again. Exotic Dancer comes into this with just one trial at Warwick Farm to her name. There was nothing special about that outing, but the unknowns about her keep her strong in the market. Vella Icon is better than she showed last start and can bounce back without surprising. Dollythediva is another who hasn't been far away of late and wouldn't surprise to see her in the finish.

Race Analysis: Thinking there could be some value about Go Ellie Go in this event. She was set alight from the wide alley and did too much work through the middle stages, just missing out on victory. Sectional analysis from that race suggests she was a good thing beaten and if McGuirk can roll along at a more even speed, she'll take plenty of catching from out in front. Burgundy Girl is also appealing. She got into a slow race over an unsuitable trip at Queanbeyan last week, blowing out the cobwebs following a short freshen. She was strong through the line there and her best efforts are when she gets a genuine speed to run at, which it looks as though this race will be. Can see her sitting closer than last start and being there to strike when asked. Breaking Ground is an interesting horse who took a liking to the Gold Coast Poly track in QLD before joining the John Nisbet barn. He's only been out to this trip once before but put up solid enough figures on that occasion. Hard to have off his latest effort, but there are excuses there and it wouldn't surprise to see him turn things around.

Race Analysis: Looks a two-horse race. Hurricane Ablowing had promised the world and delivered an atlas until last start when winning over the 1206m journey here. This looks a prime race to adopt similar tactics and build into the race. The horse he beat ran second at Wyong on Thursday afternoon. He got back to something like he promised early doors with his win last start and now he can go on with the job. His main danger appears to be Chop The Ice, though the 3YO has been a little up and down of late. His past two have been on a deteriorating Goulburn surface, with his form prior right up to what Hurricane Ablowing produced last start. He jumped favourite here in a Bm75 Federal on June 17th. Back onto a good track can see the local galloper put his best foot forward.

Race Analysis: Cracking Federal to round out the card. Starliv comes off a great run down in Ballarat with the stable chasing the synthetic racing surface. The time put up there was good, as was the rating she produced to finish second. She's went close to winning in a similar event on June 1st at this course and distance and she's likely to take up a prominent position from the draw. The one to beat if she runs up to her latest effort. Happy to have Fangela inside his stablemate La Sante. Fangela was good here a last month under the big weight and gets some relief this time around. He was good late in the piece and rising out to this distance is a big tick for him. I think he possesses more speed than La Sante who has been performing well in tough and well run races over further. He may be able to hold a closer position which will help his chances, but there's not a whole lot of edge in his morning price. Look Only creates some interest at longer odds. She's been disappointing in town of late, though when coming back for the Defense Force Cup at Queanbeyan, she held her own. Worth including in exotics and quaddies.
