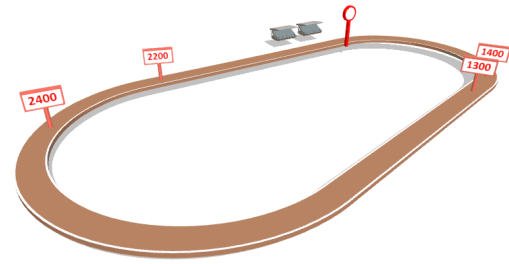

Race Analysis: Tricky race to kick us off on Acton Track Grand Final Day, the early market a fair representation. Jukebox Money is the fresh runner and gets a key jockey booking in JVO. There wasn't a great deal asked of him when tacking on soundly behind some better ones in a 900m Open trial. It Is To Be from the Emma Murphy stable does hold some appeal. He warmed to his task nicely on debut here in late July when sneaking a run up the fence to grab fourth. Never looked likely last start at Wagga but was again doing his best work late. Achieve Perfection hasn't shown enough to justify favouritism but respect stable/rider combination. Hopes don't end there.

Anticipating Krogh to burn across from the wide draw and be in it for a very long way and the good map does make him tempting. Khaleej got home best here last start in this grade. Loves it here and I don't see him regressing. Penciled was good here late when resuming last month and while he's a likely improver, he has an almighty job ahead of him from the wide gate and 63kgs on his back. Hermosa Rosa faded here fresh but will improve with that run under her belt.

The lightly raced five-year-old Phobos was only sound when sent out as favourite at Gosford in April but looks to have progressed nicely during the break. Fitter for two handy trials, one sneakier than the other. I think he can make a bright return. Moonlight Gambler is sure to have improved off his debut placing and draws well for Heywood. Bottler returns and while this looks short of a preferred trip, he could cause a scare late.

Race Analysis: Cyborg was closing hard on Departing Bullet in the key lead-up to the Polytrack Stayers Cup a fortnight ago, with the latter holding on. Cyborg is better suited over the longer trip and gets a handy weight swing on the winner who was starting to curl up late in the piece. The early market support adds to confidence. Knights Armour has come up short in early betting. Can definitely make a case for him on recent form but is yet to see the syntho and is dropping back 600m from Wagga. No better than the local form and current price too skinny. Burgundy Girl continues to save the line but is her own worst enemy.

Race Analysis: Former Sydneysider Avonview found better form for the new stable last start at Wagga. The rise in trip looks perfect fourth-up with hot-hand hoop Heywood piloting. Confident we see him relish the 1900m. Mariner's Dream is another that will appreciate the longer journey. Yet to score so gets in light. Blind Date is also staggeringly still a maiden after 18 attempts. Was denied a head here two back by Firealarm who she now meets 4kgs better. Map doesn't read favourably again but ran the splits late last time (not for the first time...) and can again. Firealarm has boosted her form since hitting the Acton but this looks tough.

Race Analysis: We are treated to another competitive edition of the Sprinters Cup. It's Tulla Park who comes up favourite on the back of two strong performances on the Acton, however I'm not sure the inside pillar will favour him. Bon Frankie returns and while he's yet to be tested on the Acton, he shoulders the superior form-lines. He was desperately unlucky not to get a start in the Country Championships, finishing third in both the Qualifier and Wildcard. Hasn't been sighted at public trials but I'm confident Clarke will have him ready to go. Fangela should be peaking fourth-up. Has the 2kg claimer sticking to aid the big weight as he steps out to a trip he relishes. Gogol was strong at the finish to get the chocolates at Wagga. Should eat up the extra 200m and let rip again. Prophet's Pride dug deep to fend off Tulla Park last start. Can give another great sight. Miss Ostend was good here two back and is another that holds claims.

Race Analysis: Everido returns and is back sprinting. Took a strong account of himself in the Listed Canberra Guineas earlier in the year and is the clear class horse. Martin knows him well and he has a bank of ratings that have him marked out for better races. Russian Snitzel has been hammered in early betting off the back of a brave front-running performance in town. That rating stands up to Everido if he can repeat it around here. Gets a key booking of JVO from an advantageous draw. Shelly's Ace will be keeping RS honest in the early stages drawn alongside. Gets a weight pull on the top two and looks the only other danger.
