Race Analysis: Not a race I'm looking to get involved in. Gary Portelli holds the cards with the top two in the market, with Sir Maurice just peaking on his run late at Queanbeyan. That rates highly among this field and with improvement expected, he's a deserved favourite. Bubble Tea is hard to line up after chasing home a dominant winner here a week ago. Form out of that race was franked just a couple of days later and the extra journey should help. Bubble Tea's form ties in through Flashy Icon who finished a long way off at the Sapphire Coast on debut. She was an eye catcher behind the winner there, though more is needed from her on this occasion. Sooby Rose comes through a slower race on the same card but has

Race Analysis: Been some early support around for Maikrow and it's easy to see why. He wasn't disgraced in his first campaign in much tougher company than he'll face today and this guy profiles similarly to stablemate Weeping Woman who bolted in here a fortnight ago. He might just have too much class for this field and his trials suggest he's right up to the mark. Champ De Mars was good over this track and trip last start and while she's fit and going, she'd have to make a jump to catch up to what Maikrow's done thus far. Rowdy Shebang has ratings similar to Champ De Mars, though over further than the 1080m trip today. Won a recent trial and Martin booked are both positives, but happy to mark her longer than her early quote.

Race Analysis: No real desire to get involved in this race. Champagne In Lace went a touch too hard at Ballarat when chasing the synthetic tracks last start. She does race well over this course and distance though and she'll be burning across from out wide to put herself on the speed. Ticks plenty of boxes, but horses like Don't Thinkaboutit have ratings to match, as does Khaleej from tougher races at Albury of late. Hermosa Rosa has performed well first-up in the past and has claims with Penza booked.

Race Analysis: Interesting race where settling positions will be key as there's not a lot between them. Burgundy Girl gets a little drop in weight following a close-up third, hitting the line locked together with Tip Top Timing and Departing Bullet. Hoping the apprentice can hold a closer position this time around and she can go a couple better with a slightly better run in transit. Crystal Waters is an interesting galloper, coming back off Midway races. She's performed well around this area previously and she maps to sit much closer than we've seen her in recent efforts. I think she's going better than her form suggests and a return to her best would see her right in the finish. Departing Bullet was strong to the line last start when just edged out and should be fitter again. Looks to get a slightly easier run this time and is right in the mix. Loose Love is also thereabouts coming back from midweek grade. He'll make his own luck up front, though out to this trip for the first time is a niggle. Tip Top Timing got the job done over a couple of these last time out but meets them worse at the weights and is likely to be giving them a head start.

Race Analysis: Zazel was trending the right way before getting into the slow going at Moruya on a heavy track. Back onto the Acton and out in trip appears the right recipe, though the draw is a little sticky. I still think she's trending the right way though and the scratching of Exotic Dancer leaves the door wide open for her. Just needs to be within striking distance turning for home. At the other end, Ferrari Girl seems to have been forgotten despite placing in this grade two starts ago. There doesn't appear to be whole lot of speed in the race which should allow Teaghan Martin to come across and assume control. She's proved hard to beat with those tactics before and it wouldn't surprise to see her get back to something like her best.

Race Analysis: Chop The Ice bolted in a fortnight ago at this track and trip, but there is more than meets the eye there. He led, kicked away and won, but by Racing and Sports measure, the time was slower than what Tulla Park produced when winning the Federal on the same card. He mightn't be able to lead this time with Prophet's Pride and Ready To Humble engaged which is also a little niggle. Worth noting, he jumped \$1.60 in a Federal here on June 17th (1080m that day) off the exact same rating he ran a fortnight ago. speaking of Prophet's Pride, she's racing well without winning this campaign and faces the easiest grade of race she's been in since March 2023. She'll roll to the front from barrier three and her recent ratings stack right up in this field. She'll take some catching now she's at peak fitness. Tulla Park was put on the speed and his strength shone through to run away and win by a length despite being caught wide and without cover throughout. Drawn wide again, though Boudvillian may adopt similar tactics which would see his chances increase drastically.

Race Analysis: Blind Date was gunned down late by Firealarm last start after overtaking the Portelli trained runner inside the final furlong. That form doesn't leap off the page and with not much speed engaged, Craft may end up controlling things from out in front. His recent figures stack right up in this field and the extra journey won't be an issue if he gets it all his own way out in front. Craft's tactical advantage and the race shape makes Blind Date a big niggle at her current quote, despite the big weight swing in her favour from last start. Whilst she was a touch unlucky turning for home, she shot through with 300m to go for JVO and was unable to put the race away when it was hers for the taking. She'll be a long way back from the wide draw and she'll need some improvement to be running down Craft from the front. Firealarm has some claims after a good run here two back when on the speed. Knuckled down last start to beat Blind Date but the weight swing is an issue.
