### Canberra Community Chest

When: Sunday, 24 November 2024

What: The Canberra Community Chest will be Canberra's equal richest race with \$250,000 up for grabs, \$200,000 prizemoney plus a \$50,000 community chest for the 12 charity and community partners

The race will feature 12 runners with one charity and community partner designated for each runner

The Canberra Community Chest will be a Quality Open Handicap over 1400m which is limited to 12 runners.

Why: Community giving. Each partner will receive portion of the \$50,000 community chest based on the finishing position of their designated horse. The partner with the winning horse will receive \$25,000 and the last placed horse will receive \$1,000.

Who: Charities and community groups with a meaningful connection to the Canberra region (further details follow)

**How:** Applications are via Thoroughbredpark.com.au and close at 5pm, Wednesday, 27 September 2023







### Eligible Partners

You may be eligible to apply for a Partner Slot in the Canberra Community Chest if either:

- (a) You are a Registered Charity, Community Group, or Sporting Club based in:
  - (a) the Australian Capital Territory ('ACT');
  - (b) Queanbeyan-Palerang Regional Council area; or
  - (c) the Yass Valley Council area, or
- (b) You are an equine welfare related charity.

If you are a Registered Charity, Community Group, or Sporting Club the following conditions apply:

- 1. Registered Charities must be endorsed as having DGR status;
- 2. Community Groups must have a clear and demonstrated mission to serve the local community;
- 3. Community Groups must not have annual income exceeding \$3,000,000 in the preceding financial year;
- 4. Sporting Clubs must a clear and demonstrated mission to serve the local community through the promotion of a sport or activity; and
- 5. Sporting Clubs must not have annual income exceeding \$3,000,000 in the preceding financial year.

The Canberra Racing Club reserves the right to exclude any potential Partner from participating in the Canberra Community Chest in its absolute discretion, including if:

- 1. the potential Partners values do not align with the Canberra Racing Club values; or
- 2. that potential Partner could bring the Canberra Racing Club into disrepute.

An independent selection committee will determine the 10 most appropriate partners with Pegasus an automatic selection after their horse was late scratching in 2023, all either eligible applicants then entering a public vote to determine the 12<sup>th</sup> and final partner.

# Partner Obligations

- 1) Partners of the Canberra Community Chest will be encouraged to:
- a) Promote the 'Canberra Community Chest' on their website, social media channels, and other relevant platforms
- b) Inspire their supporters and members to participate in the event
- c) Be named and promoted as a 'partner' of the 'Canberra Community Chest' race in all relevant promotional materials.


