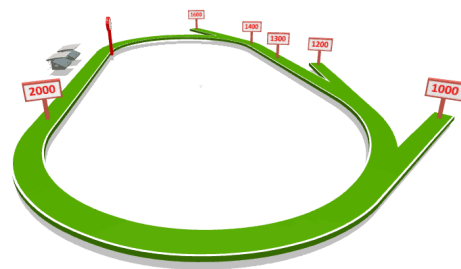

**Race Analysis:** Keen to play in the first where the Matt Dale-trained Pauji Power is the one to beat. He was huge last start at Moruya when he kept finding late in the race despite being off the bit with 600m remaining. It was his best performance since breaking his maiden at Moruya back in March, but it was also the first time we'd seen him in a strongly run race. The time out of his last start is great and he wasn't stopping as they hit the post. Out to this trip now is a big tick and this race looks ripe for his picking. Pretty Please and Dressel tie in together. Pretty Please beat home Dressel by 3.8L at Moruya on August 18th and the former's recent run over 1800m at Bathurst was solid. Ready for this trip now, but still has to improve a touch to be with Pauji Power. As for Dressel, he was good back to 1460m at Queanbeyan last start, but out to this trip sharply is a big niggle as he's only been beyond the mile once. Monomakh was closing off strongly behind Pauji Power last start and is worth plenty of thought.

**Race Analysis:** Not a race I'm looking to bet into, especially with the AFL Grand Final moments away! Wegotabetterhoffa was strong last start over 930 at Moruya and will handle the sting out of the ground. She beat some more fancied rivals there and the rating stacks up. She appears well placed in this, though the early price is giving nothing away. Field Agent was good last campaign, and the booking of Cahill suggests the gelding is in good order for the Kirkup Barn. Don't Thinkaboutit and Papaver Miner have shown that there's not a lot between the two in their recent efforts. Rosy Sue's trial here recently was sound, but others are preferred with her first-up and with a 4kg claimer engaged from a sticky draw.

**Race Analysis:** Another early favourite that looks as though it'll jump shorter than its current quote is Goodnight Barlow. Competitive in some good races at Provincial level in his debut campaign, he posted figures there good enough to be winning a race of this calibre first-up. He did his best work through the line and after the post in his recent Hawkesbury trial and this distance fresh appears ideal. He has much more upside than a lot of his rivals in this field and Scorse strikes at 23% when riding for Ible. Glory Start tends to mix his form, though his good days see him at the pointy end of a race of this strength. There's been plenty of form out of his past two starts and his is easier than what he's been contesting of late. Drawn nicely slightly back in trip, if he's on you can have him marked inside some of his rivals. Kalimba sat on the speed and faded over 1200m fresh at Bathurst and was a 12-1 chance there. Out in trip for the first time but should get plenty of favours with the 2kg claim coming in handy. Would need to go to a level we haven't seen her at yet, though she isn't exposed enough to suggest that rating is out of her reach. Ferghana has had a few goes now and was in the right position to strike fresh at Newcastle. He's been placed second-up previously and he looks to get a nice run once again for Jack Martin. Fitter now and deserves respect.

**Race Analysis:** Interesting race with a lot of these evenly matched. Things look to set up nicely for Easy Company this time though back to 1400m and with a bit of sting out of the ground. She looked a winning hope down the straight at Moruya last start, but it looked as though she failed to run out the trip. She maps to get a lovely run under Glenn Cahill who has made a good start to his career down this way. Suspecting most of her rivals, such as Breaking Ground and Hurricane Coni will be behind her in the run. Breaking Ground is way back in grade, though he's anticipated to get a long way back in the run under Olivia Dalton. He brings the best peak ratings into this event though and that holds plenty of weight with many of these horses already as good as they're going to get. Prince Papa pulled up with an issue when tiring from the front at Moruya as favourite, pulling up with a cough. He comes back to this trip now but should be prominent from the outset which is a key form pointer in races like this. Red Redemption beat home Hurricane Coni last time out, where it looked like the latter peaked on the run late. Suspect there's good improvement to come from Hurricane Coni and he gets a weight swing in his favour this time.

**Race Analysis:** Clearly bringing the best form into the race is Danny's St Darci. Newly acquired by the Matt Dale barn, she resumed with a solid run in Listed company at Moonee Valley last start with that form holding up well at a higher level. She draws a good marble for the 3kg apprentice which should see her get her chance in the running. While there is plenty to like about Danny's St Darci, the pull in the weights of Gogol also appeals. He was narrowly beaten at Moruya last start when running along from in front and can take up a similar position this time around. He meets those rivals better at the weights today and the booking of Matthew Cahill is a big tick. Will be prominent in the run and in this for a very long way. Laurel Hill comes back to 1200m which is a slight niggler, though she was improving at good intervals earlier this campaign. I think she's better over further, but if she can run up to her recent figures he'll be right there to strike. Devine Miss edged out Gogol last start and out to this trip now isn't an issue. Suspecting this is a kick off point for Invertational with races like Gundagai's Snake Gully Cup and the Community Chest here on November 24th what the stable may have their eyes on.
