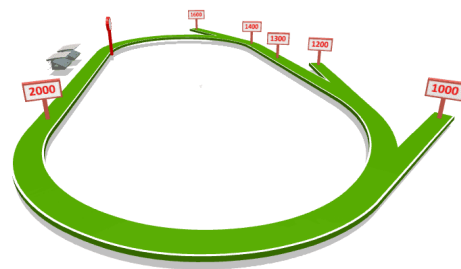

He should be able to sit closer in the run this time around and he has ratings right up to his rivals who he is getting weight off. Suspect he can improve now and get back to winning ways. Louie's Legacy beat Chairman's List fair and square at Goulburn in a strong Bm66 over the mile. Louie race to a new peak there second-up and this looks a better set up for him today. Has to back that effort up but he seems about his right price for a gelding who hasn't won in a little while. Chairman's List replaces the apprentice hoop with JVO today and should get his chance from a favourable alley. Happy to take on both Cyborg and Dubai Centre who have found their best form away from the mile.

Race Analysis: Champagne In Lace is a deserved favourite after scratchings. The map looks kinder to her as well with Cahill probably able to scoot across from the draw and take up the running. Concussion Plates going on is a niggler, but her form stacks up highly in this event raced around a lot of these lately. She was a winner over this track and trip fresh and is the one to beat again. Dollywood was better over 1206m on the Acton last start after possibly finding them a little sharp first-up. Back to 1000m now, but JVO rides and he should be hitting his peak third-up. Papaver Miner and Skaifee have minor claims. Walk Up Start resumes today and while the market has him short, I'm happy to be right against him in this. His last win was a heavy track 1400m at Gundagai and his best form is all over a trip further than this. Happy to just watch him today.

Serial Offender disappointed at Moruya first-up after a promising campaign earlier this year. She's obviously better than she showed there and Louise Day hopping back in the saddle can see her play a role. Xceptional Fella stuck on well in a trial at Wagga recently which was the second-fastest 1000m trial on the day. The stable gets Owen in the saddle who is in form of late and it wouldn't surprise to see him salute on debut. The same could be said for Oaky Doaks who trialled behind some smart gallopers at Goulburn recently.

Race Analysis: Ceremonious led them up at a sedate speed last start and was outsprinted down the straight at Newcastle. Suspect he may be better with some more speed in the race, and he looks to get that in his favour today. Magorrian should have him up on the speed from the inside alley and getting out to this trip for the first time can see him shed the maiden tag. Diamond Discovery goes out to this trip second-up after running on well over a mile at Newcastle on the same day as Ceremonious. The niggles is she's expected to end up back in the run from a wide alley and she'll have to give Ceremonious weight despite being rated similarly to him. Taumata sustained a long run over 1750m on the Acton track on August 9 and has been kept up to the mark with a recent trial. He looks well placed in this and had the measure of Craft that day who now steps out to this trip for the first time.

Race Analysis: Siding with the Waterhouse & Bott galloper Satin Shimmer in this event. Did the work from the front at Muswellbrook first-up and was strong to the line, pulling away late to shed the maiden tag in fine style. Easy to think there's more to come from her and she already rates there alongside her main market rivals with another ratings leap anticipated. Putting Narrative next with the aid of an inside draw which may see her sit a little closer in the run. She was strong behind a progressive type at Hawkesbury last start, following the leader through the traffic but was unable to land a blow late in the race. The John Thompson barn is flying of late, and she's expected to be in the finish as she drops into Country grade. Happy to push Dupli Kate in early betting. She comes here off a 56 day freshen and is likely to get back in the run for Matthew Cahill. She comes out of a good form race last start, but it's interesting to see her ratings are in a very tight bunch with little variance run-to-run. That's a bit of a niggles, though getting onto a firm surface today may see that chance.

Fitter for two trials coming in and she'll get her chance from the draw. Win The Day is hard to line up as she's lightly raced and on the way up. Now out to 1300m, but she was great in tough conditions at Gundagai last time out. Alysha Collett booked is a big tick and she has the upside to be able to go past her rivals now.

Race Analysis: Competitive Federal. Laurel Hill has gone to another level since join the Rob Potter yard, posting a new peak when winning at Moruya last time out. He did get to the right part of the track after sitting off a strong speed, but this appears to set up similarly. Beat a couple of key rivals there and doesn't rise in weight. Wouldn't surprise to see him round these rivals up again. La Sante started \$3.50 in that race and ended up 2.3L off Laurel Hill at the finish. He does get a weight swing in his favour today and getting back on top of the ground may suit. Racing well without winning this time in and is a leading chance in this event. Belleistic Kids was caught wide in the Goulburn Cup and will find this easier than his past couple of efforts. His best trip may be a mile, but he maps well in this and his recent figures are good enough to win a race like this. Thinking the locally trained Fangela gets his chance now. He's been race well over the shorter trips and now gets out to 1400m. Jeff Penza replaces the apprentice hoop which is a key. Expect him to sit closer today and be fighting out the finish. Stablemate Best Intent went a little hard in front at Moruya last time and is better than what she showed there.

Race Analysis: Plenty of converging form lines in the last. Longinus has been beaten as favourite his first two career outings and now comes up the biggest price of his career in arguably his easiest assignment. That's very appealing, though it does look as though he's had every possible his past couple and has been unable to put his rivals away. Despite that, he rates well among his rivals in this field and if they can negotiate the sticky alley, he'll put his best foot forward. This trip looks as though it's the absolute minimum for Flying Argento who was hard ridden in his latest trial a long way out but continued to find under those urgings. Was tested in G3 company last campaign so the stable must have an opinion of him. Suspect this suits much better and he's sure to be strong late. Rishuu was out the back and never really got a crack at them first-up at Kembla. Now gets out in trip with the blinkers on and Nick Heywood in the saddle. There's plenty to like. Iceman was a sectional star at Goulburn just three starts ago. He's been well beaten in Midweek company since and he's very intriguing getting back to Country grade. Worth plenty of thought.
