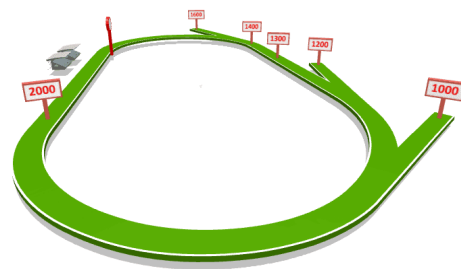

Anticipating she'll be better over a touch further, though she has plenty of class and closed off well in both of her 1000m runs in her career thus far. Hou Long Gwai is on debut for the Freedman's. His trials have only been fair coming in and Dressed In Gray has trialed better than him in my opinion. She was meant to run yesterday at Kembla Grange and was backed there, though with that meeting postponed, she lobs here in what looks a suitable race.

Race Analysis: I think the top of the handicap is the place to be in this BM50 event. Forbidden Gemstone has been going around at long odds in tougher races than this her past couple, beaten 4.7L in a CL2 at Wagga last time out. This looks to suit much better and she'll make her own luck up on the speed with Martin's 2kg claim coming in handy. Thinking the step out to 1200m will suit Dollywood who missed the start and never featured over the short course last time out. Sectionals said he was good there in his own race though and he has been fancied in this grade recently. He looks to have found a suitable race and if he runs up to his latest efforts, he'll go close. Chipstar just missed in a similar race two back before being outclassed most recently in a BM58. The blinkers go back on today and he maps to be close to the speed. Can see him bouncing back.

Race Analysis: Keen to go back to the well with Satin Shimmer after piling into her last start. She just bumped into an in-form and fitter galloper who was beaten just 2.1L at Canterbury on Wednesday. The pair gapped the rest of the field there and the extra 100m won't hurt. She was taken out in front last start, but looks to get more control this time and looks set to go one better. Fascination Alley comes into this fitter for two trials and was placed at Bathurst first-up last campaign. She has a few ratings that match Satin Shimmer, though they were produced later in her campaign and over a mile. Miss Stalwart was good from the back last start and that rating matches right up. Hard to think she's much better than what she's produced, compared to Satin Shimmer who looks to have more to come.

Race Analysis: Another tricky race with plenty of converging form lines, but those of Ilovenews look most appealing. He was at the top of the weights in a good Maiden at Wyong last start and looks well placed in this CL1/Maiden under the conditions. Back to this grade is a big tick and he'll be on the speed from a favourable alley for Jeff Penza. Ticks plenty of boxes and looks to have found his race. Kaffir Lady was the eye-catcher behind Longinus in the last race of the day here a fortnight ago, running into a clear second on debut. It's important to note she was 20-1 there and the ratings was average for a maiden runner here at Canberra. I can see her appeal out to the mile, though Hooligan Tommy is a last-start winner and posted a good figure in the process at Scone. He jumped in the pointy end of the market there and JVO rides him over Kaffir Lady despite the fact he can ride the weight. He may need a touch of luck from the alley, but he's run to higher ratings than he produced last start and that holds plenty of weight. Longinus went around at Kembla Grange on Thursday and is expected to be scratched.

Race Analysis: Bit of an open race and one I'm not looking to dive into. After scratchings, the draw doesn't appear too bad for Best Intent who brings the strongest form into this race. She is out to the mile for the first time today, though she'll make her own luck up on the speed. She's a tough mare and if she runs out the trip, she'll prove hard to run down. Vaguer maps to land in a handy spot off the inside draw and put up a figure that would be competitive in this event when first-up over this course and distance last campaign. He went on to win on Black Opal Day and during the Albury carnival in dominant fashion following that. Has class and is sure to be there at the finish. Louie's Legacy and Star Buyer hit the line together last meeting here over the mile. There isn't much between them on ratings.

Race Analysis: The inaugural running of the Black Mountain and it's a very competitive field. Body Bob hasn't done much racing over 1000m previously, but his early speed is up to the mark, especially after what we've seen at the trials recently. Good to see the stable are allowing him to roll forward this campaign after talks of trying to restrain him early last time in work. He's run to a level higher than his rivals have and while those ratings are over further, he's been sharp enough in his trials to suggest he won't be far off that mark on resumption. Bomarea makes the trip to Canberra, turning down a similar race closer to home. She too has plenty of early speed and the inside alley can see her take up the running. She bumped into Kosciuszko contender Compelling Truth two back before disappointing last start. Her recent trial since then was superb and Mikayla Weir knows her well. She'll roll to the front and take plenty of catching. Master Joe doesn't have much variance in his ratings, though he's obviously back in good form judging by his trial around Group winner I Am Me at Goulburn the other week. Happy to oppose Tulla Park in this event. He is racing well, but this is a completely different set up to what he's been running in and it's hard to think he'll produce something like his best.

Race Analysis: A couple of scratchings leaves this open. Xceptional Fella produced a strong rating on debut over this course and distance when running over the top to score. The sectionals out of that race stack up nicely and he looks to have plenty of upside. Suspect we haven't seen the best of him yet and if he can improve again on what he did on debut, they'll have to make a jump to get him. Getty was disappointing first-up at Moruya but brings the highest average rating into this. After scratchings, he does look to get plenty of favours up on the speed from the inside alley and while improvement is likely, just how much is the question. Picksix was just fair at Wyong last start and will find this much easier. Worth noting that he was accepted for a BM50 here a fortnight ago. Miss Belgium ran home strongly at Queanbeyan last start and is some hope.

She maps for a cosy run under the stable apprentice and it's the unknowns that make her an exciting proposition in what isn't an overly strong race. Oaky Doaks was good from the back in the same race as Xceptional Fella and that form may have been franked by now. Sectionals backed up what the eye shows us there and there's not doubt he can go to another level now out to this trip.
