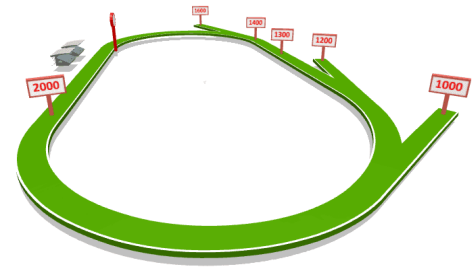

**Race Analysis:** Keeping the cash in the back pocket in the opener with no real standout. Serial Offender has promised that she's better than Maiden grade, yet still finds herself without a win from her first six starts. The winner from her last start outing has since won again and her run here two back from back in the field was solid. Back to this trip now and ridden similarly may see her come out on top, though there's no clear edge on ratings. Seeking To Win was a \$12 chance in the same race first-up and meets Serial Offender worse at the weights now. She went under at Leeton as a \$2.50 pop second-up, but she'll be prominent in the run and should be at her peak third-up now. She's High Society was a well-beaten favourite on debut at Queanbeyan back in April. She was green as grass that day and has since switched to the Joseph & Jones yard. Her trials suggested she is better than we saw on debut, but there's too many question marks to get stuck right into her. Menacing Kaiser and Tjaka have trialled well without setting the world alight. Leaving this through to the keeper.

**Race Analysis:** La Signora Dane trialed well coming into her fresh run here on Hops & Hooves Day and ran over the top to score narrowly. She looks very well placed in this event with Alysha Collett coming to ride with some upside still to come. She can sit just off the speed again and with improvement likely, she'll prove hard to hold out. Speaking of upside, Grins creates interest here first-up after a couple of solid efforts on the Acton track in May and June. She'll put herself on the speed from gate two and Coriah Keatings claim is very handy. Expecting her to take plenty of catching. Rex Cole produces Outstanding reward for her first run for the stable after making the move up from Victoria. She's placed 2/4 at this trip and while she hasn't won for a while, her most recent 1000m rating stacks up in this field. May need some luck from the draw but she can be swooping late. Papaver Miner is usually around the mark in this grade and can be about the finish from a good draw.

He has ratings close to Asuriito and is nicely weighted after the claim of Bronnett Prag. Happy to place him ahead of Pretty Vegas who has been good this campaign but drops back to 1000m which is a little niggler.

**Race Analysis:** There's not a whole lot between the first few in the market, but the form of Final Comment stands out. He stuck on gamely at Dubbo last start after being wide the trip, but prior to that he just missed in Provincial grade at Hawkesbury and beat a similar field comfortably at Moruya prior to that. He maps to get the run of the race from an inside alley and can be marked favourite. Where Is Ken has been running well over the mile and has improved with every run this time in, but he didn't improve when stepping out in trip last campaign. Granted, it was at the end of his campaign at the Sapphire Coast, but he'll be back in the run off what looks just a moderate tempo. He did show good zip two back though and there's not doubt he's trending the right way. Aunt Roberta was behind Final Comment at Moruya on August 30 and there's not enough changes to suggest that result can be flipped.

**Race Analysis:** Open federal with some good horses lining up. Invertational was superb on resumption and posted a good time figure when winning on Hops & Hooves Day. She does rise in weight, but she has always hinted that she was a nice horse and she can get back on track now. Manderboss looks one who can improve getting back to his home track. He hasn't won since the Bega Cup in 2023, but he's been performing at a higher level than what he's in today and he's well weighted under the conditions. Can get back to his best form now. Tavolo had every possible last start and was just fair when produced in the straight at Wagga. He ticks a few boxes being third-up and expected to get the run of the race, though there's no edge in his early price. Capital Heart was only fair last start after a good win two back. On the quick turnaround for the first time in his career but he'll be in the finish if he returns to his best. Champions League is racing well, but he was jumping 20-1 or longer in similar races last campaign and his ratings say he's not going any better now.

Dame Annie bolted in at Gundagai but was rather plain as a \$5 chance at Nowra last time out. Up in trip now may suit, but her two SP's to begin her career is a niggle on her. Maps to get her chance though. Golden Fairy was put on the speed last start and produced a good figure to break her maiden. Ratings and time stack up here and she's in the mix.

**Race Analysis:** Thinking the Gai and Adrian-trained Space Ace can score a debut win. His trials in Sydney have been good and this trip looks ideal for him first-up. He was scratched from a maiden at Hawkesbury on Thursday to run in this race and he should get plenty of favours up front for Winona Costin who strikes at 23% when riding for the stable. Wouldn't be surprised to see him start much shorter than his current quote. Cassette draws out and may get back in the run as she did at Warwick Farm on debut. She was a \$26 chance there and this is obviously much easier. Her trials going into her debut were solid and she's likely to run a much better race back to Country level. Malbork Castle has moved nicely at the trials in readiness for today and can be running on strongly at the finish following a sound debut performance at Canterbury back in April.
