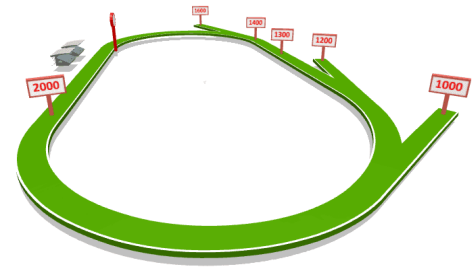

Race Analysis: That's Outstanding ran to a new peak last start at Warwick Farm when out to the mile for the first time. His closing splits there suggests the step up in trip is no issue and his breeding is a big tick as well. Collett remains with the gelding, and he's run some very good ratings on a wet track previously. He brings the highest ratings into this event and has the scope to improve again now out to 2000m. Back to country level today and is clearly the one to beat in the opener. Stand In Line dictated from the front at Goulburn last start and sprinted quickly to get the job done. It looks as though this may shape similarly, but he would need to improve again to match it with That's Outstanding. Ocean Diva is fit and ready for this trip now but would need to revert to her best figures, plus some.

Race Analysis: Fair Maiden jumped a \$4 chance at Canterbury on debut off the back of a couple of nice trials coming in. Sent for a spell and she's fitter for one solid hit out at Warwick Farm recently where she looked to get through a wet track. The market expected her to run to a figure that would be an above-average Canberra maiden winner there and she still has the scope to do just that. Can entertain Miss Spacegirl on debut for the Freedman's following a nice trial at Rosehill recently. The stable is in form and strike at 17% at Canberra. You can poke plenty of holes in most of the raced brigade and that makes her somewhat interesting. Ilikesoobogie was first-up for 662 days at Wodonga last start and folded up as she was entitled to do. Fitter again now but the rating is just fair from that effort and suspect she'd have to run to a new peak rating to be winning this.

Race Analysis: Sutton Vella posted a strong figure over this course and distance last start and the sectionals suggest she was hitting the line full of running there. She brings the best last start rating into this and she has handled a wet track previously. Pace may be an issue in this race with no noted leader, which gives Pretty Vegas a great chance. Loses Alysha Collett for the apprentice hoop, but she appears the likely leader from the barrier. She's run well on wet tracks previously and she'll be hard to catch from the front. Mighty Myrtle may end up being the best horse out of this race. Her two wins at the end of last campaign hint at her being a smart horse for the future. While her best ratings are over further, she has rattled home in two fresh runs over 1000m previously and if she doesn't win today, she'll be one to follow moving forward.

Race Analysis: Rileycat was strong from the front here two back before running on well from beyond midfield at Wagga most recently over this trip. Gets a jockey upgrade today and should get the run of the race from the barrier. She's the rightful favourite on ratings, though Spirit In The Dark finally gets a set up to suit. She closed off in good time off a slow 1000m journey last start and steps straight out to 1400m which will suit her down to the ground. Anticipating she can sit closer today with not a whole lot of speed engaged. She's hinted a few times that she's above average and today looks the first chance she gets to show us what she's really capable of. Divine Conclusion settled on the speed last start and was mowed down by Rileycat and others. Fitter now and drawn well again, but happy enough to dismiss from a ratings point of view.

Race Analysis: Keen to pin down Laurel Hill in the Federal and think she should be favourite in this event. Rob Potter was trying to get her to the mile earlier this month before a little mishap and the way she's performing over the shorter distances suggests the rise in distance is right up her alley. He's booked the services of the South/South East's hottest hand in Nick Heywood, she looks to get a lovely run and a return to her best ratings is on the cards, if not better again. That would make things tricky for Louie's Legacy who ran to a new peak rating to win the Cootamundra Cup last time out. While he is in form, it's hard to think that there's more to come from the six-year-old, though he should make his own luck on the speed. Martin has ridden him well in the past and her claim comes in handy, but the thinking that Laurel Hill can go to another level has me leaning her way. Heir Jordan and Pretty Eyed come through the same race but this looks a very different set up. Heir Jordan could end up in a sticky spot with the inside alley and his racing pattern, while it wouldn't surprise to see Pretty Eyed sit much closer than we've seen of late. While only a Class 2 mare, Pretty Eyed has a nice race in her somewhere and I'm keeping her safe in the Federal.

Race Analysis: Very interesting race. Iron Will was racing through the grades as a very progressive talent, winning under similar conditions as an odds-on chance in December last year. The big niggler is, that his win on December 1 was the last time we've seen him publicly. There's no doubt he has class and ability, but there's some others in this race who are fit and rate right up to him. Devine Miss got the job done at Moruya in a photo finish and ran up to that effort over 1200m last time out. Those ratings are only up to what Fangela has produced in the past and he looks to get a better go of things this time. Held up on straightening last start but still closed off well in the Black Mountain most recently and Heywood hopping on is worth noting.

Race Analysis: Really liked what I saw from Urafiki last start at Moruya when shedding the maiden tag in a Super Maiden and the figures back that up. She put up a high rating to win that race as favourite and the time figure backs that up. She comes off a strong tempo so the extra 100m isn't a problem and both stable and jockey are in form. 0/3 on wet tracks previously, but this is a much different set up to what she's seen on those occasions, and she can go back-to-back. Ronny Rock Art is a model of consistency and rarely runs a bad race. The wet track is no problem for him, and he'll make his own luck up on the speed. The claim helps and he's likely to be in this for a long way. Won well at Cootamundra but the rating out of that was only fair. She's likely to give them a big start again and there's a couple who rate similarly to her. Hobbsy disappointed on the same card at Cootamundra, His prior form is better than that and the blinkers go on first time. Can see some edge in his early price.

Race Analysis: Grins jumped the \$2.25 favourite in this grade last time out and bumped into an in-form galloper. She was first-up there but the ratings suggest she's right up to the mark. Strips fitter now and should get her chance from the draw again, it's easy to think she should jump a similar price to what she was last week. Forbidden Gemstone just missed here two back and wasn't far away at Cootamundra most recently. Back to this trip is a little nigger, but she'll put herself on the speed with the 2kg claim coming in handy. Rosy Sue was well backed in a similar race here first-up and wasn't disgraced in a CL1 at Queanbeyan last time out. Watch for her flashing late. Our ambition rates well in this off her maiden win last start, but she was a \$26 chance there. That was her first go on a wet track though and maybe that is the key.
