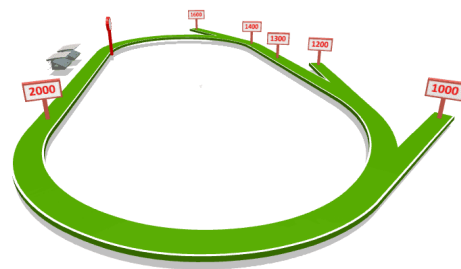

Race Analysis: The scratching of Telecom leaves this a relatively open race with most of these horses rated similarly. Taumata has put up nice ratings over 2000m previously and now gets back out to this trip. Sectionals from Albury last start suggested the horse is still in top order and is screaming for this extra journey. He and Divine Conclusion are rated very similarly, but it's the map advantage of Divine Conclusion that has me leaning his way. He was gunned down late at Gundagai, but he did jump favourite there and he looks the only pace in this race. He'll roll forward, dictate and be hard to gun down.

Race Analysis: The scratching of Zealously opens this race up. Perigean comes down to the Seib barn after racing for Tony Gollan in Queensland and putting up some competitive figures, particularly for a race like this. He's shown early speed early in his career and should be prominent from the inside alley. He'll be fitter for a Sydney trial where he ran through the line nicely and with convictions on some of his main market rivals, he's the one who appeal most. Onigiri has a ratings edge, but there's always a niggle with how these European horses adapt to Australian conditions. Only 155 days between runs for Onigiri and if she could run to her prior figures she would be winning this, though it's not an easy feat.

Race Analysis: Invincible Madison was only fair in both runs as a 2YO but lobs here under more suitable conditions. Her latest trial was good in Sydney, with the first and second horses there both winning since and the third horse out of the trial jumping a \$3.20 chance at Hawkesbury and going close to winning. That reads strongly for a Canberra maiden and she looks to get plenty of favours from a nice barrier. Highwire Flyer disappointed last start in stronger company following a good run at Orange to start her career. She has the speed to offset the barrier and she'll be in this for a long way. Capital Babe trialled well at this track recently around some smart gallopers and she didn't look out of place there.

Race Analysis: Louisburgh comes down for the Neasham & Archibald team who have a strong strike rate bringing horses to Canberra, particularly ones with similar profiles to Louisburgh. He wasn't disgraced as a 20-1 chance on Heavy going at Canterbury on debut and the stable thought enough of him to try him in Metropolitan company. His two trials this time in have been great and he maps for a lovely run. Looks to have some class about him and is clearly the one to beat. California Blues was 60-1 last start at Hawkesbury but showed plenty of improvement when out to this trip for the first time. He'll find this easier and he can run another bold race. The other Neasham & Archibald runner Easy Girl looks a little over the odds. She was good behind Brazen Crime here last start and maps for a similar run today.

Race Analysis: Ronny Rock Art continued his consistent run of form at Canterbury last week but the figure he put up there was around the same mark he's been at for a while now. He'll make his own luck up on speed for Nick Heywood which are two big ticks. Interesting to see Miss Ghent priced up inside him who couldn't run him down at her latest effort over this course and distance. Not only that, she meets him worse at the weights. Expecting the market to swing back in Ronny's favour closer to the jump. Icebreaker ran good time first-up over this course and distance but went from a mile to 2100m and bolted in second-up last campaign. He was just too good for his rivals last start and he's expected to build on that rating here, it's just whether he's looking for further now. Pretty Eyed got back to something like her best last start and she was campaigned like a good horse to begin this preparation. Now McDougall legs aboard and she can be an improver.

Race Analysis: A cracking second edition of the Canberra Community Chest and it's a hard race to nail down the winner with plenty of betting angles and a number of horses good enough to win on their day. I'mintowin comes out and Elettrica looks to have the perfect platform for the Freedman barn. She ran a new peak rating with Racing and Sports last start and the sectionals from that run suggest she can go again third-up into the campaign. She's in red-hot form and with further improvement expected, I can see the market trending towards her at the jump. The rating Elettrica put up last start is right alongside what Battleton put up when winning two back. He has become a consistent horse albeit without winning a whole lot. There's not a whole lot of range in his ratings profile, though his win two back at Rosehill says he has what it takes to win a Community Chest. Just too far back off a moderate tempo last start at Newcastle but the sectionals say he was absolutely humming late. Chorlton Lane brings in the highest last-start rating with Racing and Sports, though he's expected to be a long way back from the barrier and will need a touch of luck. Super Helpful won this race last year and ratings say he's trending in a similar fashion heading into this. He's set for this race and he's already proven he can do it at this level. The Prodigal Son steps out to 1400m for just the second time, though he did return with a new career peak fresh and he's improved with every second-up run in his career. Sectionals say he was warming to the task late in the race and he's worth keeping on side.

Toes In The Water mightn't live up to the heights of Single Gaze (not many will, mind you) but she's right in the sweet spot to win this race. He progressed nicely through the grades last campaign to stamp herself as not only Highway grade, but a little better than that. Her one niggle is that her wins have been over further and on wet tracks, but she has run strong ratings on quick ground in defeat. Nice trial has her ready to fire a big shot first-up. Mighty Myrtle never got a crack in the Highway last start when well back and given none. This spot suits her much better and the fresh win over 1000m here said she was in for a big prep. This spot looks to suit Mighty Myrtle much better and she can not only return to her winning figure, but better that here.

Race Analysis: Brazen Crime won like a good horse on debut and the figures produced said he was a horse of Highway quality. The chatter going around was that he was relatively underdone heading into that race, so improvement is expected second-up and Penza should get every chance from the draw. Don't think the debut win was a fluke and he can stamp himself a progressive talent in the Tony Campbell Memorial Cup. Fifty Five Mustang boasts a strong second-up record and produced a solid run fresh which suggested his best wasn't far away. Still has some upside but would need to run a new career peak now to get to Brazen Crime. Mountain Chatter showed signs of life last start. He looks to be getting back to his best and out to this trip for the first time doesn't look an issue. The booking of Cahill is a positive lead and his recent efforts rate right up to those of Fifty Five Mustang.
