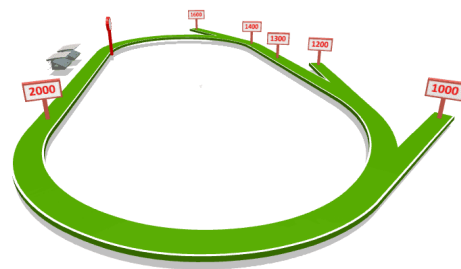

Race Analysis: Shalmum has been hitting the line nicely in both runs this time in and now gets out in trip now where she was producing strong ratings in her earlier campaigns. Those ratings would be top of the bunch here, but she's with a new stable now and the market have kept her short enough. Easy Girl creates interest for the Neasham & Archibald partnership who have made the Nation's Capital a happy hunting ground. She kept up well over 1000m on debut and looked to be doing her best work late in the race, with the stable now jumping her straight out to 1400m. Plenty to like about her coming into this and she looks to have some edge early doors. Bertus was good on debut before jumping \$26 at Kembla and being only fair to the line. Have to think he's better than that from what we saw first-up and this is within his grasp. Brazen Crime and Omaha Sand are both debutants who have showed enough in their trials to suggest they're worth keeping onside at their debuts.

Race Analysis: No real lean. Icebreaker is the best horse in this race, but he is an out-and-out stayer who found them too sharp over the mile first-up last campaign. Whilst that was in Provincial company, there doesn't appear a whole lot of tempo in this event and I question his ability to quicken off a moderate tempo. His stablemate however, Jack Of Aces is the one I'm most warm on. No jockey is engaged as yet, though he'll be fitter for three trials coming in and his latest at Hawkesbury was solid. He jumped \$3.50 in a BM70 over this track and trip to end last campaign and he appears to have the most edge in his price early doors - as long as he lines up of course. Closed off well first-up at Muswellbrook first-up and improved sharply getting out to the mile in her debut preparation. She has the upside to raise the bar. Major Desire has some strong figures over shorter trips and now steps out to the mile for the first time. Worth keeping an eye on the market. Expecting Hookham to come out after running at Corowa on Monday.

Race Analysis: Tavolo appears a nice mare on the way through, jumping favourite in a similar race last start and getting the job done comfortably. She was challenged in the straight but pulled away late to score. The draw may be a niggler, but she ran a new career peak rating last start and there looks to be scope for further improvement. Not much separates her, Mosgold and Bon Frankie, though the upside is what makes her most appealing. Mosgold has been racing well in town and now comes back to Country level and carries less weight. She's a highway winner over 1400m and getting back on top of the ground looks a big tick for her today. Maps for a lovely run and she should be able to feature if she's at her best. Bon Frankie ran a similar figure to Tavolo when winning at Wagga, albeit in slower time there. Form out of his last start has measured up and he's worth plenty of thought.

Race Analysis: Looks a race in two, but the market knows that too. Circle Of Love was left racing wide and without cover throughout at Hawkesbury on debut and faded late in the race. This will be much easier for her today dropping back to this level and she'll have the speed to cross from the middle draw. Thinking she can run up to her market expectation this time and that should see her as the one to beat, though the trial form around Leila Belle is red-hot. The third horse out of that trial won at Queanbeyan as a \$6.50 chance and the horse she hit the line alongside jumped the \$2.80 favourite at the Sapphire Coast last Thursday and won easily. She'll be prominent from the inside alley and will take catching if she can run up to her trial form.

Race Analysis: Interesting race. Miss Ghent and Straight Fire are 2-2 from their previous four match-ups, though aside from the Albury Guineas, Straight Fire has jumped shorter in the market. Straight Fire was obviously disappointing last start when a \$6 chance in the Highway, being hampered around the home turn and never getting a fair crack at them. She was trending the right way prior to that and this presents as a great opportunity to raise the bar as expected in Sydney last start. Miss Ghent was \$26 there (vs. Straight Fire's \$6 SP) and now ends up favourite in this race. Miss Ghent hasn't run to the ratings of Straight Fire since that Albury Guineas effort, and that only builds the case as to why she should be marked outside Straight fire. Blinkers now go on for straight fire as well, with getting away from the inside another big tick. Encompass is on the quick turnaround and maps for a lovely run and it wouldn't surprise to see him thereabouts if he can hold his form.

Race Analysis: Wide open race to end the card. Trapeze Legend is a 3YO colt who has stacks of upside, winning as an odds-on pop at Bathurst most recently. While he is up against it today as a 3YO giving away weight to older horses, he looks to have plenty of ability and his ratings stack right up in this field. He's yet to see a firm deck which he'll get this time and he may be able to improve again now. Easy to mark him favourite, but hard to nail down with some handy ones behind him. Lyrical Beauty jumped a \$5 chance in a Provincial BM64 first-up and just felt the pinch late after leading them up. She now finds herself longer odds to win a lower grade race. Should be able to roll forward and take plenty of catching late in the race. Sutton Vella hit the line full of running last start over 1000m and the horse who beat her wasn't disgraced in a Highway on Saturday. She looks ready for the extra trip now and she's expected to be running on strongly. Nettles still has some upside coming into this event and was a good winner here third-up last campaign. Profiles nicely for a race like this as a lightly-raced prospect. Nettles' ratings tie her to Hot Bandit though who has been solid so far this campaign. Good here two back under the big weight as a \$3 chance and he commands plenty of respect. Worth going wide in the final leg of the Quaddie!
