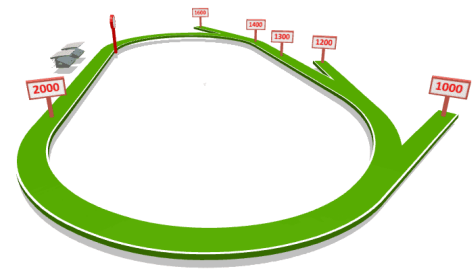

Race Analysis: Wasn't really a race I was looking to dive into before scratchings, and that hasn't changed after scratching time. Icebreaker is a clear on-top selection here following his two good wins at this track and trip, though they have been off solid tempos. Small field here may see this play out a little differently and it makes it hard to dive in at the early price. Ferrari Man did very well to hold on for second at Queanbeyan last start when setting a very strong tempo out in front which may have flattered the winning margin there. Back to the mile now where he'd put up strong ratings prior and he looks one of the main pace influences in the race. Victory At Omaha should land on the speed and give himself every chance, but he'd need to improve on recent efforts.

Race Analysis: Looks a bit of a trap this race. Waverly went around as a \$1.50 pop at Goulburn two back before running in a Midway at Rosehill most recently. He was left with too much to do off a slow tempo at Goulburn and that seems the right run to work him around in this race. Suspect he's likely to get back in the field in a race that doesn't have much speed on paper. Looks the one to beat though there are enough knocks to have me leaving this through to the keeper. Is another who went to town last start when jumping a \$19 chance at Canterbury and finishing 3.4 lengths off the winner. He still has plenty of upside being a 3YO and out to this trip and he may be able to sit a touch closer from an inside barrier this time.

She gets onto a firmer surface today, the tongue tie goes on and she maps for a lovely run just off the speed. Can go to another level now and while she has accepted at a few different locations, she's the one to beat if she lines up here. Blue Bayou would've finished closer at the Sapphire Coast, but she had a rival laying in on the top of her for much of the straight. She can sit a little closer today third-up into the campaign and the blinkers replace the pacifiers. Can bounce back to her best. There's not a lot between Missy No Nay and Jukebox flyer off their recent efforts over the Gundagai carnival.

Race Analysis: Thought Charlemagne should've been favourite when markets first opened, but following the scratching of his main danger, it increases the confidence. I was happy to bypass him last week as I thought he wanted a similar race to what he gets today, but he proved me wrong in dominant style. I prefer him out to this trip now third-up into the campaign and there looks to be good speed engaged. While he'll be well back in the run, he should be able to build into the race as he did last start and let rip down the outside. A key here his that he beat a lot of his rivals here with ease last start and while Prophet's Pride does meet him better at the weights following the claim of Cahill, he was only extending his margin late in the race and it's hard to see anyone out of last week's federal turning the tables. He's never raced on a 7-day turnaround, but he has been good off 10 and 11-day breaks throughout his career. Kahawaty was very impressive first-up and may find this a more suitable distance. She won running away from her rivals there, putting up strong figures in the process. Epaullo Creed comes through the Adaminaby Cup but that rated well despite being a non-tab event. Maps to find the front and does prove tough to run down if he gets it all his own way.

Race Analysis: Scratchings have taken some of the depth out of this field, but the top end still looks strong with the regally-bred Buckenara on resumption for the O'Shea and Charlton team following a nice trial at Canterbury most recently. He looks to have good upside, and his debut run as a 2YO at Newcastle showed some positive signs. He looks as though he'll get out over further, though this is a handy kick-off point for him, and he can resume on a winning note, particularly with a few of his main rivals coming out. Rampazetto looked to just peak on the run first-up at Hawkesbury but he laid the foundations for a solid campaign. He improved well when second-up and out in trip in his debut campaign and he rates as the main danger.

Race Analysis: Teetotal looks to have found a very good race third-up into his campaign following a strong run at Wodonga where he was only collared late in the race. Now out to a trip where he's been successful previously and he has the speed to offset the tricky gate. It's a relatively open affair, though he is the correct favourite from a ratings point of view. Love Of Air looks to be some value at her current price. While this is her first time out to this distance, there's nothing in her profile to suggest it will be an issue. She was good to the line in a solid Highway last start, and she maps to hold a lovely position from the inside well back in grade. Looks beautifully placed and over the odds at the early price. The same could be said for Breakaway Week who bumped into a progressive type last week. It took a good one to run her down with that race rating highly and now she drops well back in class. Anticipate they'll adopt similar tactics this time and she'll be tough to run down. Flying Flossy wasn't far away in a CL1 over this track and trip first-up last campaign and is worth including. Lord Finland has been kept safe in early betting but I'm happy to oppose him first-up with his best figures over further.
