

Race Analysis: The scratching of The Right Rein makes this an open event to begin the card and one I'm not looking to dive into. Cicada drops in weight following a narrow defeat at Bathurst over this trip most recently, though he was seemingly given every chance there. He should be fitter again fourth-up following a year-long spell and he looks to be trending back to his prior ratings now. He makes the most appeal. Buff In Disguise was a winner at this track and trip three starts back and ran up to that level last time out when closing in some strong splits at Orange. Likely to be giving them a head start turning for home, but he'll be closing off strongly late in the piece. Gatchan and Grenoble are around the mark on ratings but don't win win often (2-23 and 2-29 respectively) and that sums up the race.

Race Analysis: The raced brigade hasn't produced a whole lot of note, so the debutants look to hold the key. All three at the top of the market have trialled on the same day, with Miss Backchat being the quickest of those. She ran her time from the front too and she appears a speedy customer, so barrier 10 mightn't be that much of an issue. Louise Day is striking at 22% from her last 50 rides and she may be too speedy for her rivals in this. Safrano spotted Redoute's Girl a start in their most recent trial and proved too good under a hold. Expecting her to sit just off the speed form barrier six and be launching her attack late in the race. Hey Jude could surprise. She got into a good maiden on debut at Kembla Grange and was in the worst part of the track there. This looks to suit better.

Race Analysis: With his main danger coming out, this looks a race primed for Due Calzini to take advantage off. The stable thought enough of him to send him to the G3 Gloaming where he wasn't disgraced before finishing well back in the G1 Spring Champion Stakes. Not only that, his runs prior in Highway company to begin this campaign stamp him as a clear on-top selection. He is 41-days between runs, but if he's at the level he was to begin this campaign, he should be getting the job done. Montevecchio looks open to improvement back in trip second-up and from a good gate while Scarli Japali can get back to his best and be in the finish.

Race Analysis: With Simply Nutbush coming out, it opens the door right up for Dubai Warrior, though the price on offer now doesn't look to have much juice in it. He did a bit wrong on debut when being slow out of the gates but he was very good from then on, sustaining a run at Scone to miss by 0.6 lengths and produce some good sectionals in the process. The form out of that race has been strong and he gets Heywood in the saddle from a good draw and out in trip. Ticks plenty of boxes and looks a promising galloper. Happy to give Greygenta a chance in this. She got into a horrible spot first-up over 1000m in a slowly run affair, but the sectionals say there's plenty of upside there. Now 1400m, a bigger field and a firmer deck, this looks a much better scenario for her.

Race Analysis: Keen to bet in the Federal and it's away from early favourite Lang Park. While he ran some good figures last campaign in solid races, it's not any different to what his rivals have produced, and he's never won first-up. That's enough to oppose him in my book and this looks a traditional Norm Gardner set up for Devine Miss. She's been running well for the apprentice hoops recently, getting into the finish from tricky positions her past couple and this looks her sweet spot. Drawn ideally with the in-form Louise Day hopping aboard, she'll be close to the speed, and she's expected to run up to her best figures. Another who shapes nicely is Prophet's Pride for the Matt Kelley barn. She just found them too quick over 1000m in the Tuckerbox at Gundagai and this is a much better scenario for her today. Wet track is no issue, distance is no issue and I expect her to make her own luck up on the speed. Her best form is as good as Lang Park and Devine Miss and she profiles beautifully to get back to that level today. Charlemagne will be closing off well late in the race, as too Astunner who wasn't horrible in the Road To The Chest first-up and comes into this off a 31-day break.

Race Analysis: Keen to go again in the last with the Matthew Dale-trained Adolphus. I don't think we've seen the best of him just yet and his last campaign suggested he's a horse for the future. Heavily backed on resumption during the Wagga carnival, he bolted in there over 1400m before stamping himself as a Highway class galloper with a dominant win at Moruya. Just missed at the end of last campaign before heading straight to the paddock, he profiles as though he'll improve again this time in work, and he gets the set up to do just that on resumption. Nettles is racing at a similar level to Adolphus, but her profile suggests there may be a little less upside in her. Good without being great last start at Hawkesbury, her two runs prior over 1200m stack up nicely in this. Shouldn't be too far off the pace and should be going close on recent form. Happy to oppose Flying Impala who has two standout ratings, though the rest of his form rates a level below Nettles and Adolphus. He does look the main pace influence in the race and the claim helps, but he'll need to be at his best second-up and that's hard to forecast off just a moderate fresh effort in Highway company.
