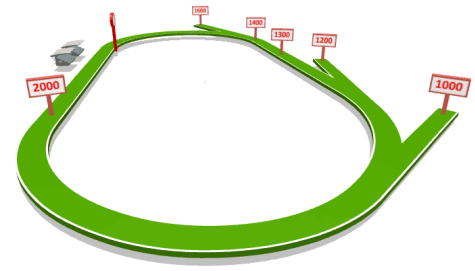

Race Analysis: Scoundrel disappointed last time out at Gosford but his form prior was much better than what he showed there. He's a lightly raced son of Pierata and he brings in the highest peak Racing and Sports rating from his run two back at Gosford. Expect Loy to roll to the front, sit on the speed and he would just have to refer to his form prior to last start to be getting the job done. Wings Of Carmen has shown good talent in his own right, winning over the mile at Albury in November before being tested at Moonee Valley. That highlights the stable's opinion of him, including a run first-up in the Country Champs Qualifier at Wagga. Ticks plenty of boxes with McDougall on board and while he'll need to improve sharply to get to Scoundrel's recent ratings, he is the most likely of the field to be able to do that. Wal's Angels steps up to the mile for the first time today and there's nothing suggesting he won't run the trip. Has always hinted that he's a touch better than we've seen from him and maybe he can run to those expectations now up in trip.

Race Analysis: The 2YO's are often poorly treated at the weights in races like this, and the same could be said for You Sexy Thing. What You Sexy Thing has that others don't in this race however, is strong ratings and a positive racing pattern. The exposed form lacks depth in this maiden and if You Sexy Thing was a 3YO with her record, she'd be almost labelled a good thing. If she can run up to the figures she has run to in town, it'll take a sharp one to gun her down, even if she is poorly treated under the conditions. Of the others, Bella Ferrari looks to have trialed the best of the unraced brigade. She hit the line nicely in her latest trial, but the time was slow against other trials on the day, and she goes from one short course trial straight up to 1200m. The booking of McDougall suggests she's ready to fire on debut, but there's enough there to be in the corner of You Sexy Thing. Chentileeno looked very impressive at the trials at Goulburn and has performed well in similar races previously. Can be close to his best fresh which would have him around the mark.

Race Analysis: Not a race I'm getting involved in with plenty of these rating similarly and expected to improve. Unsurprised to see Babyfaced Assassin come up as favourite with Loy in the saddle when she outran her market expectation at Kembla on debut. This looks easier and she should get every chance from the draw. Her stablemate Black Bugatti is of similar vein, though she does come here from Goulburn where he was a \$13 chance. He's anticipated to have come on from that effort and he turned in a good performance second-up last campaign. Early market has swung the way of Leovanni and that doesn't surprise. She was a \$2.90 chance at Scone when back to 1300m and was a Sectional Star late in the race there. She's shown she handles all conditions, and she maps beautifully from the barrier. She's another with stacks of upside and is likely to improve, though just how much is the question as she should be close to her peak fitness.

Race Analysis: La Signora Dane won a very similar race back in October last year and held her form going up in grade following that win. She'll carry the same weight she did to win in this level and now gets McDougall in the saddle in a big push for her chances. Should be fitter for one trial coming in where she did enough late and she's got things in her corner to suggest she could return in even better touch. Siovy Dane boasts an 8.2L victory on the Acton here, though she hasn't been back to that level at all since that effort in May last year. She's been running around in stronger races than this though and gets the key switch of Loy on board. She too can be on the speed from barrier five and will be in this for a long way. Wegotabetterhoffa looked good in her most recent trial and was a fresh winner at Queanbeyan last campaign.

Race Analysis: Mountain Chatter was super in the Country Champs Wildcard at Goulburn, running a strong rating there and probably showcasing what he had threatened to do at the beginning of his career. Different set up this time with not as much speed on paper, though he should be able to hold a handier position under Day, who rode him in the Wildcard. He'll need to run up to the rating he produced there at Goulburn, which is the question, though the feeling is that he'll be able to. Silent Impact is a newcomer to the Matt Kelley yard, and he creates plenty of interest in this. While he's had his issues, he's still a lightly-race 6YO and he brings in strong ratings for a race like this. He disappointed at Canterbury, but this suits much better and a return to form would see him go close. My Last Hooray ended up in a horrible position in the Highway fresh and he's always suggested that further would be better for the gelding. He's turned in a nice trial since that run and he should get every chance from the barrier. He'll have to improve on what we saw first-up, but he's one of the more promising horses engaged. Demanding Mo is an old champion who has returned to his best ratings since coming back to the Dryden & Snowden barn. Should be right in the mix again with McDougall in the saddle. Dorami was good fresh in the Camarena and now gets out to a more suitable trip for her.

Race Analysis: Canadian Ruler may have felt the pinch first-up here on Opal Day, but the splits he clocked late suggested there's still plenty more to come from the 4YO. He sat up front on a slow speed there and just when it looked like he'd run by the winner, he hit the wall. Fitter now and it wouldn't surprise me to see more tempo in this race and that may suit him with some of his best performances coming in strongly run races. He looks a good bet to end the last. Ghost Walker went back to 1300m off a freshen and was too good there and he maps to get a lovely run in the race once again. He looks to be hitting his straps now and if he can improve in similar fashion to how he did last start, then he'll go close, though that is the question. Boom In The Dark was first-up for the stable at Goulburn and probably just found them a little sharp over the 1000m journey there. He kept up well though and out to 1300m can see him return to his best ratings which have him in the finish. Miss Ghent is an interesting runner back from the Canberra Cup Preview and looks too short in early betting with her best form being over further.
