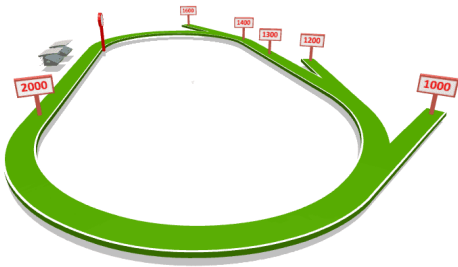

**Race Analysis:** In The Nic Of Time jumped a \$2.70 chance last start at Wagga in a stronger maiden than this and wasn't far away. Back to 1000m now where she was very good on debut, she draws well with a positive racing style and its's easy to see why he's favourite. Callenem Thru has trialed well coming into his debut though and the winner of the trial he comes through has been placed at provincial level prior. That seems a good formline for a maiden of this calibre and it wouldn't surprise to see him run a race on debut. An argument can be made to suggest they should be a touch closer together than the early market suggests.

**Race Analysis:** All Astern drops back to 1000m off a short freshen following a disappointing effort over 1200m last time out at Wagga. This is a much easier race than that and she has enough early speed to offset the wide draw. Ratings say the first two in the market have a clear advantage, and form would suggest that All Astern has the ratings that the others need to catch. Beau Rock boasts a good record at this track and trip but has been doing his recent racing over 1200m. Drawn wide seems a little niggle and while he's well weighted after the 4kg claim, he comes in off lower races than what All Astern has been in. Single Beat needs to improve to get to their level, but her best figure this campaign came over the sprint trip three back. Wouldn't surprise to see her improve.

**Race Analysis:** The Burns Club Cup and it's a good race where I'm happy to pen a couple. Dame Annie will need some luck from the wide draw but has shown good pace over the shorter distances recently. She flew home fresh over 900m in a stronger CL1 at Muswellbrook before jumping a \$4 chance last start and disappointing. Now third-up and out in trip, she looks well placed in this easier race and you can mark her shorter on recent figures. She'sadare looks to get the run of the race from barrier four on the 8-day turnaround after another strong effort here last time out. The slight rise in distance doesn't pose an issue and the form out of her maiden win two back has worked out nicely. She appears the main danger. Apparate was a newcomer to the Kirkup stable at the Sapphire Coast but got the job done there in good style. The first-up figure suggested she hadn't lost anything moving to the new barn and those prior ratings are still well in play. Has enough upside to suggest she can be marked ahead of some others in betting. Stablemate Miss Emma comes back from some strong races but hasn't offered up a whole lot in recent outings despite having every possible. Happy to go against Rainagain who put in a good run here two back but the ratings all around that effort suggest he needs to lift. Sturdy has been given plenty of opportunities now and looked to have found a winnable race last start. She failed there and she can go around without me.

**Race Analysis:** Region Time drops right back in grade today and looks well placed from a very suitable gate. He's raced against some handy types recently and the form out of the last start has already been franked. He was on the 7-day back up there and now with a longer weight between runs and the drop back in grade, he can return to his best figures. Spritzzy Lass was in a CL1 at Queanbeyan last start and wasn't beaten far when sitting close to the speed as a \$6.50 chance. Fitter again now and she steps up to the mile for the first time which could see her go to another level. Ever Was creates interest back in trip off a freshen and with a nice trial between runs, but he may need some luck.

**Race Analysis:** Looks like the market has the Federal about right. Arthur The Great brings in some different form through the Wagga Town Plate Prelude where he was beaten 0.6L as the favourite, but his win over this trip two back was super as an odds-on pop. Looks to be at his best over the 1400m journey and he has the speed to offset the wide barrier. With no other real pace evident, he may be able to dictate from the front and that'll see him very hard to run down. Demanding Mo and Mountain Chatter were separated by a head last time out at this track. Market has Mountain Chatter ahead, but Demanding Mo meets him better at the weights after the claim of Cahill despite the last start win. Shouldn't be much between them again.
