Race Analysis: Tricky race the first with a number of chances. Diamond Ridge got the job done by a half-length last start Moruya and put up a competitive figure there. Form out of the race has already worked out and she maps okay with RBP claiming 1.5kg. Getting to the middle of the track could be the play and she'll be set up well from the barrier. Beau Rock had plenty of fans here last start and almost got the job done, nabbed on the line as favourite. He's won 2/6 over this trip though and suspect he's better suited now. Sinclair's claim comes in handy and he'll get every chance. Have to think there's some juice in the early price of Santorini Sun, who brings in some strong form in better races. She disappointed last start, but went under narrowly two back in a BM58 and the strike jockey Guymmer goes on. Carries the top weight but deservedly so.

Race Analysis: Elivina sat on the speed at Newcastle and proved too strong for her rivals in Soft going, posting a strong rating and time figure to go along with it. Comes down to a set weights CL1 and up to the mile which doesn't look an issue on the late strength she showed last start. With a lack of speed in the race, she can roll forward to make her own luck, and if she's come on since that last run, she's clearly the one to beat. Wild Sensation was a narrow victor here last start and that form was franked through the Wagga carnival last week. Can roll across from out wide and give a sight, but she'll have improve to go with Elivina. Dark Stratum has had plenty of goes now, but has produced strong figures in town, particularly two starts ago. That level would see him win this, but he is hard to trust.

Race Analysis: Malbork Castle was close in similar races to this last campaign but just failed to land the knockout blow, being beaten narrowly at the beginning and end of his campaign at Thoroughbred Park. He looks to have improved this time in though judging by his recent trials and he gets the winkers on first time. The inside draw can see him sit closer in the run and the Litt stable are striking at 30% with McDougall on board. Catonahotinroof appears the main danger following solid efforts in stronger races this campaign. She'd spent 403 days off the scene prior to this preparation, so she'll be getting back to something like her best now and the ratings she's put up her past couple have been competitive. Should land close to the speed and give a bold sight. Happy to oppose Faceoff in early markets. He's been there to strike in his races and has only been fair. This is easier, but he'll be giving his main rivals a head start and he'll need to lift.

The claim of Sinclair comes in handy and he's not a difficult horse to ride, sitting close to the speed from a good gate. Can see some value in his price. Region Time is racing well, but her record at the distance is a niggle and the race was there for her to win last start when she was gunned down on the post. Unowho has had a few chances now and while he's gone close, he's failed to land a big blow. Avonview stuck on well at Wagga last week and looks to be knocking on the door. He is 2 from 22 though which is the niggle.

Guymer remains in the saddle from that effort and the rating and sectional upside she possessed has her well ahead of the rivals she faces this time. Looks well placed and can bring up back-to-back wins. Here Comes Hogan comes in off an interesting set up going back to the trials after his first-up effort at Nowra. Back to 1000m now and the blinkers go on from a good draw. Can play a role.

Race Analysis: King Gutho comes into this off a strong run on the Gold Coast last start and two trials in readiness for this. The second trial was just fair to my eye though and he's not as sharp as he used to be first-up in the past. Probably deserves to be favourite from what we've seen at the races recently, but have my reservations on marking him that short. Castlebar Road looks the one with the most juice early doors, following a strong effort from up on the speed in a BM82 at Bathurst first-up. Jordan Quince claims 3kg, seeing him get into this race lighter at the weights and he's won 2/5 second-up. Looks to be good speed engaged and he's part of that brigade. Fangela and Tap 'N' Run did battle in the Flat Knacker at Albury last start were they were both a tad disappointing in a small field. Tap 'N' Run is known to improve sharply second-up however and looks better suited this time over Fangela who is caught in the cheap seats out wide. Can see them starting closer together come the jump. Premosphere was taken to Canterbury first-up off a long break, highlighting how well the stable thought she was going. Looks well placed here with that run under her belt and can feature.

Race Analysis: Vinniro comes here off a 323-day spell but has moved nicely at the trials coming into this. He showed plenty of class early in his career and the ratings he put up last campaign stack up highly. Needs to return at that level, but his trials suggest it's not out of the question. Octa De Lago is another who has impressed at the trials, winning his latest Warwick Farm heat with the blinkers on, which stay on today for the 3YO. Blaike McDougall's booking says he's ready to go on debut and he'll be right in the finish if he can run up to what the trials have shown. 2YO's tend to be poorly weighted in these events and with the class on offer, Lockhart may find himself a little short in early betting. Hard to ignore what he did on debut at Nowra though and will be better for that, but will have to go up a level again now on what the ratings to show. Bardette trialed well coming in but was a drifter on debut and was just fair in the finish. Thinking she's better than what she showed there and may be some value at her early price.
