Race Analysis: Thinking the opening race revolves around the top of the Handicap. Shes'adare got the job done in a similar race a fortnight ago in a strong performance over 1080m when running to a new peak rating with Racing and Sports. The key is that her previous peak had come over 1200m prior, hinting that she may be able to go to another level now up in trip. This shapes similarly to her last start and there looks to be some juice in her early price. Don't Tell Jack comes right back in grade today after going under as a \$16 chance a fortnight ago. He led them up there and was only gunned down late and he's been competitive and in the market in similar races in the Northern Rivers. He appears the main speed influence in the race and if he gets it his own way up front, he'll be hard to run down once again. Beau Rock loomed into the race last start but couldn't finish it off in stronger company and comes back to this level where he won well two starts back. Can sit close to the speed and will give a sight again. Wouldn't surprise to see Santorini Sun sit a touch closer this time around and can be flying home late in the race.

Race Analysis: Want to make Our Red Planet much shorter than his early quote, however the 6YO is 0/8 at this distance in what is a big nigggle. He's been narrowly beaten in a similar event earlier this campaign on the Course Proper here, but all his recent form is over 1000m. While he looks to have plenty in his favour and will find this a touch easier than recent races, that is the one big question mark that makes me hesitant to load the cannons. Along with that, Jacob Joe from the Byrne stable looks ready to fire after flying home from the back of the pack last start behind She'sadare (Race 1). The inside barrier can see him sit much closer than he did last start, similar to how he did on April 18th when winning on the turf course. Can play a leading role. Merchant Reign has to be included on recent performances and has winning claims back to 1200m and this grade. Dodge The Dark was better last start at Queanbeyan in a CL1 and the winner of that race was well backed at Goulburn last week. Not out of this.

Race Analysis: Keen to side with the Rob Potter gelding Flashy Icon. He was very strong late in the race over 1750m last start on The Acton, showing his staying prowess as the leader began to curl up late in the race. The sectionals say he wasn't stopping close to home and the rise to 1900m now looks ideal with Quayde Krogh remaining in the saddle. He has an edge on the ratings off that effort and if he can run up to that figure, he should be bringing up his second win. Lucky Star was just sound at Queanbeyan in this grade last month when beaten as a \$4.60 chance. He'd have to improve on those figures now up against Flashy Icon, but he is the main danger on the ratings he's produced recently. Ausbred Nunya steps right up in trip now for the first time. Being by Dundee, it should suit this mare, and it wouldn't surprise to see her turn in an improved effort.

Race Analysis: With the Scratching of McTominay this morning, the race looks wide open now for the locally-trained Souk. He comes through a good maiden where the first three across the line cleared out from the rest of the field. He wasn't far off his old form for the new stable first-up and he has the speed to roll across from out wide. He turned in a strong rating in a maiden last start and with the thought he can improve on that effort, there looks to be some value about him. Yindymarra trialled well on this surface after the last a fortnight ago and the horse that ran third in the trial ran 2nd at Wagga on Thursday. That form reads well and suggests she can make an impact on debut.

Race Analysis: Another race where scratchings have helped do the form for us, chipping away at the top end and leaving Indie Mae as the one with most appeal. She had trialled well coming into her fresh effort but disappointed there on a Soft track. She's been back to the trials since where she was very impressive on the polytrack at Warwick Farm. She showed good speed there and looks to be on the speed from barrier five under Jeff Penza. Her best run has been on a good track which she'll get this time around, and Pride has won 5/15 on the Acton track since 2021. Can notch up her maiden win in this suitable event. Cold Mist Surprised last start on his first try on this track. He has to back up that performance now, but he won't be far away if he can.

Race Analysis: Great Federal with a touch of class at the top. Mogo Magic drops right back in grade today after contesting much stronger races in recent campaigns. He was placed second-up in BM88 level at Canterbury last campaign as a \$2.25 chance and he's now a bigger price to win on the Acton in an Open Handicap. He still has a big weight to carry on some handy rivals, but he has speed and will be tough to run down. Craving Magic was super on this surface last season when winning a similar event. He hasn't dropped off from that level on ratings and comes in off a short freshen. Can sit close to the speed and make his presence felt. Punters were coming from the trees to back Prophet's Pride first-up and looked to have her chance. She will be fitter for that effort and improvement is expected, but she's probably priced up correctly early on. Keikoku is likely to get back and will need the run despite running some very sharp sectionals last start at Parkes and Chop The Ice was competitive in similar events last season on the Acton. Both have claims.

Race Analysis: He needs a couple of scratchings to gain a start, but if Irish Jig can gain a run, he'll go close to bringing up back-to-back wins. He used his strength to his advantage in some sharp tactics, setting a strong tempo and running his rivals off their feet here last time out. He was curling up late in the race, but he draws better this time, and he rates highly down in the weights. The horse he beat has since run at Warwick Farm on Wednesday and if he can back up his recent effort, he'll be hard to catch. Behind him, it's a bit of a raffle. Nothing separated Xceptional Fell and Exotic Dancer last start and both have drawn wide this time around. Their ratings are similar to what Tigers Roar ran last start at Gunnedah when winning a CL1 in comfortable fashion and has shown early speed in his recent events. That's a big advantage over his rivals and he can play a major role. Christmas Star is right there on ratings as well and has claims.
