Wide draw for Goofinator but there isn't a lot of speed engaged and the map can be seen as a real positive for him. Should roll across and no shock if he took up the running without much pressure. Did set up a decent speed figure last time. Zouwase is the one to get handy with him. Well held at the end last time and Steamed Hams stayed past him but also set up a decent time and it can be seen as a step in the right direction. If that is the front of the betting then Black Bugatti must see this as his moment. Maiden after 13 but his best ratings are the best on offer. Beaten in lone Acton run but got into an ordinary spot in better company than this.

Super Extreme also arrives off a win last time. Did it well but they overdid things up front chasing a pattern and collapsed in front of him. Capital Heart was part of that collapse and might do better though the draw does him few favours and he has thrown up more bad than good lately. Sutton Vella won fresh and a couple of winners have come out from behind him there. Easy to excuse the last start in town given conditions but there must be a big of a niggle about him out past 1000m.
