I would have Bardette as second pick though. She continues to knock on the door of a maiden win, though tends to find herself in poor spots in relation to the speed of the race. Would be a surprise to see her beat Mortlake, but she looks the best of the rest.

Race Analysis: Happy to take a stab at Royal Detective here in an easier race than he took on last start. The track played very funky that day, but he still finished off strongly into second, albeit well off the winner. Suspect he can sit closer from the gate this time around and he does possess more upside than his rivals. With his rivals being a touch flaky, he makes the most appeal, particularly at his early price. Good Once has had plenty of spins but had been competitive in Provincial company last campaign. His trial was very sharp over the short course and while he usually does his racing over further, this looks a suitable kick off point. Into The Fire had been around the mark in previous efforts but landed the knockout blow last time on that bias track here a fortnight ago. Suspect similar tactics will be adopted this time around, but he's got to repeat that effort which is the big query given his overall record.

Race Analysis: Looks a race in 3 on form and figures and the market is trending that way too. Joe Pride and connections have been patient with My Proclama, though it looks like she'll pay them back rather swiftly judging by her trials coming in. She's shown the ability to sit on the speed or take a sit, which could prove important with her main dangers being speedy types as well. Miss Trentino turned in a strong figure for an Acton Maiden last start when close at Hawkesbury, leading the field on that occasion. She'll be able to show that speed today from a good barrier and that's the benchmark that My Proclama will have to reach on debut, with Miss Trentino possibly having more improvement to come now third-up into the campaign. Expecting Gladstone Grande to give a bold sight from the front as well, particularly with the 4kg claim.

Race Analysis: Thinking Laurel Hill has enough class to land favourite here third-up from a short break. With her main dangers all being speedy types - and the expectation that Pretty Vegas will fly along with the apprentice on board - she can sit just off them and have the last crack. Her two runs in town have been sound without setting the world alight, though her best figures have all been when on top of the ground. Her figures are already up to the mark and the prospect of still having another gear to find makes her an attractive prospect. Fine Vintage has done nothing wrong this time in, scoring comfortably his past couple. Losing Heywood isn't ideal however and with the pace angle I'm taking, it leans me away from him, particularly with how the track played last start. Pretty Vegas has early speed and bumped into a smart one last time out on a Soft deck at Canterbury. Suspect she'll try and run them into the ground with no weight on her back. Capital Heart is another speedy customer. He's better than he showed last start and isn't out of this on his best form.

Race Analysis: Going to flip the first two in the early market and have Avonview on top following a strong win here 35 days ago. While that is the slight query, he has run well under similar circumstances, including at this track and trip. Avonview has the early speed to make use of the inside barrier and the claim of Ramsbotham sees him nicely weighted. She'll be ahead of Cosmic Lad in the run, and that'll be the key. Joe Pride's charge was very strong late at Wyong and the sectionals show the rise in trip should be right up his alley. The blinkers go back on today and this is his first time beyond a mile since the Sydney Derby in 2024. The main query is his racing pattern, coupling that with a wide draw may see him slip some handy horses too much of a head start. Midnight Luna is another who is a query on the map. She's shown some adaptability in recent events and if she rolls forward from the gate, then she'll be right in contention.

Race Analysis: Scratchings have made Guerrera an attractive proposition at the top of the betting. While she's an odds-on quote this morning, there still may be some value in that price with how things set up for her off the inside draw. He'll roll to the front and while he's likely to have some company, he has a ratings edge on what she's done in her recent efforts. Climate Change was staying on nicely behind Guerrera on last start but there is nothing in the sectionals to say she was unlucky or should have finished closer. She may be able to sit a touch closer in the run today which is a big tick. Tokyo Ice has shown glimpses in her career and produced new peaks in two of her 3 efforts last time in work. This trip looks ideal first-up and she can surprise. Sir Lunchalots had a stack of support here last time but felt the pinch after leading and would need to improve. Happy to be against Sir Lunchalots who had stacks of support here a fortnight ago and couldn't go on with the job. He was off a freshen there and is likely to be fitter, but he'd have to go to a new level today off a poor performance and that's very hard to forecast.
