Race Analysis: Not the most exciting of starts to a raceday I've witnessed, though it does get better throughout the card - just like one of those fine Murrumbateman Winery Cab Sav's! Storm Park is the clear pick on RAS Ratings and while a small field did bring him unstuck last start at Tamworth, I suspect Blaike McDougall won't make the same mistakes this time around. Just has to hold his form to be coming out on top. Hard to throw one up around him, though Pontiac should probably be second pick on ratings. He was good last start over the mile here in a race that was only moderately run. His late splits were solid and with the step up to 2000m now, it wouldn't surprise to see him in the go close.

Race Analysis: Expecting both the Gorrel-trained horses to come out of this event with both Lost Ya Sock and Hot Toddy engaged on their home track next week. Thinking this is a two-horse race just as the market suggests, though the early edge may lay with Tomcat Flowers. He was very good at Goulburn first-up on the Heavy deck when running to a new peak RAS Rating and that sets him up nicely for the campaign ahead. He jumped \$1.90 when second-up last campaign at Queanbeyan and was home before he threw the race away with 150m remaining. He's had a few chances, but with a strong rider like Guymer booked to ride, he can keep Tomcat on the straight and narrow to notch up his maiden victory. Wild Legacy plugged home fairly in the wet at Nowra on debut before never really getting into the race last time out at Muswellbrook. She has upside being a 3YO filly with McDougall booked, though I would've liked to have seen more from her last start at Muswellbrook. Clearly second pick on what she's done thus far, but she'll have to raise the bar to reel in Tomcat.

Race Analysis: With a couple of local brews under my belt, it's time to let rip and back a local in She's High Society. It may sound obvious, but the form out of these BM50's tend to work out well when up against their own grade and that's a big key when assessing She's High Society's form. Aegipan beat her last start (scratched from this) and then jumped a \$12 chance in a stronger race at Goulburn earlier this week. That bodes well for She's High Society who jumped in the market and was only narrowly beaten there. She has the speed to work across from the wide draw and she beat the likes of Prophet Time and Shelley's Ace that day. Picksix is on the quick turnaround today after finishing off strongly in this company over 1200m last time out. He comes in with a solid RAS Rating off that effort, though the drop back to 1000m is the query. For me, Prophet Time and Shelley's Ace seem too close in the market to She's High Society off we've seen in recent weeks, though Motorboat comes in with different form from better races. She only raced on Tuesday at Leeton, but the drop in grade can see her improve on what she's done recently.

Race Analysis: Thinking this market at the top of betting should be a little closer than what we're seeing early doors. Keen to be with the Litt-trained Nabha who trialled well and turned in a solid time on the day last week at Warwick Farm. She showed plenty of early speed there, so hopefully McDougall lets her roll across with Parting The Seas also a speedy type. When assessing Nabha's trial time, the quality of horse her time stacks up against is on the high side for a maiden of this quality, holding her in good stead for her debut performance. Parting The Seas should be able to give Nabha a cart across, though he won't be easy to get by in the run to the line. The form out of that maiden though leaves a bit to be desired, but the stable has tinkered with his gear and he'll give himself every chance. Justwatchher may be a bit of a sneaky flying under the radar. No trials this time in work and she had no luck at all on debut during the Wagga Cup Carnival. When she got out late at Wagga she worked well to the line however, and the fact Smart took her there suggests he may have an opinion of her. She looks the only one away from the top two.

Race Analysis: Bit of a raffle this one and probably a good leg to take a few in the Quaddie. Single Beat steps up to this distance for the first time, though based on what we've seen from her recently, it doesn't appear a negative. She drops in weight as she rises only slightly in grade, and the inside barrier should see her get every chance to produce her best. While Apparate has done plenty of racing on a Wet deck, labelling him a 'wet tracker' could prove costly. Back in his time with Ciaron Maher, he was running similar figures on Good surfaces as he is now with Kirkup on soggy tracks. All of that is to say that she rates well off that latest effort behind Luna Angel and the booking of McDougall is a big push for her chances. She is 0/6 at this trip, but they have all been in stronger company than she meets here. Can see some value in her early price. Lysander may be another who has some value early in betting landing here third-up and with Guymer now taking the ride. He's in form and strikes at 11% when teaming up with the Thorotek stable. Drawn well and can play a major role off what we've seen from him this time in work. Luna Angel was too good last start right down in the weights and although this is an easier race, this is a completely different scenario to the one that saw her victorious 15 days ago.

Race Analysis: This looks a good Federal with some handy form lines coming in. Win The Day is the progressive one on the rise, placing in Highway company as a \$7.50 chance before stretching to a mile at the end of her last preparation. She worked through the grades impressively, running a new peak RAS Rating four runs in a row before hitting the midweeks at Warwick Farm. A firm deck on resumption isn't an issue and with the scope to raise the bar again this time in work, she can get her campaign off on a winning note. Stronger form comes in through the likes of Sass 'N' Cheek, though that appears to be her level. While that can sometimes hold negative connotations, in this environment it holds her in good stead as she lands down in the weights and with a good map. The booking of Guymmer suggests she's ready to go first-up and if she's at that level, she's sure to be in the finish. Getty won the Sprinter's Cup two back before failing at Gundagai. He stepped a little slow there and was unable to have the race to his liking - which usually exacerbates the losing margin. He should be able to find the front today however and if he gets it all his own way up front, he'll be a tough nut to crack in the straight. The track played very on-pace here 12 months ago and if it's the same here today, he'll be some value.
