**Race Analysis:** Looks a pretty even race on paper and not one I'm diving in to. Beau Rock jumped favourite ahead of Merchant Reign two starts ago on the Acton track here, with the former just too speedy on the day. Since then, Merchant Reign turned in a strong effort in stronger company, while Beau Rock drifted back and probably found them too speedy over 1000m here last time out. Going off their runs two back and the set up that faces them today, they should be closer in the market, meaning there could be some edge around the Vella-trained Beau Rock. Merchant Reign is the deserved favourite, but the market behind him is where the interest lies. Champ De Mars has been ticking along nicely in stronger races, finishing 3.5 lengths away in a Class 1 at Mudgee last start and tackling Provincial grade prior to that. She's right back in grade now and it wouldn't surprise to see her have some fans late in betting. Single Beat comes through that same race as Beau Rock where she hit the line nicely, finishing a narrow second. Rising to 1200m now is some query, with her past two 1200m runs in this grade being rather plain, though she'll carry less weight this time and is an obvious threat on that performance.

**Race Analysis:** This looks a strong maiden, and Lethal Love may be the pick of them. Things set up beautifully for her today albeit a 3YO taking on the older horses. Her two trials in town have been super and the map looks favourable for her from an inside barrier. May just need some luck at the top of the straight to find daylight, but she looks the one to beat on what we've seen publicly. Uber In and Baycat trialed on the same day at Warwick Farm, and while Baycat won her heat, she was ~1.25 lengths slower than Uber In. With that, they have to be held together in the market, though I would still have the gap between them slightly bigger. Dee Dee Express led in her trial and ended up finishing 2.2 lengths back in fifth, though she wasn't asked to do a whole lot in her Kembala Grange heat. Can show early speed and be in this for a long way. Happy to put a line through Deep Affection despite the filly having tackled strong races in her debut campaign. Her trials have only been fair and while it can be suggested that they're coming here 'for an easy kill', I think it's more the fact she mightn't be going that well. I'll eat my words if she wins, but I would've liked to have seen more from her at the trials coming in.

**Race Analysis:** Tricky race over the mile with plenty with the capability to improve. O'Sheamus looks the obvious following a strong run in Heavy going on Goulburn Cup Day where he was just left flat-footed when they sprinted for home. He looks suited up in trip and this looks an easier maiden on paper. Stellar Rhonda may appreciate the firmer footing this time around after a fair debut performance at Newcastle on a map where the outside fence was the place to be. Her trial since was very solid however and she looks open to sharp improvement, particularly with the set up. Alzaman is a hard one to line up. He was good in his debut performance at Newcastle when beaten 4.3 lengths and it's hard to get a read on his trials, with all of them around the 1050m distance. The draw probably doesn't suit him with his early speed, and he'll likely be better over further, but he looks to have some ability, and he can't be discounted. Brooklyn Eyes is another one that's hard to line up. She was too good first-up at the Sapphire Coast and but has been disappointing in her two runs since. Back from Provincial grade last start, but the run prior at Moruya was just fair. Brutal Eyes didn't get it all her own way up front last start and is better than she showed there.

**Race Analysis:** Another tricky race to assess. Felis Chaus is the correct favourite on the back of an impressive run first-up at Gosford, though the barrier draw will see her well back in running. No doubt the bigger track today will suit her and the booking of McDougall is a big push for her chances. While it may be a tough watch in the run, if she can run up to the splits she produced at her first-up run then she'll be flying late in the race. She's A Dame will be at the opposite end of the spectrum with her early speed holding her in good stead. She'll be fitter for two trials and was solid on debut at Nowra when leading over 1400m. Can give them something to chase. The Eyes Have It comes through a maiden here last week that we'll get a good line on through Dancing Man in R2. Just have a slight niggles going from 1000m to 1300m, but the fresh run was solid and that may set her up nicely for this. Winning Rulet was better last start at Wyong when sitting on the speed and that rating stacks up in this field. The firm deck looks a big tick for her chances and she's right in the mix with improvement expected, though the barrier makes things tricky.

**Race Analysis:** Keen to follow up on the locally trained Buenos after a big win first-up. It highlighted that the debut campaign wasn't a fluke, picking up in good order with further improvement anticipated. She should've finished much closer to the winner second-up last campaign in the Guineas Preview and drawing outside again is a big tick under Rebecca Bronnett Prag. She's a lightly raced mare with stacks of upside, though this race does shape better for Petawawa who was no match for Buenos last start. She returned as good as ever, Petawawa, but was still no match for the Dryden & Snowden galloper. Suspect this time she'll be in front of Buenos and she gets a big weight swing in her favour. She ticks plenty of boxes with McDougall hopping on board too and the race looks to revolve around those two at the top of betting.

**Race Analysis:** Keen to play in the Black Mountain, taken out by Tulla Park 12 months ago. This time I'm hoping for a local victory with Take The Rap who has been eyeing this event throughout his campaign. He felt the pinch second-up on the Acton and was taken back from the draw at Warwick Farm most recently, but his late work was solid enough. Down in weight now and into what looks a very suitable race for a horse with his ability. He still has some upside about him and on recent figures, he's clearly the one to beat. Vella's Best dropped back to country level last start and bolted in to win a CL3 at Moruya. He carried the grandstand there and now drops right down to 55kg. He has the speed to roll across from out wide, though Take The Rap is expected to be within striking distance on straightening. Mogo Magic couldn't land a blow on the Acton, though his runs suggested he wasn't far off his best. That form holds up here and he's likely to be prominent from the outset. His stablemate Extravagent Lad was solid at the trials here last meeting and can fire first-up, though there doesn't seem to be any edge in his early price.

**Race Analysis:** Even race to end the day which makes things tricky. Webejamin wasn't beaten far in town last start and drops right back to Country level today. Despite her strong run last start, she remains right down in the weights with the step up to 1600m being ideal. She's building nicely this time in work and now hits a winnable race. Map looks a bit sticky, but she has shown early speed in the past and she looks the right favourite. Bit of a raffle behind her. Mah Ali flew home at Wyong last start after getting back over 1350m and finished less than a length away on the line. Her record at the mile isn't great, but she's spent plenty of time in stronger company than this and she's right in this race on her last start effort. Ronny Rock Art is such a good old horse, clinging on to win last start in a photo finish. Tougher here, but he drops down in weight and he does look one of the only speed influences in the race. From his good draw he should get every chance to notch up back-to-back wins. This spot also looks good for Missile Leader who can improve now fourth-up off a long break. His only try at this track and trip he jumped a \$2 favourite and bolted in carrying 62kgs. A lot has happened in the 18 months since, but he showed he wasn't far off his best last start at Moruya and he's worth including in quaddie's and exotics. Happy to look past Philadelphia Storm after she got over her rivals in a slowly run mile at Goulburn last time out. Burgundy Girl was the flashing light run first-up in the Federal here a fortnight ago, but she can tend to be the flashing light without knocking one off. This does look a different scenario for her as well with less pace engaged which is a query.
