Race Analysis: Back onto the Turf course today following a successful Acton season through winter. Looking back on this meeting 12 months ago, the rail was in the True position and the track played very fair. Although tempo dependant, every horse should get their chance. Looking to bet early in the card with the Freedman's bringing down Yes I Win on the back of three trials in Sydney. While the finishing positions don't jump out at you, the work he produced was solid enough and this isn't an overly strong maiden. Suspect he'll be able to get into the race from an inside barrier with the in-form Guymer booked. Keen to play him in the first. While I'd usually like a horse with Zo Frilling's profile, she's had plenty of chances to notch up a win now and she's been at the head of the market on a number of occasions. That includes races at Goulburn and Nowra where she's jumped at the head of the market and gone under. Her past couple of ratings has been solid, but nothing that stamps her as the one to beat. Thinking she may be vulnerable to the newcomer. Brannum never got into the race at Goulburn last start and is better placed here out in distance. His only 1400m run produced some good form out of it last campaign, but he'll have to go to another level third-up and it's hard to back him to do that off a flop last time out.

Race Analysis: A tricky maiden where you can make a case for plenty of them, so I think it's best to just watch and learn. The Dryden & Snowden stable have been a little lean in 2025 thus far but look to have one with a bit of talent on debut here in Sweet Warrior. The stable raced the dam who was a handy horse in her own right up to the mile. The trial form is iffy however, with the horse she beat jumping a \$13 chance in the Highway last Saturday (good) but finished well back (bad). Not willing to stamp her a clear-cut top pick with Cosmic Eagle having some handy ratings behind her which saw her jump a \$1.60 chance at Muswellbrook two starts back. Disappointed last start at Hawkesbury but this looks to set up better for her from a better gate. The Eyes Have It seems a touch over the odds early doors for the new stable. A profile like hers is very attractive in a race like this, jumping \$1.30 in a Country maiden two back and \$3.70 at Newcastle last time out. Being 0/7 is a niggle, though it's easier here and Pepper has had success with similar types recently. She's Assort has shown good promise at the trials in Sydney coming into this too and can't be discounted. Happy to watch and learn something here and we may be able to follow a few out of this race going forward.

Race Analysis: After keeping our powder dry through the past few races, lets dive into Buenos on resumption for the local stable. She was a strong winner at this track and trip on debut with good splits late and then backed that up in the Guineas Prelude behind Oaks placegetter Sun 'N' Sand. That form reads well for a race like this where she gets in at the bottom of the weights. Don't love the earmuffs going on, but she rates right up to her rivals, they're all giving her weight, and she has the upside to blow by them now. Beer Baron was strong late in the Highway and I'm glad he steps up to 1200m rather than back in trip. He looks to get a gun run on the map and he'll take catching if he can run up to the figures he produced last start. Magic Leprechaun flew home to win first-up clocking some fast late splits but couldn't repeat the dose last start. Up in trip now from an inside draw may be the recipe he needs to bounce back.

Race Analysis: Think there's some value in the early price of Brutal Eyes who can make her own luck up on the speed. She should be at her peak fitness now after a good run at Bathurst where she was only caught late and her win here two back on the Acton was very good. She has a slight ratings edge on those two performances, though that also seems the strongest formlines coming into this race. The claim of Ramsbotham helps and this looks a very suitable race for her to return to winning form. Happy mark her much shorter with Cosmic Ride's form looking a little suspect. He was beaten at the Picnics earlier this campaign before two solid runs in easier company on the Acton most recently. Brutal Eyes' form looks much deeper than that. The Olive stable had some opinion of Vinari, though it took her longer than anticipated to break her maiden. That rating stacks up however and she does have the scope to go on with it. Needs some luck from the alley but with the blinkers on first time, further improvement may be in store.

Race Analysis: Good Federal this and interestingly, Belleistic Kids beat Laurel Hill in this very race 12 months ago - how about that! Thinking that the former has been aimed towards this and while his form doesn't read well on paper, I think it sets up nicely for a race of this scale. He's never really handled a Heavy deck which he's faced his past couple on the Kensington track and his first-up effort at Wyong when on a similar track to this was solid. I'll concede the draw is a query, though he looks well placed in this event on his recent ratings and this looks a great chance for him to return to winning ways. Epaullo Creed creates plenty of interest as a double-figure chance, particularly with his light weight and attractive racing pattern. He couldn't be caught last time out, and he only rises 0.5kg following the claim of Bradley. He looks the main speed on paper, and he'll give a bold sight from the front. Spirits Burn Dep rates well on her latest win in a CL3 at Goulburn and has hinted that she's up to this grade. Needs to repeat the dose which could be the niggle on her profile, however she can't be discounted on the latest effort. Tavolo worked through the grades nicely last time in work and her fresh run in Saturday Metro grade when unlucky sticks in my mind. Might be a sweet spot for her first-up and can land the knockout blow in an open Federal. Plenty of chances in a cracking race!

Race Analysis: Magic Pharoah comes into this third-up and the with the cope to improve sharply. Her last start at Newcastle was on a bog track and while she did find the best going out wide, her best form has always been on a Soft or Good track. Third-up now and back to country level is a big tick and she'll be able to lob into a nice midfield position under Ryan. With some knocks on her rivals and with some improvement up her sleeve, she makes the most appeal in another competitive contest. Acheson also fits the bill of an improving type with a good run when out to the mile last start at Goulburn in a good race. He maps to sit a touch closer this time around for Guymer, the wet track won't hurt, and his ratings are good enough to feature. Samurai and Tom Cruising comes through the same race at Goulburn where the former was just better on the day. Thinking the wet track is a niggle for Samurai and that leaves him vulnerable at the top of the market. Expecting those two to start a similar price. Ronny Rock Art is a great old horse and never puts a foot wrong. He'll be on the speed, he'll relish the going and he'll be in this for a very long way.
