While on paper her trial suggests it wasn't too flash, she hit the line nicely after being a touch awkward into stride. She was a good winner over this track and trip on debut before jumping \$1.55 in a Class 1. She didn't handle the Heavy going prior to the break, though the figures in her two runs here stack right up. Looks well placed on resumption with McDougall in the saddle. Noctua wasn't far away on the Acton last campaign and has performed well on this course previously. Should get every chance to produce her best off the inside.

Race Analysis: Tsarina Diamonds lines up for the new stable on Matt Kelley Racing Raceday after racing in Victoria for the Shane Nichols barn. Back to the mile today looks a good move with her best figures coming over 1700m three back and 1610m two back. She's a speedy customer, so can take up the running and dictate from the front under Penza. No doubt been targeted to this and a return to her mile figures can see her win on her stable debut. Fire Island is another who looks better placed back to this distance after failing to run out 2000m last start at Kembla. Her runs prior stack up nicely for a race of this calibre and sharp improvement is anticipated. Poker Flash was strong late here on Hops & Hooves Day and while this is tougher, the rise to the mile won't pose an issue on the back of that performance.

Race Analysis: Wolf Island was edged out in a strong race at Goulburn and there's been a winner out of that race already. The winkers go on for the first time today and the booking of Cahill suggests it's go time now. Cahill strikes at 19% when teaming up with the Gardner barn and there doesn't look to be any excuses for him today, particularly after scratchings. Common Goal returned in good order at Nowra when sneaking up the inside in the straight. He jumped a 20-1 chance there however on the back of a couple of plain runs to begin his career. He may be an improved commodity this time in work, though I'd like to see it one more time before taking the early price about him. Prophet's Promise comes into calculations after scratchings. Ran on well in a 1400m Maiden here two back and maybe the stretch to the mile was a bridge too far most recently. He's shown glimpses of ability throughout his debut preparation and if he ran up to those expectations, he may be some value.

Race Analysis: If you're into odds-on pops, then Tyrone's Power is one for you. He ran around in some good races as a 2YO and jumped a \$1.14 chance at Newcastle to end last campaign, going under in Heavy conditions. His trial at Warwick Farm this time in was scintillating with Jason Collett taking it very easy on board. Thinking he can settle close to the speed, and he'd only have to pick up from where he left off to be getting the job done. Aside from Tyrone, the Maher debutant in Margin Call looks the other. His latest trial was very impressive when winning at Randwick and he showed the ability to sit just off the speed and launch late. That may come in handy here with some good speed engaged and he looks a classy type himself. Happy to hitch the bandwagon to those two in the first leg of the quaddie.

Race Analysis: Teylu turned in a strong figure first-up at Wagga when jumping the favourite and finishing 1-1/4 lengths away. He'll be better for that effort and the favourable alley will see him sit close to the speed once again. Think he's well placed on his recent rating and it wouldn't shock to see plenty of support late for him. One who the market may have missed is Ischyros from the Scott Collings barn. It took him a while to break his maiden, though he had shown good promise in the process and strung two on-end before tackling Highway company. The two figures he put up to win those events are right up to what Teylu has run to in recent times and the Cahill knows him well. May need some luck from the barrier but he's worth having something on at the price. Sooo Crazy drops back in trip after a disappointing effort last time out and has a few RAS Ratings that are competitive here. Will give them something to chase from an inside draw. Sparkingly has trialled well coming in and the booking of McDougall says she's ready to go, but this is a tricky spot to back horses after so long off. More than a year off the scene and while the trials were good coming in, there's enough doubts there to be shouldering arms, especially when she was beaten in similar company in the country throughout her last campaign.

Race Analysis: Keen to play Bravissima in the Federal. She looks well placed here off what she did last campaign, beginning with a strong win first-up for the new stable over 1200m. The 1400m journey today looks ideal with the mare proving the mile was no issue last time in work. Can lob just off the speed and if she can resume on a similar note to how she finished last campaign, she'll be hard to hold out. Hot Bandit looked as though he needed the run first-up at Warwick Farm but improved sharply last campaign off a similar effort to win pretty much the same race as this. Up in the weights now, but the fresh run will hold him in good stead and he's the obvious danger. Champions League and Genetic Freak bring in similar ratings from the Federal here on Hops & Hooves Day. Champions League draws better this time and probably won't concede as big a head start as he did a fortnight ago. Hard to see either horse spiking off that performance and however you assess one, the other needs to be considered in the same vein. Future Fund was a good winner at Leeton and finished quickly to boot. May be a sneaky at double figures. Missile Leader is 25-1 and shaped nicely last start before bottoming out late in the race. Looks well set up this time and is worth including.

Race Analysis: Savaii was very impressive on debut at Goulburn over 1100m and the splits he ran late suggest the rise in trip today is no issue at all. Collett was on board that day and she sticks with the gelding. Drawn a little sticky, but he showed early speed last start over 1100m, so the option is there to push forward if they wish. He put good gaps back through the field, showing a lot of what we look for in a nice horse at Racing and Sports. Last start rating stands out and he's sure to be popular to finish the day. Dooralong bolted in after sitting on the speed at Moruya 24 days ago. Should get every chance from the inside draw again and while he would have to improve just a touch, there's nothing to suggest he can't make the necessary leap. Azzucca was too strong from up on the speed last time out and that form has already been franked.
