Race Analysis: Nice little race to get things underway where Teylu and Noctua find themselves joint favourites at opposite ends of the Handicap. The former comes through a stronger race here a fortnight ago where he was well backed, was caught wide and just plugged away to the finish. He was a little flat there, but back in grade now and a chance to land in a better position in running, this looks to set up nicely. Noctua comes through the race won by She's High Society last start where she jumped a \$4.20 chance. While she does drop in weight, she's yet to be to the level of Teylu according to the RAS Ratings. She's High Society got the job done in that race Noctua comes through, turning in a good figure in the process. She'd promised to do something in her starts prior since winning on the Acton back in August but hadn't been able to land the knockout blow. She must be tied to Noctua through that performance and much like that horse, taking the early price about a horse who was \$18 in an easier race last start is hard to cop. Can win but she's of no value.

Race Analysis: We were keen on Callenem Thru here last start where she ended up a long way back and left with too much to do. As the market tells us, this is a great spot for her to land on the back of that effort, with the rise in trip and better barrier suiting her much better. Unfortunately, no spoils in the price but where she sits early doors is correct. Rileycat turned in a nice trial at Goulburn in readiness for this and may be one who can spoil the party. Sound behind So You Pence first-up at Goulburn last campaign and along with Callenem Thru, is a galloper who has more upside than her rivals.

Race Analysis: Little Lunch went around a 25-1 chance last start at Hawkesbury but turned in some strong figures while still looking as though she had improvement to come. That's a scary proposition as she comes back to Country grade and gets in well under the conditions of this race. Third-up now and out in trip, she looks primed to improve on the RAS Rating she produced last start, although she would only have to repeat her last start performance to win this. Ziggy Rose looked like a horse crying out for further when winning at Moruya two back and did so again when kept to the mile at Goulburn last start. No reason to jump off her from that Goulburn performance and the positive is that she has plenty of room for improvement. Draw is a query, but there's plenty to like, especially on her soon-to-be home track. Anulfa was unlucky not to finish closer here a fortnight ago and getting away from the inside rail looks ideal for him. He was held up at a crucial stage last start and with what looks a better set up today, he can build into the race at the right time to put his best foot forward. Whether that is good enough will be the question he needs to answer. Dunwithya was sound at Goulburn over a similar trip and has claims. Happy to throw up Hustie as one for exotics too at a good price. I'm liking what I'm seeing from her without winning and I think she can run a cheeky race out to 2000m now.

Race Analysis: Market matches the RAS Ratings here that it's a race in two. There's no denying Dundee Flyer is the right favourite, coming through much stronger races than this where she's been getting miles back and left with too much to do. While she's not been given much chance recently, this shapes a very different scenario from an inside barrier and against slower horses. If she can be in the first half of the field in settling, that'll go a long way to her getting the job done. If the eye didn't tell you Roonami was a good thing licked last start, then assessing the sectionals told the tale. Settling a clear last in a field of six, a rider being dislodged caused some interference for the filly and she just had too much work to do from that point onwards. While the rise to 1400m is suitable, she's going to be a long way back from the barrier, and in turn from Dundee Flyer. She's the main danger away from Dundee Flyer, but if things go her way, she'll be powering home at the finish.

Race Analysis: Good sprint this. Action King trialled very impressively here last month and went straight to an Open event on Cup Day at Dubbo where nothing went right for him. He was caught very wide but still loomed into the race like he would be in the finish. He felt the pinch late but there was enough behind that effort to suggest the Potter stable have him in good order. Much better scenario for him this time and he jumped a \$2.70 chance at the midweeks when second-up last campaign. Rebel Dean comes through the race won by Take The Rap at Moruya, turning in a strong RAS Rating when back to country level. Looked to have his chance there and just bumped into one better, but he meets Take The Rap better at the weights today and they were clear of the rest. This looks to shape nicely from a good barrier, and it wouldn't surprise to see him take up the running and give a bold sight again. Mighty Myrtle finds herself a big price here first-up but she's worth specking. A winner at this track and trip when first-up two campaigns ago, she never really got into her work when tackling the Country Championships heats last time in. She'll be back from the barrier, but with no weight on her back it wouldn't surprise to have her come sailing down the outside. My Last Hooray is a nice horse, but the set up here just looks a bit iffy. Back to 1000m now after going to 1300m last start is a query and others have the ratings to match him at this distance.

Race Analysis: Time for the Federal now and this looks to shape differently to recent racing where Genetic Freak has been able to dictate, and that's all thanks to the addition of Epuallo Creed who should set an even speed up front. That will suit a horse like Tavolo who was very gallant in defeat at Kembla last time out, ducking back to the inside which has never really been the place to be. The good gate should see her positioned just off the speed and Alysha Collett is a very good booking. Brings good RAS Ratings into this and she looks to have some value in her early price. Due Calzini couldn't reel in Epaullo Creed in the Cootamundra Cup, and the market will tell you that this is a harder race, with Epaullo Creed \$6.50 there and now double figures. Had his chance there and may be looking for further now after wins over 2100m and 2500m last campaign. He'll be spotting his rivals a bigger head start from the barrier this time around as well, so while he's a classy customer, there's enough against him to trim up Tavolo. Another who should appreciate more pace is Hot Bandit who never got a crack last start when the race was stolen from up front. He was doing his best work late there and while his form on paper reads 8th and 9th this time in, he's had some excuses in both efforts. Thinking he can turn in a much more "Hot Bandit" like performance in this.

Race Analysis: We were with Savaii last start, and he didn't let us down, pulling away to win impressively and highlighting once again that he's a nice horse in the making. Scratchings this morning make this an easier task to manage from the barrier for Alysha Collett who can land on the speed without a hitch. If he can bang up the RAS Ratings he's produced his first couple of starts, he can remain unbeaten. Kendalia joins the new stable following some good efforts at Provincial level for Joe Pride. Now with Matt Dale, she doesn't get too many favours from out wide, though she's turning in strong figures that stack right up in this field. Thinking she'll be spotting Savaii a head start in the run which is the big niggles.
