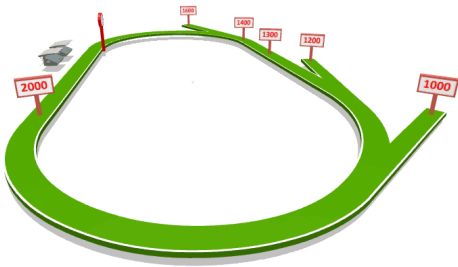

Race Analysis: Thoroughbred Park on Melbourne Cup/Big Dance Day. Where else would you rather be? Hopefully the weather gods are on our side, as well as the punting gods of course. Craft led them up in Highway company last time and was waving the white flag shortly after straightening. We often see horses come back from Highway grade and fail as the race shapes are completely different, however with Craft's racing pattern and both Olive and Heywood's nous, they won't allow him to end up in position that harms his chances. Can see him taking up a prominent role and setting a good gallop as that's how he's performed best in the past. Caravanserai comes through a hot form race at Goulburn where he set the tempo. He looks another key pace influence in this event and has the figures to make his presence felt, though the one query would be a rain-affected deck should the heavens open.

Race Analysis: Glastonbury Girl relished a solid tempo over 1400m last start to break her maiden in good fashion. There looks to be good speed engaged in this race once again and she looks open to further improvement with Guymer now in the saddle. Only her third race start, she has plenty of upside and looks ready to explode for the Matthew Smith barn. Team Thorotek tested Heligan in the Geelong Classic a couple of weeks ago and he never really fired a shot. He comes back to what looks a more suitable trip for him. It'll be a question of whether the trip has made him hardened, or if he's gone backwards. Would've liked to have seen him knock over a maiden prior to this with the figures he's running and there's enough queries with him to keep him at arm's length. Going to make Prophet's Promise third pick as this looks a bit of a target for the stable who just seem to be regaining their mojo. He was left with too much to do off a moderate tempo last start when back to 1300m and there's enough substance in his mile effort two back that suggests he can be a factor here. He's a work in progress, but there's signs there that he'll repay the believers in spades.

Race Analysis: Extrio is a former Bjorn Baker-trained filly now in the Luke Pepper stable. She seems the right place to start after showing good ability in her trials before failing as a \$1.90 fave on debut at Newcastle. While she was beaten there, the experience will be invaluable, and she comes back to country level. No public sightings for the new stable, though she'll be ready to fire on a feature raceday. Skibidi was tipped out after his only trial as a 2YO where he wasn't asked to do a whole lot. Looks the main danger under the apprentice hoop but I'm happy to let this through to the keeper.

Race Analysis: Some race this! Plenty of local talent on offer with a spot in the Community Chest on offer for the winner. Vermicella looks well placed first-up on the back of a nice trial at Queanbeyan where she was very strong through the line. She was placed in Midweek company when fresh last campaign and the race set up here looks ideal. A damp track is right up her alley, and she boasts a very strong first-up record. Can see her starting the favourite ahead of Mountain Chatter who has had two trials for his new trainer Nick Olive in readiness for this. The map is a big query as he tends to get back in his races and he's likely to be spotting Vermicella a big head start. There's a few at odds worth specking with all having RAS Ratings that are up to scratch. I thought Mighty Myrtle was flying through the line over 1000m first-up, a distance well short of her best. She's going to be back in the run once again but she's still hinting that there's something more to come and with a genuine tempo expected here, she can reproduce her best. Craving Magic beat home Vermicella in that recent trial but is a much bigger price. Has done enough first-up in the past to suggest he may be of some value. Good Prize was superb through the winter and 1300m first-up looks ideal. He has untapped potential and while he carries the top weight, he may not have hit his ceiling just yet. Hell Of A Fox was just okay at Hawkesbury first-up but turned in a solid enough number there. Can build on that performance in this event and she's worth including in exotics at 30-1.

Race Analysis: Very even race this with five runners separated by just 4 RAS Ratings points and they all find themselves at the top of the market. Callenem Thru won well here at the last meeting and looks open to further improvement now third-up into the campaign. This is tougher, but she shapes as a progressive type who can continue through the grades. Teylu is 1/1 at this track and trip and has a strong fitness base. He jumped a \$3 chance in the CL1 here when sitting close to the speed back in April at this stage of the preparation. Not willing to discount him. There may be some value around Forcefilly following a good win at Bathurst last start when stepping out to 1200m. She was an \$8.50 chance there, but turned in solid RAS Ratings and she remains right down in the weights. Looks a pretty straight forward steer for the 4kg claimer. Supairo hasn't been far away in good races at Muswellbrook and is right in this on RAS ratings, though he lacks the upside of others around him in the market.

Race Analysis: Happy to side with the local debutant in Silver Touch here. She was very impressive trialling after the last here a couple of weeks ago, and importantly that was on a Soft surface. Nick Heywood tried everything he could to keep the trial sneaky, though she trucked him through the line in a very strong trial performance. A sister of Single Gaze for long-standing supporters of the Snowden & Dryden stable, there's a sense that she's been aimed at this for a while now. Purple Rose looks the only danger on the back of two trial wins in Sydney since joining the John Thompson stable. It's easy to think she's gone to another level since joining the new barn, though she has had chances to knock off maiden's in the country previously.

Race Analysis: You Wish lines up today first-up on the back of a couple handy trials in good company. She's a rocket first-up and she's been competitive in stronger races than this throughout her career thus far. Looks a perfect starting point for her from a good draw and with a lot of the form tying in together, she makes the most appeal. Prophet Time and She's High Society are joined at the hip, starting similar prices and finishing alongside each other when they do battle. Weights and measures have things in the favour or Prophet Time today, though she has threatened without winning one of these plenty of times before. She's High Society will need a touch of luck, but she looks better credentialed on the back of a strong performance in tougher company last time out.
