

Race Analysis: Matthew Smith looks to have a stranglehold on the opening race on Community Chest Day. My Greek God has jumped favourite his past three starts, with 2 of those being at provincial level. His one country start recently, he was edged out in a photo finish at Scone over 2200m. The form reads beautifully for a race of this calibre and while his wet form doesn't read well, all those runs have been short of this trip. Can land in a good position in running and this looks a perfect race for him to knock off his maiden. Happy to put the stablemate Liyah's Girl as second pick, coming through the same race as The Greek God at Gosford. She's a lightly raced mare and was only a neck away at this track and trip two back. Ticks plenty of boxes and can see her being well supported as well. Koning looks the likely leader which will go a long way to winning this race. Likely to dictate the tempo but would probably have to lift on recent efforts.

Race Analysis: Think there's a few chances to bet around the favourite. Agent Zero's run was short lived at Kembla first-up with the gap opening and the gelding never really letting go. While improvement is expected and the form suggests he should be at the pointy end of the market, horses like Fierce Impulse and Tinklejazz look value plays. Fierce Impulse ran the fastest time of the morning over 1200m at his only heat, some 15 lengths quicker than Tinklejazz on the same morning. Fierce Impulse jumped a \$4.40 chance on debut at Nowra on the back of some handy trials last campaign and was just flat there. Looks to have come on in the break and at double figures in early betting, there's a strong case he can be second pick. Tinklejazz is a well-bred filly, being a full sister to G1 winner D'Argento. She looks a filly that will be better suited over further, though her trials suggest she may be sharp enough to run a bold race on debut in what looks a suitable race.

Northlander has trialled nicely and judging by his latest trial, getting to the outside of horses looks a key for him, so the wide draw may end up being in his favour. Has trialled well on Soft going coming in. Top Speed has also trialled fairly in town, though there's plenty of unknowns around. Pombia comes up favourite on the back of a good run at Wyong last start, though she has had her chances. Taking a wait and see approach. Skibidi rates well off the debut effort here when a \$3.10 chance and gets the gun for hire Boudvillain on board from a good draw. Happy to let this one through to the keeper, something those English cricketers could add to their game...

Race Analysis: Scratchings have changed this race and it's not one I'm looking to bet in. I like Ziggy Rose, though back to 1600m and the blinkers on isn't the scenario I want to find her in. While they may sharpen her up, She's shown her past couple that she mightn't be quick enough over the mile at this stage of her campaign. She was finishing strongly off a slow tempo at Hawkesbury latest, but her win two back over the 2000m here was won in good time where she was the strongest late. Thinking she may be vulnerable back to the mile, but in saying that there's nothing I want to back to beat her. Gatchan was huge here in the Road To The Chest when flashing late, but that was a surprise at 100-1. Don't exactly want to be in her corner now at the shorter odds - albeit in an easier race - as we've seen this from her in the past. Devil Rider is one you may be able to make a case for. Maps well under the apprentice hoop and has won on a Soft deck previously, though like the stablemate, back to the mile is a big query.

Race Analysis: Keen to side with the 3YO in Neeson for the now local barn. He led them up at Corowa and put them away with ease at an odds-on quote, highlighting his class with a 3.8 length victory. The inside draw should see him close to the speed again and he's expected to be better again now third-up into the campaign. There's plenty to like about him on the RAS Ratings scale and he makes plenty of appeal at the early price. You can make a strong case that Xceptional Fella should be second pick in this market. The gelding returned a new peak RAS Rating first-up, highlighting he's in for a good prep with a CL2 win over the 1200m here. The form out of that race has been superb and the wet track is right up his alley. May spot them a start in the run, but with natural improvement likely, he's right in this race. Stormbringer was solid when dictating from the front at Nowra last time out. Should be able to take up the running again or at least be positive from the inside draw. Jumped an odds-on pop last start and with a slight change in his gear, he can put his best foot forward. Dolly put in a good figure when winning at Cootamundra before finishing back in the run at Rosehill last time out. Back to this company looks a good move and an improved run is on the cards third-up.

Race Analysis: Kimberley Secrets brings the best form into the race, coming through Saturday grade most recently. She has the speed to roll across from out wide under Keatings and her recent RAS Ratings stack right up in this field. Well suited out to 1200m now and she looks beautifully placed back to this grade. A wet deck won't be an issue and if she runs to her form, she'll take beating. Mighty Myrtle won this race 12 months ago and looks set for a bold performance third-up into the campaign. She's been ridden passively so far this campaign, but now with McDougall on board, she can sit a touch closer than we've seen in recent efforts. Her ratings are building nicely this time in work, and she looks poised to strike. Vella Fox just missed at Albury when finishing off strongly from the back at Albury. May get back again from the draw, but Boudvillain sticks and that's worth plenty. Drops in weight now and can be finishing strongly. Zulfiqar trialled very well recently for the Litt stable and is not to be discounted, as is My Last Hooray who has hinted that he's up to a races like this in recent efforts.

Race Analysis: Mayfair bounced back last week at Newcastle, showing he was back to the form of old. While he's only won 1 race, he's G1 placed at 1400m as a 3YO and he wasn't beaten far by Linebacker first-up in the Silver Eagle in Sydney. Those formlines look very strong for a race of this calibre and the map looks to work out beautifully for him. Wouldn't surprise to see him improve again now out to 1400m and return to winning ways. Things look to work out well for Sir Artie who was very disappointing in the Ladies' Day Cup at Hawkesbury last time out. While the form prior reads well for this, the gelding would be a little query if the rain came. Happy to keep him at his current price, but it wouldn't surprise to see him drift across the weekend if the rain does fall. Ticklebelly was superb winning the Snake Gully Cup last week and is on the quick turnaround. She put up a strong RAS Rating and she has the speed to offset the tricky draw. About her right price on current form. Green Shadows is one who can improve. Hasn't had much luck this time in work in stronger races and now gets Collett on board, as well as the blinkers in a winnable race. Goulburn Cup rating this time last year stacks right up and he's performed to that level numerous times since.

Race Analysis: Our Little Star makes plenty of appeal with a favourable set up first-up for the new stable. Her first-up record is strong, placing in midweek company first-up last campaign. While she didn't beat a lot in her trial here a couple of weeks ago, she did it easily and looked to have plenty under the bonnet. Suspect she'll sit just off the speed, get to the outside and let down strongly, with the wet track not being an issue. Runranirun has trialled very strongly in Sydney coming into this and may still have some improvement to come being a lightly raced mare. She'll have the speed to roll across from out wide and jumped favourite in a CL1 at Newcastle when fresh last campaign. Her RAS Ratings are right there with Our Little Star, but the set up looks to suit the Olive runner better today. Stern Looks appears a promising type, though how she handles a wet deck would be the query.
