

Race Analysis: Good race to begin and I suspect Bearings will be the one the money comes for. She makes plenty of appeal off a strong first-up effort at Wyong over the mile, let alone the form she brings from last campaign. There's plenty in her favour today that suggests the RAS Ratings from last campaign are in play, with a bigger track and getting to 2000m both big ticks. While there's some handy horses in this field, there's plenty to like about Bearings. Ziggy Rose surprised me back to the mile last start and with the blinkers on, going close to winning. Getting back out to 2000m now is a big bonus for her, though she does look to have bumped into one in Bearings. She looks a nice mare on the rise though and she looks the main danger on RAS Ratings. Can make a case that Devil Rider should be shorter than his early price. Out to 2000m, he gets Heywood on board replacing the apprentice hoop and was a winner in this grade three back at Bathurst. Can play a role.

Race Analysis: Keen to take on the early favourite with the Matthew Smith-trained De Louviere. His two trials in town have been very sharp, and he looks primed for the mile first-up. He's got the RAS Ratings from his last campaign to figure, albeit over further, and his form ties in through Bearings in race one. Smith strikes at 19% with horses first-up at Canberra in the last five years, and he makes plenty of appeal. Twisted Love is the early favourite, though I wasn't taken with her latest trial at Warwick Farm. She was only fair in her three runs in Queensland in her debut campaign in Australia when stretching out to 2200m and her sharpness over the shorter trips would be the big query. Happy to bet against her in this race despite her being back in grade. Simply Nutbush was very good here on Community Chest Day winning over 1400m after getting the perfect run in transit. This shapes similarly and he can go back-to-back without surprising.

Race Analysis: There looks to be a good betting opportunity here with the Jarrod Austin debutant Ocean Empress. She sat on the speed in her latest heat at Warwick Farm and ran away to win convincingly under a strong hold. There looked to be more under the hood and that's an ominous sign for her opponents. What makes her more attractive here, is that she beat Mashean in that latest heat with the Archibald filly being urged along in the straight. Everything sets up beautifully for Ocean Empress and she can make a statement on debut. All Exceed was heavily bet on debut at Albury but went amiss and has been off the scene for a year. Comes from a good family that the Olive camp have plenty to do with. May not be his race here but watch and learn for future events.

Race Analysis: Looks an open Federal with a couple of different angles. King Taurus comes up the early favourite, though I'm happy to take him on with 1200m being a little query. While he's raced in metropolitan grade his past few, he's had his chances in Country grade and jumped a \$4.40 chance in a BM74 at Wagga four back with Boudvillain on board. Carries no weight with the apprentice hoop riding today, but there's enough knocks to think he'll drift. Urafiki had support first-up at Moruya and bolted in, clocking good splits in the process over 1300m. Outclassed in the Barn Dance las start, but he's been freshened and comes back to a suitable level today. He'll get back from the draw, but if he can reel off the splits we saw first-up then he'll take plenty of beating. Imasuperstar wasn't far off King Taurus at Wagga and hasn't been sighted since. He comes into this second-up with a favourable alley and with the upside to improve. Another who looks an improver with Keikoku who was the eye-catcher in the Single Gaze here on Community Chest Day. The splits back up what the eye saw there and this shapes as a good opportunity to put his best foot forward.

Race Analysis: The scratchings here have played into the hands of Telling who lines up here on the back of a solid effort at Gosford when back to 1200m. He's showing good early speed in his races and that holds him in good stead from out wide, with some speed drawn inside that he'll be able to follow across. Getting out to 1400m now looks ideal, jumping a \$1.30 chance two back at Orange when winning a CL1 comfortably. Think he can sit handy from the draw and run to a new peak RAS Rating. Cashbook got the job done well at Gundagai in a CL1 and is another stepping out to 1400m. Some niggle with the apprentice hopping on board, though he can roll forward from out wide and be in this for a long way. Still has plenty of upside to come and he's not to be taken lightly. Tokyo Star finished off well at Kembla last start and has some claims coming back to Country level.
