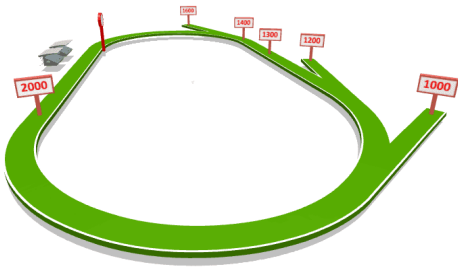

**Race Analysis:** Racing returns to the Capital for the first time since the 28th of December and it's a good event to kick things off. Keadool comes back to 1000m after tiring late over the 1100m at Gilgandra last time out. He had his chance there after settling behind the speed, though this shapes as a suitable event on his form prior to that. The ratings he produced in his two wins prior stand up in this field and he's a deserved favourite. Spirits Burn Deep will need some luck from the barrier, but she boasts a good first-up record, and she progressed nicely last campaign. She was outclassed at Canterbury at her last start, but her SP here in a Federal two back highlights the class she has. Can't be left out of calculations. Vainstream looks to get plenty in his favour here with an inside draw. He's 0/5 at this track and trip, though his past two ratings have him right in the thick of the action.

**Race Analysis:** La Stiava looks the one to beat following the scratching of the early favourite this morning. Her trial here prior to the debut effort was very impressive and she held her own in Sydney on debut. Back to an easier race here and she'll have improved from the debut performance. Music Time was good on debut here in the Clan O'Sullivan but this looks a little harder on paper. Where he ends up from the barrier is the query here and that makes it hard to mark him any shorter. Union may end up jumping inside Music Time. He was ridden out in his recent trial at Randwick, but he stuck on well enough there and should be on the speed from a good gate.

**Race Analysis:** Hitching my wagon to the 3YO Sir Tua here who looks to find a favourable set up. He was left with too much to do last start around the tight Wyong circuit, though his win two back at Nowra suggested he's a horse on the way up. He can sit closer this time around from an inside alley and while he gives weight to the older horses, his ceiling looks much higher on what we've seen in his past couple of efforts. Flashy Icon wasn't far off his best ratings at Albury last start and just bumped into once better when back to this trip. Budler rides now, though he would have to find another gear now and that looks tough to forecast with the tight range in his recent figures. Looks the second pick though despite Dolce Dior being an impressive winner prior to the break. She won't be a horse that trials well so I'm happy to overlook that heat recently, though her two fresh efforts over the mile haven't turned in ratings good enough for a race like this. Thinking she'll be a drifter as she'll be better suited later on. While Tjaka was a good winner last start, this sets up much differently today. She's likely to be a long way back in the run, but with the splits she continues to run, she can't be left out.

**Race Analysis:** This looks a pretty good race on paper with a few of these threatening to rise through the ranks. Fierce Critic was very good on debut after being last in the run at Kembla Grange. She finished off strongly from the back of the pack there and clocked some nice splits in the process. This presents as a great opportunity second-up with the opportunity to settle closer from a better gate today and the slight rise in trip should suit too. Listen Sweetheart has trialed very nicely coming into this, sitting back and hitting the line nicely. She looks ready to take the next step this time in work and 1400m fresh looks ideal. Might need some luck on straightening but if she can return at the level she showed last campaign, then she'll be right in the finish. Happy to go against Colorado Sun on his home deck. Jumped an odds-on pop last start at Wagga and while things didn't work out perfect, he was still a little plain in the closing stages. That form has since been just fair at Albury on Thursday. Would have to turn around and go to a new peak off the poor effort, and that's very hard to forecast.

**Race Analysis:** Looks a pretty straight forward race on ratings. Sweet Twilight is a lightly raced filly on the way up, jumping favourite two back at Kembla before a \$6.50 chance at Newcastle last time out when finishing strongly from the back of the pack. That form stands right out in this field and drawing better here back in grade can see her closer in the run. 2000m now looks perfect and she's clearly the one to beat. Doc March is an honest horse and his form behind the handy Due Calzini over 2100m last campaign isn't far off what's required here. Hard to see him going to another level with how exposed he is, though he's there to strike if something goes wrong with the favourite.

**Race Analysis:** A tough second leg to the Quaddie here and there's not much between the exposed horses on RAS Ratings. It's a hard race to line up with plenty of form lines coming in from different directions and the early favourite Divine Secrets being a year between runs. Typically, those horses racing first-up underperform against the market expectation. Mark Of Glory maybe looks the most appealing but there's no juice in the price and it looks a raffle with the number of unknowns coming in. Happy to go wide in the Quaddie and hope for the best.

**Race Analysis:** Looks a good race to end the day and Falcon Lair comes into this on the back of a couple handy trials at Warwick Farm recently. He wasn't far behind Sixties who bolted in first-up in Saturday grade in his first trial and hit the line well enough last start in a 1200m heat behind handy galloper Glint Of Silver. Suspect he'll get out over further this time in work, which is the query with him here fresh, but he's shown plenty of class in his debut campaign and the \$1.35 SP from his last start shows he's better than a country galloper. Happy to throw up Wolf Island as the second pick after a strong return performance behind a smart one at Albury last time out. 1400m here it a big tick and he continues to improve with racing. Draw is sticky, but he'll be able to get to the outside and show what he's capable of. Can make cases for Madame Fiocca out to 1400m and from a good draw, as well as Shoreman who draws the inside first-up and can make every post a winner fresh for the new stable.
