

Race Analysis: This might end up being a good form reference in the future with some handy types making their debut. The trial form of Get Litt stands out though, showing good ability in two Warwick Farm trials. In her first trial this time in, she was narrowly beaten by Maluku who won a maiden at Wyong last week, and in her latest trial, she went close to one who had been in the market and had placed in metropolitan company. That reads well for a Country maiden of this calibre and she has shown some adaptability in those trials. There's plenty to like about her. Of the raced brigade, The Way Ahead is the most appealing on the back of a strong performance over 900m at Newcastle last time out. Better suited back to country level today and she possesses good early speed. Dancer's Delight is another who has impressed at the trials coming into this. While his trial form mightn't be as good as what Get Litt brings in, he may be able to jump the rest of the raced brigade right away.

Race Analysis: Bedda Mia stands out on the RAS Ratings, though how this race sets up for her is the big query. She's a maiden taking on BM50 grade, but her figures stand out. Her last run in Country grade she was beaten as a \$1.85 favourite at Cowra in a disappointing performance, but she's been right up to the mark in Provincial company since. If she can cross from the wide draw, she'll be hard to gun down, but that is the question. Behind her it looks pretty even, with Written By Lucy holding her rightful place in the market. She looks the next best with the form she brings into this, she just has to be close to the mark fresh. Liubov disappointed at Goulburn fresh, but he was very impressive when breaking his maiden at this track and trip back in 2024. He's spent a long way off the scene and may need some more time to knock the rust off, but this shapes as a much better assignment today.

Race Analysis: Keen to back the debutant Samaka here. Looking at the RAS Ratings and the form his rivals bring in, there's nothing to be running scared of and he's shown good ability in both trials coming into his debut. He hit the line very nicely in his latest heat, and beat a horse called Spanish Artist who jumped a \$2.25 favourite in a Super Maiden at Kembla by nearly 4 lengths! While it is only a trial, this looks a relatively weak maiden away from him and this looks a great opportunity to make a winning start to his career. Uber In was sound fresh at Goulburn when over 1100m but she was a long way off the winner there in the sticky conditions. Out in trip may help her chances, but she'd need to improve sharply on the first-up effort and that's hard to predict. Setta Icon is probably better suited back to a race of this calibre - as shown by his fresh effort at the Sapphire Coast. Expecting him to bounce back to be in this for a long way.

Race Analysis: Can make a case for a few in this race on RAS Ratings and that makes it hard to nail one down. Cabbucio was super last start when back to the inside at Kembla Grange and looks well suited out to the mile as she continues to build. Things look to work out well for her here, but a few others fit into that bill as well. It's hard to line up the form of Unavoidable who comes to Australia off a debut win at Navan back in 2024. His trials this time in haven't set the world on fire, but the mile first-up should suit and the winning rating on debut is strong in this field. Timeless Grace flew home behind a smart one at Wagga last time out and the mile looks ideal now for the first time. Can be wherever she's comfortable from a good draw and can put herself into the finish. Canadian Fling has ratings that are up to this and while Luna Bay was disappointing fresh, this looks to suit her much better. Happy to watch and learn.

Race Analysis: Keen to back Urafiki here despite the disappointing performance last time out. She was simply outclassed in the Country Champs Qualifier at the Sapphire Coast last time out but returns to the scene of her most recent win. She beat Keikoku on that occasion and meets him better at the weights. This looks very similar to the way she won two starts ago and if Guymer can get her to the outside, she'll be storming home over the top. Cyclone Rupert is the 'weight horse' in this race, dropping 5kg following a strong win in tough conditions at Goulburn most recently. He'll be up on the speed despite a wide draw and that'll be a key to his chances. JVO is striking at 14% of late and he'll take some catching. Soul Lady had some fans in the Camarena here on Black Opal Day but never got into the race. Fitter now and getting out to a more suitable trip for her look big ticks and she'll be closing strongly. Keikoku was super in the Camarena when back in trip and looks ready to fire getting back out in trip today.

Race Analysis: There's no doubt Cruizingthestars has plenty of talent, but I'm not sure I can get her as short as the early markets have her. Her late strength at Goulburn was a highlight as she pulled away in the final 100m of the race and getting out in distance doesn't look an issue. She'll make her own luck up on speed, but Interro has a RAS Rating to match from her victory at Goulburn two starts ago. She was caught in a slow race last start at Newcastle where she couldn't sprint with them in the small field. This looks a better scenario for her now back to Country level and out in distance and it's easy to think her early price is far too big.

Race Analysis: Think the finale sets up nicely for Awesome Artist who looks to have plenty of upside after a narrow defeat in Provincial grade at just his third career start. He'll be close to the speed from that draw and he's expected to raise the bar yet again with that latest run under his belt. Ticks plenty of boxes in this event and if he can run up to his latest effort, he'll be very hard to hold out. Take The Chance bolted in to win over 1700m at Cowra after a solid performance over this trip at Queanbeyan last time out. Where Penza gets to from the draw is a query, though if she finds the front as is able to dictate, that'll go a long way to her winning. Justifiably will be fitter for the fresh run over 1600m and should appreciate the jump straight out to 2000m. Creates some interest with Boudvillain remaining in the saddle.
