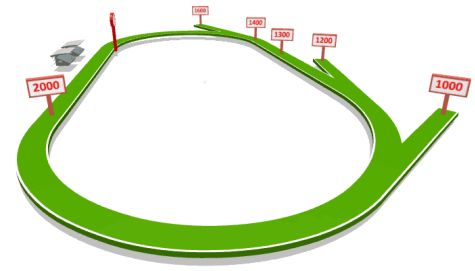

Race Analysis: The opener on a cracking card for Black Opal Day, though it's a race I'm happy to leave alone. Sacred Inferno is the pick on form, though he'll be spotting his rivals a start and Seib's hot form has fallen away, now sitting ~3 wins behind the market in the last three months and on a run of 28 outs. Pure Octane has been under Bjorn Baker's care for all three public trials but switched down to the Pepper barn in readiness for this. He held his own in those Sydney trials and the form out of the latest one has been solid, but he's a difficult horse to line up. Trooper comes to the local Thorotek team and his trial here a fortnight ago was very strong, as was On The Fly's trial at Goulburn on a wet deck last week. There doesn't appear much between them and Show Rhythm who was sound on resumption behind a big winner here on Preview Day. Hard to find an edge in early betting.

Race Analysis: It's not often you think drawing an inside barrier is an issue in racing - but that does seem the case for Brazen Crime. He disappointed in Highway grade two back but probably should've won last start had he not been locked away on the fence. That is the query again today, but he's always hinted that he's better than his rating suggests and this presents as a golden opportunity to show what he's made of - he just needs to find a way off the fence! Remadosi comes back from Highway grade where she was solid over 1800m. That sets her up nicely coming back to the mile now and she gets onto her preferred surface. Boudvillain sticking is a good push and her form ties in through Miss Stalwart who presents some value here. She was very good winning on Preview Day and this may set up similarly today. The Soft deck may be a query, but her price is simply too big on the form she's in coming here. Oneforian has returned with a bang and run to a new peak rating in both wins. He doesn't have an edge on the ratings despite those wins however and now he gives weight to some handy types. Deepwater Artist is racing well, but this is tougher and he stretches to the mile for the first time which is the query.

Race Analysis: The early market suggests this race is an absolute raffle away from Vella's Best - but there are some angles which can help crack the code. Vella's Best was very impressive throughout his last campaign, and he's tuned up nicely for this with a strong trial win. He'll jump straight to the front from a good draw, and the ground won't be an issue. Plenty of positives for a horse targeted towards this event. Soul Lady does represent some value away from the favourite however. She may be better placed over further, but this will be a stiff 1000m and her trial alongside subsequent Country Champs Qualifier Vermicella was superb. Down in the weights and looks poised to strike. Behind them there's a few chances, though Take The Rap has always suggested he's a handy type and while the fresh run was disappointing, this may be more to his liking. Major Time gets Tommy Berry replacing the apprentice hoop and he's run well in this race on numerous occasions.

Race Analysis: There looks an opportunity to bet, and in turn a big chance of the \$100k Inglis Bonus going off! Things look to shape nicely for Cosmic Eagle in this event, third-up into the campaign after posting a strong time in town last start. She closed well from midfield and importantly today, she maps to be in front of her main dangers. Rach was left flat footed in a very slow event at Canterbury last start, though she held on for second in a strong performance and that form has already been franked. Her run two back brings in a strong rating too, though where she lands from the outside barrier is the query. Your Chilli was on debut in that same maiden that Rach comes through and he was finishing strongly after settling back in the field off that slow tempo. He's likely to be back in the run again, but a stiffer test this time looks to suit, and it wouldn't surprise to see him right in the finish. Happy to push Superata despite the inside draw. He's had a few chances to knock one off now - at country level as well - and he's one I'm happy to go against.

Race Analysis: Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott have only two races they are yet to win, the Cox Plate and the Canberra Guineas. They look primed to knock over the latter with Watson here who continues to raise the bar this time in work. He stuck on very well behind subsequent Group 1 winner Tempted in the Eskimo Prince and has since trialled brilliantly. Should find the front with ease for Clark and with his ratings edge as well, he'll be very hard to mow down. While Watson looks a standout, it wouldn't surprise to see this be a strong form race with the likes of Rivendell and Transcend making the trip. Rivendell is unbeaten for the Snowden barn and has a brilliant ratings profile coming into a 'normal' Canberra Guineas, the problem is that this looks above average. He has plenty of upside, though whether he can make the jump necessary to knock off Watson is the question. Transcend was caught wide and without cover first-up in Sydney. While it's easy to forgive that performance, it would be some ratings turnaround to see her run a new peak off that effort and score the Guineas. It's worth noting that Azarax has beaten Watson previously, when Azarax was on debut at Wyong. Watson has since gone to another level this campaign, though Azarax put up a new peak RAS Rating first-up at Hawkesbury. That bodes well for the road ahead and while he profiles nicely for a standard Guineas, this looks a Guineas from the top shelf.

Race Analysis: Following on from the Guineas, this is a fantastic National Sprint with most of the dual acceptors opting to run here. Hellsing is low flying at the moment, and his RAS Ratings reflect that, running to a new peak figure in every one of his last three outings. He drops right down to the minimum weight here which makes him a very attractive proposition, particularly with his racing pattern. He should get every chance from the draw and be there to pounce with a solid tempo expected. The set up of the race is a big knock for Magnatear and Cool Jakey, who bring in strong ratings, but in Magnatear's case, a very different scenario. Magnatear was able to dictate in Sydney last start but couldn't fend off a solid winner, but it was War Eternal behind him who looks better suited here. The wet deck is a tick and Collett hops on board having won 3/4 when riding. With a wet track on offer, getting him to the outside and letting rip may be the recipe for success, and he'll relish the tough conditions. Green Fly is another who'll be happy with the rain on Saturday evening. He'll be spotting his rivals a start, but with a genuine tempo expected, he'll get his chance if good enough. Zouatica comes into this off a higher rating than he did when winning 12 months ago, though barrier 17 and a few pace influences make him easy to oppose.

Race Analysis: The Group 3 Black Opal Stakes and for the first time in a while the local contingent are in this up to their ears. The number 1 seed is Music Time after an impressive win in the Black Opal Preview a fortnight ago, mowing down Bar Jester with a big gap back to the rest of them. Music Time comes into this rated the same as Farcited from 12 months ago who jumped a \$2.70 favourite - a long line to draw, though historically significant. Music Times sectionals in his past couple suggest he's screaming for 1200m and he's ready to make the next step. He can be the first locally trained horse since Vella won with You're Canny in 2011 - and Gratz thinks Music Time is better! Eviction Notice is clearly the main danger on form alone, being the Silver Slipper runner-up and that form got a handy push on Saturday with Stretan Ruler. He was a long way off the winner in the Silver Slipper, though he still produced a strong RAS Rating and he'll have the speed to roll across from out wide. Bar Jester was fresh going into the Black Opal Preview, though Music Time did have his measure there. Out to 1200m now though and he'll get the gun run from an inside draw. Fitter now and is part of the strong local contingent. Out wider - Artaneous and Threads have trialled well coming into this and cases could be made for them also.

Race Analysis: It's unfortunate to see the Cup have so many scratchings, but that still leaves a handful of chances - all with ratings to win. Travolta opts to run here as the top weight, and he brings in the highest last start rating with Racing and Sports. He was right behind Piggyback there in the Parramatta Cup and that form came to the fore in the Randwick City Stakes on Saturday. He has enough early speed to roll across from the draw. He's the starting point when assessing the Cup, behind him it's a bit of a raffle. Nellie Leylax comes here third-up and out to 2000m, the same programming that saw him run to a new peak figure last campaign. He'll relish the sting out of the ground, and he'll jump to the front and give himself every chance. Sam Hawken and Touristic also come through the Parramatta Cup where Sam Hawken was on resumption. He didn't have the cleanest of passages there and he was sticking on to the line. Further looks better for him, though if this turns into a slog, that's when he'll bring his A-game. Touristic was given none last start in the Parramatta Cup and flew late to be on the heels of Sam Hawken across the line. Assessing Touristic's chances take some imagination on his recent performances, though his rating under similar conditions when winning the Lord Mayors Cup last year suggests he's right in the mix. The wet track helps his chances. Last year's Wagga Cup winner Flying Bandit lobs here second-up. While his record reads 2 wins from 4 second-up starts, they've been under very different scenarios to what he will face today. His best is good enough, it's whether this is the scenario he can produce his best which is the question.
