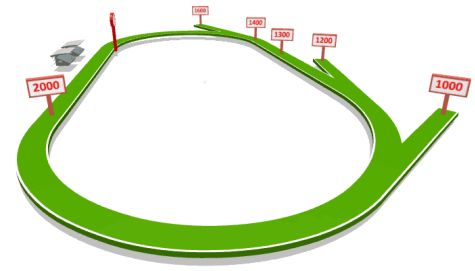

Race Analysis: Needawinna looks the pick following a good win at Echuca last time out in similar company, though there are a couple of queries. She jumped a \$26 chance when winning last time out and was a \$7.50 chance when breaking his maiden earlier this campaign. Apprentice Ella Bent strikes at 17% when teaming up with the Widdison stable and the draw looks ideal with her pattern. Just has to run up to her latest effort to win again. Dame Annie rarely turns in a bad one and will appreciate this easier company today. Only 1.7L away in a BM58 last start at Goulburn and that form rates well here. Fire Your Guns, Showtime Maggie and Vinari all come in with similar RAS Ratings in what looks a very even race to kick off the day.

Race Analysis: Angel City is clearly the one to be with here on the RAS Ratings, coming in well clear of her rivals off an impressive win at Goulburn last time out. This looks to shape similarly off an inside barrier for Boudvillain and the step up to 1600m is no problem at all. Not much juice in the price anymore but she deserves to be a short-priced favourite. The only other you could make a strong case for is the debutant Col Du Tourmalet who brings some handy trial form into this. He's won his last two trials coming into this, and the horse he beat in two trials ago Stand My Ground went on to win a Super Maiden at Newcastle before being beaten under a length in the Group 1 Vinery at Rosehill this past Saturday. He looks ready for the mile fresh and is worth keeping onside.

Race Analysis: Iowna Benz brings in a strong RAS Rating following a big win at Wagga last start where he led the field up and shot away to win by 1.3L. This looks to shape similarly, though he drops 5kg for the rise in grade. JVO sticks with him and he'd only have to run up to his recent efforts to bring up back-to-back wins. Happy to go against Keikoku here. He's a great horse who rarely runs a bad race, but I just think the set-up is unsuitable coming back in trip on the short turnaround. He was great in the Camarena on Black Opal Day, but this shapes a little differently and with the likes of Panic beating him in the Camarena and meeting him better at the weights, it may pay to look elsewhere. Panic rates highly off that run and has been kept fresh again coming into this. May need some luck with his racing pattern but his last start suggested he's good enough. Teylu hit his straps at the end of last campaign and ticks a few boxes lining up here fresh. Can play a leading role.

He hit the line nicely in his only trial leading into this and in an important note, Boudvillain sticks with him from that trial. He closed impressively in that heat, and the barrier give Boudvillain plenty of options. He looks the pick, though Slay Queen did beat him in that trial and did so in good fashion. Being 497 days between runs and drawing out is the query, but she's right in this from what we've seen at the trials. Trooper is one I can see drifting in betting. He was just plain here fresh on Black Opal Day and while his last start was solid, he was a 100-1 chance there over further.

Historically, runners off more than 400 days between runs are losing against market expectation, though there's no standout away from him to throw up as the main danger. It's a bit of a muddling bunch behind with Optimal Moments and Six Kings the next in the market and both first-up here from wide draws. It's easy to see Strike A Pose being the trendy, but he was 50-1 on debut at Hawkesbury. Did enough there to suggest he's no slouch, but diving into him here is for people braver than I.

Race Analysis: Good race this with a lot of ways to decipher the form. Hell Of A Fox comes in with the strongest form lines through the Country Championships Qualifier and Wildcard at a tricky Goulburn track last time out. She was closing well there - but the sectionals suggested she was stronger than her rivals late in the race rather than quickening. That makes the step out to the mile very enticing here. She'll need a few things to go her way, but with good speed engaged and the booking of Boudvillain, she may be able to take the next step now. Belleistic Kids improved sharply last start in the Albury Mile when on the quick turnaround. He'd been below his best prior and that makes him hard to line up. In his previous efforts, he's dipped in his ratings following a peak effort - so that makes him a less attractive proposition here. He will put himself on the speed however and if he can hold his form, then he'll be tough to reel in. Ghost Walker has been a little plain in his past couple after a good fresh effort. This presents as a golden opportunity to get back to his best from the inside draw and out to 1600m. Aristocrat is another who is a must for the quaddie. Bumped into an in-form mare on the same day as Hell Of A Fox and was right up to his best there. Can put himself into a prominent position and he'll relish a strong mile against the older horses.

Race Analysis: Keen to back in Brutal Belle here following a dominant maiden win at Goulburn first-up. Her trial leading in suggested she was back as good as ever and she showed that first-up, running a new peak RAS Rating and being very strong late in the race too. You'd expected improvement to come from that effort and while she is back in trip slightly, she can repeat the dose. Honey Perfume rarely runs a bad race, though she rarely wins one either. The blinkers go on today however and her only win did come third-up into the campaign. Can spike now. Overtook is the only other horse you can make a case for here, though she does seem to have her issues. Only one run last campaign after a 336-day break, and now she's spent a further 132 days on the sidelines. Trials suggest she's going well, she just needs to bring it to raceday now.

Race Analysis: Another tricky race to end. Cruizingthestars was down to run here last week before being a late scratching on veterinary advice. She lines up here 9 days later and while assuming it's a minor injury, it is still a query for this unbeaten filly. She looks a very nice horse on the rise though and if she can put that mishap behind her, she can extend her winning run. Jenni The Jet comes here off a solid run in town last time out where she beat Open Secret. Jenni and Open Secret were close to each other in the market and while there are some things in Open Secret's favour today, there is a query on just how well she is going. She's never been in a race of this calibre before, so this may be the confidence booster Open Secret needs, but it's hard to predict that off her latest effort. Hip Hip Ole hit the line nicely in a trial here behind some handy types, hitting the line alongside a subsequent winner from that trial. The barrier is the only thing keeping me from marking her shorter.
