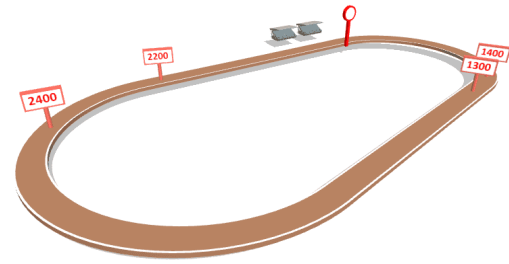

**Race Analysis:** Wave Dancer is now 0/7, but her recent figures have all been very consistent and that level is above what her rivals have done recently. She's shown some versatility and was good here late last week behind a well-backed winner. This looks the right race for her to notch up her maiden win, though the unknowns around Highway Robbery are stopping me from marker Wave Dancer any shorter. His late work in his latest trial at Goulburn was quite good and that was only a 750m heat, with the 1280m today on debut looking right up his alley. He's a half-brother to the handy Highway Strip and he looks the one they may gravitate to away from the favourite. Happy to go against Magic Anderson on his recent form. While this does look easier than last start, he would have to go to a new level now and that's hard to predict with what he's done this time in. Miss Steffi trialled soundly behind Craving Magic (in the Federal later) coming into this, but the horses she finished around there are just average. Her figures from last campaign are below what looks the winning mark in this race and it's hard to see her returning with a new peak rating.

**Race Analysis:** Keen to bet here and I think there's a couple of options to choose from. No knock on what Bide Your Time has done early in his career, but coming in 462 days between runs is the obvious query. The gelding has been accepted and scratched on a few occasions which doesn't fill me with confidence that he's ready to return with a bang, or even somewhere near the level that saw him placed in Highway company before the break. That opens the door for a number of these, including the Jarrod Austin-trained Simply Nutbush who was very impressive at his latest trial coming into this. The gelding ended last campaign in good order on the turf here and looks ready to go to the next level now. A good draw and McDougall make for good reading and if he's somewhere close to how he ended last campaign, he'll be in this for a long way. Starinion has a couple of ratings from last campaign that would see him shape nicely here, though he's been rather disappointing either side of a break. However, this is much easier and a return to form wouldn't surprise.

**Race Analysis:** This is a great Federal. Craving Magic has performed well on this surface previously and the in-form Potter stable (20% last 50 runners and 3 wins ahead of market expectation) look to have him humming judging by a recent trial. He bolted in there and looks set to return at somewhere near his best level - and that's danger signs for his rivals. He should get every chance from the inside draw for Budler and he can resume on a winning note. Love Shuck deserves plenty of respect having won the Wagga Town Plate Prelude (defeating Teylu - last week's Federal winner) before missing out narrowly in the Town Plate at his last start. The wide alley and where he lands on the map is the only thing stopping me from marking him shorter. Pleasurize looked to get his chance last start at Albury but didn't land a shot. McDougall replaces the apprentice hoop now though and she's not out of this on her best form.

**Race Analysis:** Happy to throw up Sure Intentions in the last as a bet. His past couple have been strong, particularly last start when flashing late at Moruya over 1650m. Out to 1750m for the first time, but it should suit the son of Hellbent and he's shown tactical speed in his past couple. Can lob in a handy position and with this distance looking to suit him better than some of his rivals, he makes the most appeal. Big Time Charlie has raised the bar his past couple to win by dictating over 2000m. He did jump \$15 and \$16 in his last two wins however in tougher company, but the last time he raced in a similar race to this, he was knocked over at Queanbeyan as a \$7 chance. Loy rides and he may be able to dictate again, though the question will be whether he has the zip over the shorter distance. Chebici is in a similar boat to Big Time Charlie, though she'll be making her run from the opposite end of the field. She was strong late in a bm50 at Wagga last time out, but steps back in distance which doesn't look ideal. Expect Bensley to get on his bike around the home turn and build momentum turning for home, but she may run out of time.
